**Background:** The cities of Vermillion and Yankton as well as the counties of Clay and Yankton entered into a Joint Powers agreement in 1994. The operating agreement has had nine amendments over time. The members of the Joint Powers Board are:

Vermillion City Councilmember Vermillion resident Clay County Commissioner Clay County resident Vermillion City Manager Yankton City Commissioner Yankton resident Yankton County Commissioner Yankton County resident Yankton City Manager

The Vermillion and Yankton Finance Officers serve as the secretary-financial advisors for the Board.

The purpose of the agreement was to establish a system to jointly operate a solid waste disposal and recycling system. There are currently three main facilities for the Joint Powers operation. A transfer station in Yankton collects trash from the Yankton City collection and private haulers for transportation to the landfill. The landfill and Vermillion recycling center are also part of the Joint Powers operation.

**Discussion:** Included in the 2025 Joint Powers Budget is funding for the purchase of a dozer. The cost to fund the equipment is just over \$511,000. The City of Vermillion applied for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and grant. At their meeting in March 2025, the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources (DANR) Board approved a \$409,100 Solid Waste Management loan and a \$102,200 Solid Waste Management grant. The loan term is 3.25 percent for seven years.

The DANR loan is contingent upon the four parties of the Joint Powers agreement each adopting an amendment to the agreement recognizing the new loan. A copy of the amendment is attached. The main point of the amendment is to stipulate that the Joint Powers agreement will not be dissolved prior to the repayment of the 2025 SRF loan along with other loans included in prior amendments. Most of the previous amendments to the original agreement have also been due to grant/loan financing packages.

The Board of Water and Natural Resources has asked that the four parties to the Joint Powers agreement adopt an amendment to the agreement. The City of Vermillion Council and Clay County Commission have already considered the amendment at a meeting. The amendment is scheduled to be on July agendas of the Yankton City Commission and the Yankton County Commission. 416 Walnut St

*Financial Consideration:* The agreement obligates the County of Yankton to participate in the Joint Powers agreement through the end of repayment of the outstanding loans.

#### TENTH AMENDMENT TO REVISED JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

THIS TENTH AMENDMENT TO REVISED JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT, dated as of June 16, 2025 (the "Tenth Amendment"), by and among the City of Vermillion, South Dakota, a municipal corporation of the State of South Dakota (the "Issuer"); the City of Yankton, South Dakota, a municipal corporation of the State of South Dakota; Yankton County, South Dakota, a political subdivision of the State of South Dakota and Clay County, South Dakota, a political subdivision of the State of South Dakota (together with the Issuer, hereinafter referred to as the "Owners").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Owners have entered into a Revised Joint Powers Agreement, dated November 14, 2012, as amended through a Ninth Amendment to Revised Joint Powers Agreement dated October 17, 2023 (the "Original Agreement"; the Revised Agreement as amended and supplemented by this Tenth Amendment is referred to hereinafter as the "Revised Agreement") for purpose of providing for the joint ownership, administration and operation of a solid waste disposal and recycling system (the "System"); and

WHEREAS, in order to finance the acquisition of certain equipment for the benefit of the System, the Issuer has agreed to borrow the sum of up to \$511,344.01 from the from the Solid Waste Management Program (such loan, to the extent actually disbursed, the "2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan"), by entering into a Solid Waste Management Loan Program Loan Agreement with, and issuing a Revenue Bond to, the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources, and the other Owners have agreed to pay to the Issuer amounts equal to their respective shares of costs under the 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan, including their respective share of the debt service on the 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan; and

WHEREAS, the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources has required, as a condition to making the 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan, that the Owners make certain changes to the Original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Owners have found that the financing provided through the 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan is advantageous, and in order to secure that financing have agreed to amend certain provisions of the Original Agreement as set forth in this Tenth Amendment; and

WHEREAS, in order to finance certain improvements to the System and equipment for the System, the Issuer has borrowed from the South Dakota State Revolving Fund (the "2013 SRF Loan," the "2021 SRF Loan," and the "2023 SRF Loan"); and the Issuer has previously borrowed from the Solid Waste Management Program (the "2017 Vermillion SWMP Loan"); and the City of Yankton has borrowed from the Solid Waste Management Program (the "Yankton SWMP Loan"); and the Owners have agreed, pursuant to the Original Agreement, to pay to the Issuer amounts equal to their respective shares of the debt service on the 2013 SRF Loan, the 2021 SRF Loan, the 2023 SRF Loan, the 2017 Vermillion SWMP Loan, and the Yankton SWMP Loan; and

