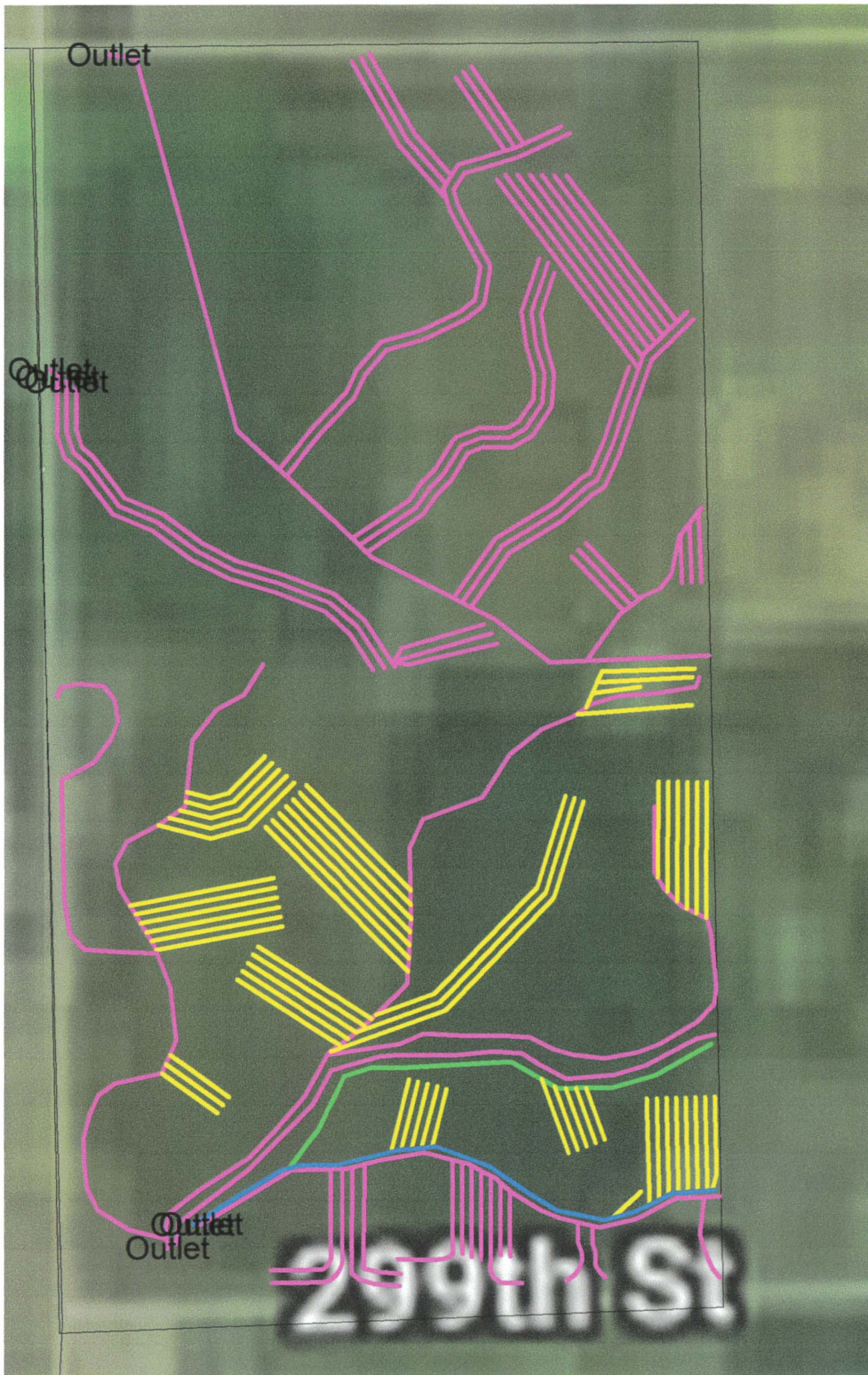



We started to drain Sec 10 in 2013. As you see from the map below there are several areas in the SW 1/4 that need to be fixed. I also realize that there are some issues in the SE 1/4 that you may wish to fix or amend. There are two things about farm drainage that cover this situation:

One is people, and the other is water flowing across the ground.

One of those things is easy to fix.

