RE: 2026 Values

Assessed values are driven by the real estate market. This past year, sellers received 98% of the total asking price, with an increased time on the market. There was a highly variable home supply paired with a steady demand for housing. This called for a variety of value adjustments to comply with South Dakota Codified Law, Administrative Rules, Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice, International Organization of Assessing Officers, local city, and county regulations.

Some important upcoming dates:

March 1st	Assessment notices are mailed
March 12th	Last day to mail or file written appeal with clerk of local board
March 16-20th	Local boards (small towns & townships) meet to hear appeals
April 7th	Last day to mail or file written appeal with county auditor (un-organized townships and City of Yankton)
April 14-May 8th	County/Consolidated boards meet

Last year there were 22 appeals, and all were heard in a single day.
On April 14th, 2026, the board will need to meet to open the board of adjustment per codified law.

Taxes

It is a common misconception the **property tax burdens** change directly in proportion to property values. South Dakota's property tax system is budget-driven, not rate-based and state law generally limits the taxing districts' authority to increase their budgets. In South Dakota, the allowed budget increase is 3% plus a growth factor, which captures new development.

Tax levies adjust to meet the budgetary requirements of taxing entities. Property assessments are adjusted only to meet the 100% market standard that is required by law.

The primary objective of the Equalization Office is the fair valuation of property. This ensures an equitable distribution of property tax burdens between owners.

10-6-104. **“Fair market value” and “full and true value” defined.** As used in this chapter and §§ 10-28-12, 10-28-13, 10-29-9, 10-29-9.1, 10-33-14.1, 10-35-10.1, 10-37-8, 10-37-9.1, 10-38-1, and 10-38-14, the term, fair market value, and the term, full and true value, mean the price in money that property will bring in a competitive and open market under all conditions requisite to a fair sale between a willing buyer and a willing seller, each acting prudently and with full knowledge of the relevant facts, and assuming the price is not affected by any undue stimulus.

10-3-41. **Median level of assessment to represent eighty-five percent of market value.** The director of equalization shall make the necessary adjustments to the valuations before the notice of assessment pursuant to § 10-6-154, so that the median level of assessment represents at least eighty-five percent of market value as determined by the Department of Revenue.

Each year, the director shall list the taxpayers whose property has been inspected as provided in this section and shall file the list with the county auditor.