I have applied for a permit to fix my problems, but once I've installed the pipe and laterals underground that route will be closed off. **I am not going to change my plans after my permits have been approved.** We did that last time and it was a very expensive, stressful and time consuming process for us.

So, time is important. This is a serious deadline. If you want to work together, I'm willing. If you don't, that is your choice.




Dear Sirs:

After reviewing our historical records, your dam was constructed sometime prior to 1966 as our records show that our agency assisted with a repair in 1966. I assume that the original construction would have been in the 1950's. We also have records of our agency assisting with a second repair in 2000 when a full redesign was completed and a 24" corrugated polyethylene (CPE) smooth lined pipe was installed as the principal spillway. The secondary earthen spillway was widened at that time. The 24" pipe that was installed in 2000 was designed to meet a 2-year rainfall event of 2.6 inches with a peak flow of 199 cf/s. Any flow higher than that is designed to flow over the earthen spillway. Please note that any additional water added to the watershed will place unforeseen stress on both the earthen spillway and the principal spillway pipe and may require a larger pipe to be installed.

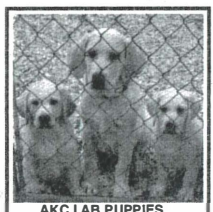

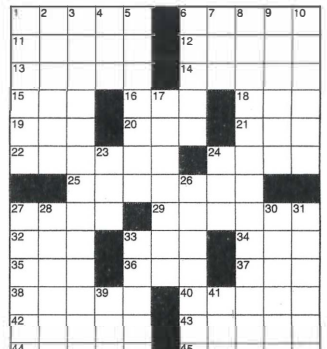

SDDOT Reminder: Election Signs Not Allowed In State Right Of Way

PIERRE —The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) reminds the public that political campaign and ballot-issue signs cannot be placed on state highway rights of way.

"This time of year, it is common to find election signs placed along the state's roadways," says Craig Smith, Director of Operations. "Illegal signs create a safety hazard and may distract motorists from seeing important regulatory or directional signing."

The use of right of way is reserved for official highway signage only. All signs in the right of way that are not required for traffic control, as authorized by law (SDCL 31-28-14), are prohibited and will be removed by SDDOT crews as they see them or when reported. If an illegally placed sign is removed by SDDOT staff, call the local SDDOT office to claim it.

Municipal ordinances regulating placement and removal of campaign signs within towns and cities do not have precedence over state jurisdiction and supervision of state highway rights of way within municipalities. Powell Kicks Off General Election With Focus On Costs

OMAHA, Neb. — Freshly minted Democratic U.S. House nominee Denise Powell, who co-founded a group that coached local women how to run for office, spent Thursday executing a lesson on how to pivot from a bruising primary to the general election. The business and nonprofit consultant in Nebraska's 2nd Congressional District started her pitch with a nod to the supporters of the candidates she bested, including longtime supporters of a major political family in Omaha politics.

She acknowledged her role in a "fiery" primary unusual for Nebraska Democrats and said she would give State Sen. John Cavanaugh and his family "their space" to wait for Friday's count of last-minute-retained early voting ballots.

"It was fiery because so many people see the opportunity and wanted to be part of the change," Powell said. "And every single person who was in this race was in it for the right reasons. They're in it because they want to bring about change."

The mother of two said she called reporters to a baseball field in east-central Omaha's Memorial Park because she was watching her son play at Memorial Little League Wednesday when she learned the Associated Press had called the race for her.

Powell then shared the contours of her general election bid, saying she looked forward to focusing the race on helping Congress take small and large steps toward making modern American life more affordable — from groceries to health care.

Among several steps she said she wants Congress to take is reasserting its constitutional authority over tariffs on trade and pulling that authority back from any president, including and especially from President Donald Trump.

She said she wants to help Congress find its ability to reclaim its traditional role of being the branch of American government that declares war and pull back from the destruction and chaos she says Trump's war against Iran

caused at home and abroad.

And she'd like to restore small business loan programs and other federal programs she says the Trump administration has pulled back from that matter to entrepreneurs. She founded her firm training business and nonprofit clients on communications.

"It is costing Americans billions of dollars ... while people here are going hungry," Powell said. "I think we need to put the brakes on this president. We are seeing him blow up our deficit, and this is something ... Republicans care about a lot."

She briefly acknowledged her joy at being the first Latina to headline a major party congressional race in Nebraska, and she said it was time for Democrats, Republicans and nonpartisans to "unify" against politicians that don't listen.

She said she expects a spirited general election race with GOP nominee Brinker Harding, an Omaha City Council member. Harding, in two statements and social media posts, has echoed some of Cavanaugh's attacks that called her "Dark Money Denise."

Harding, because he ran unopposed, kicked off his general election campaign on Election Day. He told a ballroom full of Republicans at the University of Nebraska at Omaha on Tuesday that he needed their energy to help him replace retiring GOP U.S. Rep. Don Bacon.

The ex-staffer for former U.S. Rep. Hal Daub, R-Neb., departed slightly from Bacon, who aimed squarely at the independent-minded voters in the middle who often decide 2nd District races. Harding instead fed the GOP crowd red meat and said he needs to excite Republicans to win.

He said the choice facing 2nd District voters is whether Omaha wants to become Zohran Mamdani's New York or Gavin Newsom's California. He emphasized his opposition to surgeries for minors who are trans and what he called men playing in women's sports.

"It's not about Republican or Democrat," Harding said. "It's not about MAGA [Make America Great Again] or TDS [Trump Derangement Syn-

drome]. This November's election is about normal versus crazy. And it's about common sense versus insanity."

On Thursday, Harding called Powell an "out-of-state and out-of-touch progressive activist" who had spent the primary campaign giving outside groups specific instructions on how to spend money to hurt her Democratic opponents and help her bid.

"Now, on the backs of nearly \$6 billion in Dark Money Dollars buying her primary victory over John Cavanaugh, Denise wants to pivot and pretend she cares about affordability and pocketbook issues," Harding tweeted after she declared victory.

Powell, asked about the ad spending and label from Harding and Cavanaugh, said voters appreciate that much of her support comes from people and groups who want more women, Latinas and people who support reproductive rights in Congress.

She noted the National Republican Congressional Committee's push to post a digital advertisement against her within minutes of the AP calling the race for her Wednesday evening. She said her team would be ready and willing to fight back.

"Powell, standing in the two-inch grass and weeds of a Little League outfield, said she would not let others define her and that she plans to get out and tell people who she really is and make sure people know she's in the race to help.

"At the end of the day, people don't care about politics and all of that crap," Powell said. "They just care about their survival, and there are families in this district who don't know that they're gonna make it to the end of the month."

World Briefly

Trump To Wrap Up China Visit

BEIJING (AP) — President Donald Trump is insistent that U.S.-China relations are good and getting better despite deep differences on key issues. During Thursday's talks in Beijing with Chinese President Xi Jinping, Trump expressed optimism about future cooperation. Xi said Thursday that he hoped both countries could be "partners, not rivals."

However, challenges remain, including China's limited involvement in resolving the Iran conflict. Xi privately warned Trump that their differences on the self-ruled island of Taiwan, if handled poorly, could hurtle the world's dominant powers toward an "extremely dangerous situation." Trump and Xi will meet again Friday for more talks before Trump returns to Washington.

Tensions Flare Near Strait Of Hormuz

DUBAI, United Arab Emirates (AP) — Tensions are escalating again near the Strait of Hormuz after a ship anchored off the United Arab Emirates was seized and taken toward Iran and another was attacked and sank near the coast of Oman.

The incidents reported on Thursday came as a senior Iranian official reiterated his country's claim to the waterway. Another Iranian official says Tehran has a right to seize oil tankers connected to the U.S. The British military says the ship seized near the UAE was moving toward Iranian territorial waters. The seizure comes as U.S. President Donald Trump meets with Chinese leader Xi Jinping in Beijing.

Emails Show FBI Director's Excursions

WASHINGTON (AP) — Government emails obtained by The Associated Press show that FBI Director Kash Patel went on a "VIP snorkel" session last summer at the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor. The FBI didn't publicize the excursion or Patel's return to Hawaii after official visits to Australia and New Zealand.

With few exceptions, snorkeling and diving are off-limits around the USS Arizona. The battleship is now a military cemetery reachable only by boat. It has stood as one of the nation's most hallowed sites since Japan bombed and sank the ship in 1941. A Navy spokesperson confirms the outing but says the service wasn't able to track down who initiated it.