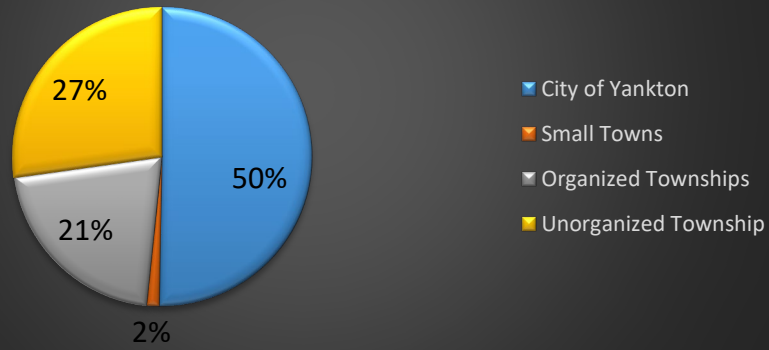

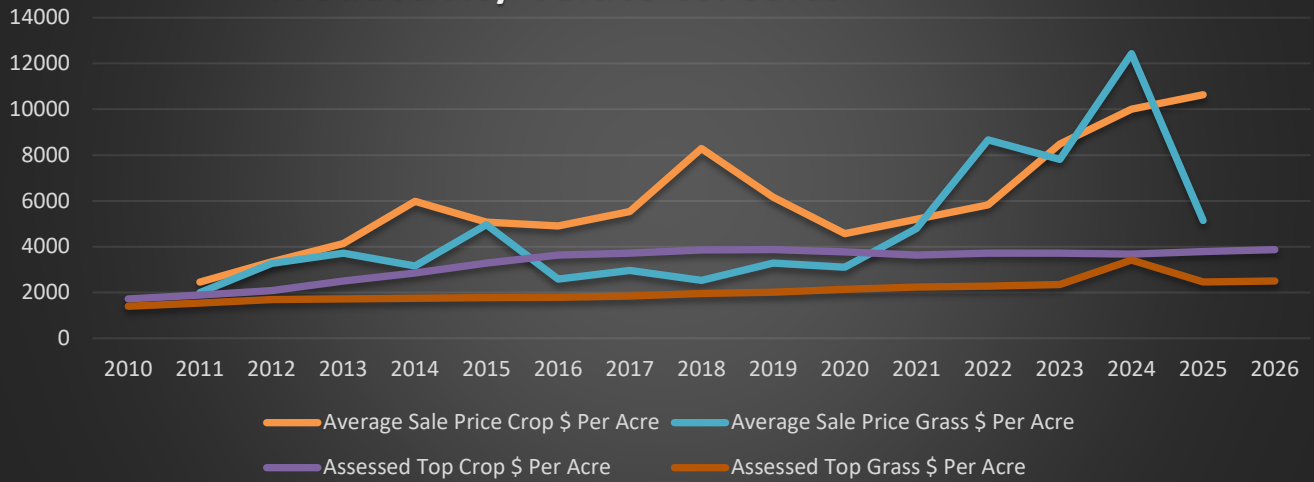

2026 Total Value Distribution Town/Township

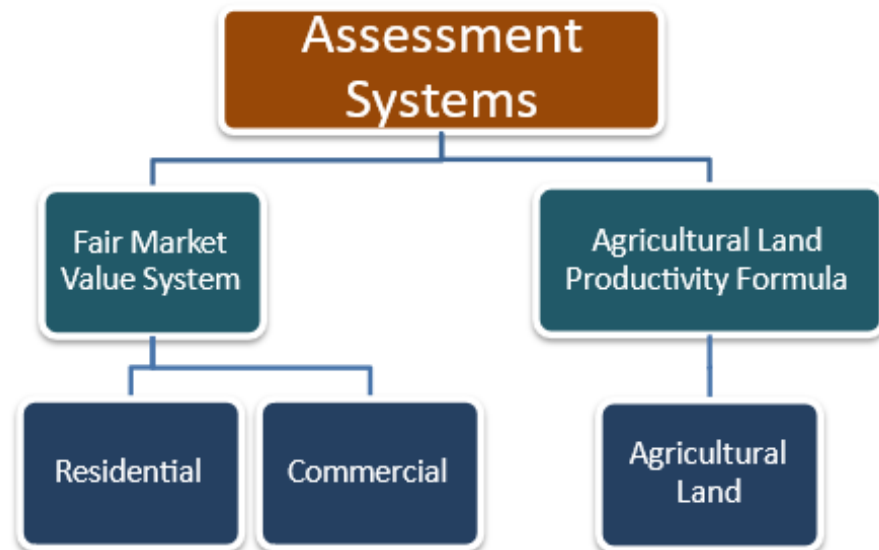


Ag Land Trends Productivity Values vs. Sales

At the above-referenced bid opening, Yankton County, SD received 3 bids for the 2026 Yankton County Microsurfacing Project. One bid came in above the Engineer's estimate, and two bids came in under the Engineer's estimate.

The apparent low bid was received from ASTECH Corp. of St. Cloud, MN in the total bid amount of \$331,478.95. A bid tabulation for the project is attached to this letter for the County's records. This bid was \$66,365.21 below the Engineer's estimate of \$397,844.16.

IMEG Consultants Corp. recommends awarding the contract for the 2026 McCook County Microsurfacing Project to the low bidder, ASTECH Corp. The Owner has been notified of any irregularities on the bid from ASTECH Corp. The bid items have been reviewed and appear to be accurate and reasonable.

YANKTON COUNTY
RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR TEMPORARY EMERGENCY REGULATION OF FIRE
HAZARDS IN YANKTON COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Yankton County are charged with the protecting health and safety of the citizens of Yankton County, including all property situated therein; and

WHEREAS, South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) 7-8-20(18) authorizes the Yankton County Commission to prohibit or restrict open burning, after consultation with local fire officials and law enforcement officials, in order to protect the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Yankton County Commission has consulted with local fire officials and law enforcement officials concerning the threat of wildfire from open burning under certain climatic conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Yankton County have determined that in the interest of public health and safety, it will prohibit open burning (open fire) when climatic conditions indicate the threat of wildfire and other dangerous fire hazards within Yankton County; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of this Resolution, “open burning” shall be defined as any outdoor fire, including but not limited to campfires, warming fires, charcoal grill fires, or the prescribed burning of fence rows, fields, wildlands, trash and debris. This Resolution excludes fires contained within liquid-fueled or gas-fueled stoves, fireplaces within all buildings, charcoal grill fires at private residences, and permanent fire pits or fire grates located on supervised developed picnic grounds and campgrounds; and