Southern States Continue Gerrymander

State senators in Louisiana have passed a new congressional map after the U.S. Supreme Court struck down the previous one. The new plan would eliminate a majority-Black district, giving Republicans a chance to win an additional seat in the November midterm elections.

The plan now goes to the House for consideration. Louisiana must redraw its House map because the court ruled it illegally used race to gerrymander its districts. The court ruling weakening the Voting Rights Act has spawned a wave of redistricting efforts in Southern states. South Carolina's governor has called a special legislative session to start Friday on congressional redistricting.

Court Allows Access To Abortion Pill, For Now

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Supreme Court has preserved women's access to a drug used in the most common method of abortion, rejecting lower-court restrictions while a lawsuit continues. The court's order Thursday allows women seeking abortions to continue obtaining the drug, mifepristone, at pharmacies or through the mail, without an in-person visit to a doctor.

Access is likely to remain uninterrupted at least until well into next year as appeals play out in a suit filed by Louisiana, including a potential appeal to the high court. The court is dealing with its latest abortion controversy four years after its conservative majority overturned Roe v. Wade and allowed more than a dozen states to effectively ban abortion outright.

Right Wing Influencer Arrested In Tennessee

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — A Tennessee man who goes by the moniker Chud the Builder and is known for posting racist videos is charged with attempted murder. Dalton Eatherly posted audio to social media on Wednesday admitting to shooting a man who he says hit him.

He says the shooting was self-defense. Eatherly also notes that he shot himself in the arm. Eatherly, who is white, posts videos to social media where he tries to provoke Black passersby by using racial slurs and racist dog whistles. He has claimed it is free speech, but the fact that he also openly carries a pistol could make it a crime under Tennessee law.

CIA Director Meets With Castro Grandson

HAVANA (AP) — Cuban and U.S. officials say that CIA Director John Ratcliffe has met with Cuban officials including Raúl Castro's grandson during a high-level visit to the island.

Ratcliffe met with Raúl Guillermo Rodríguez Castro, Interior Minister Lázaro Álvarez Casas and the head of Cuban intelligence services, and discussed intelligence cooperation, economic stability and security issues. A CIA official confirmed the meetings to the AP. Ratcliffe was there "to personally deliver President Donald Trump's message that the United States is prepared to seriously engage on economic and security issues, but only if Cuba makes fundamental changes."

large deficits in the volume of water.
"We are very dependent on the higher elevations," he said.
The U.S. Drought Monitor weekly report, released Thursday, reflects the continuing dry conditions around the Yankton region.
In southeast South Dakota, moderate drought exists in Hutchinson, Bon Homme, Yankton, Turner, Clay, Union, Lincoln and Minnehaha counties, with abnormally dry conditions in Charles Mix and Douglas counties.
In northeast Nebraska, moderate drought exists in all or parts of Boyd, Holt, Knox, Cedar, Dixon, Antelope, Pierce and Madison counties, with abnormally dry conditions in Dakota, Wayne and Stanton counties.
"There is still plenty of time to make up for lost snowfall," Hoylman said.
The National Weather Service (NWS) has issued a winter weather advisory until 6 p.m. today (Friday) for nearly all of southeast South Dakota and a large portion of northeast Nebraska.
The outlook calls for a 70% chance of snow and blowing snow, with winds gusting as high as 55 miles per hour (mph). The total snow accumulations are expected to be less than an inch, with isolated pockets of 2 inches.
The strong winds and snowfall will result in visibility as low as one-half mile. Conditions may rapidly change over short distances.
In addition, the NWS has issued a high wind warning for Charles Mix and Douglas counties of southeast South Dakota, while a wind advisory is in effect for much of northeast Nebraska.
Temperatures and windchills will plummet this weekend, the NWS added.
The NWS' short-term precipitation forecast calls for no new precipitation because of a strong high-pressure system. The 6- to 10-day temperature outlook leans toward cooler than normal or normal readings.
The Climate Prediction Center gives its 8- to 14-day outlook as above-normal precipitation in the upper basin, which helps move precipitation across the region.
For February, the upper Missouri River Basin looks to be cooler than normal, with equal chances for precipitation to be below, above- or normal.
The forecast calls for the current weak La Nina weather system

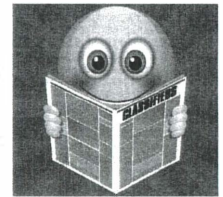