WHEREAS, conditions of wildfire and dangerous fire hazards now exist in Yankton County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yankton County Commission hereby enacts this Resolution on an emergency basis and imposes a burn ban to prohibit or restrict open burning in Yankton County, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ban will be in place until fire conditions improve as determined by the Yankton County Emergency Manager in consultation with Yankton County Emergency Officials within Yankton County, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars for each violation, or by imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty days for each violation, or by both the fine and imprisonment, if found in violation of this Resolution, as per South Dakota Codified Law 7-18A-2, and that the costs for suppressing any fire, including response fees, mutual aid assistance from other agencies or fire departments, reimbursement to governments for suppression efforts and compensation to the firefighters for time lost from their employment, be born directly by the individual or individuals responsible for setting the fire.



Occurrence means any one loss and/or series of losses arising out of and directly occasioned by an **act of terrorism** or an **act of sabotage** for the same purpose or cause. The duration and extent of any one **occurrence** shall be limited to all **losses** sustained by **you** at the **covered location** during any period of 72 consecutive hours arising out of the same purpose or cause. However no such period of 72 consecutive hours may extend beyond the expiration of the **Agreement Period** unless the **member** shall first sustain direct physical damage by an **act of terrorism** or an **act of sabotage** prior to expiration and within said period of 72 consecutive hours, nor shall any period of 72 consecutive hours commence prior to the beginning of the **Agreement Period**.

Section 2 – Benefit Agreement Clause C. – Covered Property – 3. is added:

3. Covered Property does not mean:
 - a. Animals.

Section 2 – Benefit Agreement Clause D. Cause of Loss is amended as follows:

D. – Cause of Loss – **We** will pay for **loss** to **covered property**, except as follows:

1. **We** will not pay for **loss**, or any increase in the amount of **loss**, caused directly or indirectly by, or resulting from, any of the following:

Cause of Loss r., Collapse is deleted and replaced with the following:

- r. Collapse, including settling, cracking, shrinkage, bulging or expansion, but **we** will pay for **loss** to:
 - (1) Covered Property caused by or resulting from collapse of a **covered building or structure**, if the collapse is directly caused by:
 - (a) An **act of terrorism** or **act of sabotage**;
 - (2) Covered Property caused by the collapse of personal property provided:
 - (a) The personal property which collapses is inside a **covered building or structure**; and
 - (b) The collapse was caused by a cause of **loss** listed in r. (1) above;
 - (3) Outdoor radio or television antennas or satellite dishes, including their lead-in wiring, masts or towers; awnings, gutters and downspouts; yard fixtures; outdoor swimming pools; fences; piers; wharves and docks; beach or diving platforms or appurtenances; retaining walls; and walks,

roadways or other paved surfaces at a **covered location**, if:

- (a) The **loss** is the direct result of the collapse of a **covered building or structure**; and
- (b) The collapse is caused by a **covered cause of loss** listed in (1) (a) above;

- dd. Loss or damage caused by cessation, fluctuation or variation in, or insufficiency of, water, gas or electricity supplies and telecommunications of any type or service.
- ee. Loss or increased cost as a result of threat or hoax, in the absence of physical damage due to an **act of terrorism** or **act of sabotage**.

Section 2 – Benefit Agreement D. – Cause of Loss – 2, i., is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 2. **We will not pay for loss to:**
 - i. The following types of property:
 - (1) Animals; or

- (2) Fragile articles such as glassware, statuary, marble, chinaware and porcelains, if broken, unless directly caused by an **act of terrorism** or **act of sabotage** to such fragile articles.

The Court finds that the Defendant had an interest in the property that is subject to forfeiture pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853, 18 U.S.C. § 982(a)(1), and Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 32.2(e)(1).

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the above-described Subject Property is hereby forfeited to the

United States of America pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853, 18 U.S.C. § 982(a)(1), and Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 32.2(e)(2)(A).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all right, title and interest to the property described above are hereby condemned, forfeited, and vested in the United States of America, and shall be disposed of according to law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States District Court shall retain jurisdiction in the case for the purpose of enforcing this order.

Paid Parental Leave Policy

Purpose/Objective

The County will provide up to 120 hours of paid parental leave to employees following the birth of an employee's child or the placement of a child with an employee in connection with adoption or foster care. The purpose of paid parental leave is to enable the employee to care for and bond with a newborn or a newly adopted or newly placed child.

Eligibility

Eligible employees must meet the following criteria:

- Have been employed with the County for at least 6 months.
- Have worked at least 1,040 hours during the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding the date the leave would begin.
- Be a fulltime regular employee (temporary employees, part time employees and interns are not eligible for this benefit).

In addition, employees must meet one of the following criteria:

- Have given birth to a child.
- Be a spouse or domestic partner of an individual who has given birth to a child. The County reserves the right to verify marriage or domestic partnership relationships at its sole discretion.
- Have adopted a child or been placed with a foster child (in either case, the child must be age 17 or younger).

Amount, Time Frame and Duration of Paid Parental Leave

- Eligible fulltime employees will receive a maximum of 120 hours of paid parental leave per birth, adoption or placement of a child/children. The fact that a multiple birth, adoption or placement occurs (e.g., the birth of twins or adoption of siblings) does not increase the 120 hour total amount of paid parental leave granted for that event. In addition, in no case will an employee receive more than 120 hours of paid parental leave in a rolling 12-month period, regardless of whether more than one birth, adoption or foster care placement event occurs within that 12-month time frame.
- Each week of paid parental leave is compensated at 100 percent of the employee's regular, straight-time weekly pay. Pay does not include bonuses, overtime pay, and/or the monetary value of other benefits or compensations. Paid parental leave will be paid on a monthly basis on regularly scheduled pay dates. Parental leave payments are taxable at the same rate as regular pay.
- Approved paid parental leave may be taken at any time during the 12-month period immediately following the birth, adoption or placement of a child with the employee. Paid parental leave may not be used or extended beyond this 12-month time frame.
- In the event of an employee who has given birth, the 120 hours of paid parental leave will commence at the conclusion of any short-term disability leave/benefit provided to the employee for the employee's own medical recovery following childbirth, should the

employee need additional time off after disability. If not, the employee may take the parental leave up to 12 months after the birth of the child.

- Employees must take paid parental leave in one continuous period of leave and must use all paid parental leave during the 12-month time frame indicated above. Any unused paid parental leave will be forfeited at the end of the 12-month time frame.
- Upon termination of the individual's employment at the County, he or she will not be paid for any unused paid parental leave for which he or she was eligible.

Coordination with Other Policies

- Paid parental leave taken under this policy may be in addition to approved unpaid Family Medical Leave or PTO, however all leaves are not to exceed 12 weeks in a 12-month lookback period unless required by law, eg accommodations under ADAaA or PWFA.
- After the paid parental leave (and any short-term disability leave for employees giving birth) is exhausted, the balance of personal leave (if applicable) will be compensated through employees' accrued PTO and unpaid time. Upon exhaustion of accrued PTO, any remaining leave will be unpaid leave.
- The County will maintain all benefits for employees during the paid parental leave period as long as the employee continues to be eligible for benefits-protected leave.
- Employees that are approved for paid parental leave will not receive paid holidays during the period of the leave request.
- Employees that are approved for paid parental leave will not accrue paid time off (PTO) on the paid parental leave earnings.
- A fulltime regular employee that has not met all of the employment eligibility requirements but meets the criteria as stated above, may still take the appropriate time off without pay and is afforded the same job protection for the period of time that the employee is on the parental leave as if the employee was on a personal leave of absence qualifying leave.

Requests for Paid Parental Leave

- The employee will provide his or her supervisor and the human resource department with notice of the request for leave at least 30 days prior to the proposed date of the leave (or if the leave was not foreseeable, as soon as possible). The employee must complete the necessary forms and provide all documentation as required by the County to substantiate the request.
- An employee returning from parental leave is requested to return to their position at regular schedules and not at reduced hours unless otherwise agreed upon. Failure to return to work after the period of leave, with or without accommodation may result in termination.
- As is the case with all County policies, the organization has the exclusive right to interpret this policy.