#### NOW, THEREFORE, THIS TENTH AMENDMENT WITNESSETH:

1. That section 8 of the Original Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 Financial Management: Operational budget shall be contained in the budget of responsible operating entity. The City of Yankton shall maintain the budget for operations in Yankton and Yankton County, and the City of Vermillion shall maintain the budget for operations in Vermillion and Clay County. All expenditures and revenues associated with the joint operation shall be maintained in a separate fund from all other expenditures of the City. The joint operation shall be considered an enterprise for accounting purposes and shall be self-supporting. All moneys contained in the fund belonging to the joint operation shall remain in that fund and shall not be transferred to any other fund of the city without the approval of the governing bodies of all entities that are parties to this Revised Agreement. All expenditures from the joint operations fund shall be approved by the governing body, which is responsible for the budget that contains the joint operation. There shall be established a renewal and replacement fund which shall contain all depreciation funds and any return on assets that are generated by the joint operation. The depreciation shall be based on general accepted accounting principles and shall be an expense item in the budget of the joint operation. The rates for the disposal of solid waste and the handling of recyclable materials shall be sufficient to defray all of the costs of the joint operation including, but not limited to, operational expenses, depreciation, post closure expenses, financial assurance, ground water monitoring and corrective action. State and Federal fees, and such other expenses as may be appropriate.

The fees shall be established upon the recommendation of the board with the approval of all of the governing bodies of the cities of Yankton and Vermillion. This action on the recommendation shall take place within thirty days of the recommendation of the Board. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Revised Agreement, the rates, charges and fees established under this paragraph shall always be made sufficient to pay the costs of operation and maintenance of the system and to meet the rate covenant set forth in the Revenue Obligation Loan Agreement with the South Dakota Conservancy District and Board of Water and Natural Resources, so long as the 2013 SRF Loan, 2017 Vermillion SWMP Loan, Yankton SWMP Loan, 2021 SRF Loan, 2023 SRF Loan, or 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan are in effect and unpaid.

Section 2. That Section 13 of the Original Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>13. Duration</u>: This Revised Agreement shall be in effect for thirty-five years from the date of execution of this Revised Agreement with an option to renew the Revised Agreement for another period not to exceed thirty-five years by agreement of all of the parties. This Revised Agreement may be dissolved at any time by agreement of the governing bodies of three of the four of the parties to this Revised Agreement; provided that this Revised Agreement shall not be dissolved, nor shall any party withdraw there from, until the 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan (Vermillion [\_\_\_]), 2023 SRF Loan (Vermillion CW-11), 2021 SRF Loan (Vermillion CW-09), 2017 Vermillion SWMP Loan (Vermillion 2017L-SW-401), Yankton SWMP Loan (Yankton 2016L-SW-301), and 2013 SRF Loan (Vermillion

Series 2013 loan 461022-07), have been paid in full and any other previous loans have met obligations.

Section 3. That Section 14 of the Original Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>14. Amendments:</u> This Revised Agreement may be amended, modified, or altered only by agreement of three of the four parties to this Revised Agreement. It is recognized and anticipated that amendments may be necessary from time to time due to unforeseen or unanticipated circumstances and it shall be considered to be appropriate for suggestions or recommendations for amendments to originate with the Advisory Board or with staff. So long as the 2013 SRF Loan, 2017 Vermillion SWMP Loan, Yankton SWMP Loan, 2021 SRF Loan, 2023 SRF Loan, or 2025 Vermillion SWMP Loan are in effect and unpaid, no amendment shall be made to Sections 8, 13, 14 hereof, without the written consent of the South Dakota Conservancy District and Board of Water and Natural Resources.

Sub-section a. This Revised Agreement and all its provisions which incorporate all previous amendment language and corrections to the Original Agreement remain in full force and effect, and from and after the date hereof and shall be construed as "the Revised Agreement" instrument.

Sub-section b. If any provision of this document shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact be inoperative or unenforceable as applied in any particular case in any jurisdiction or jurisdictions or in all jurisdictions or in all cases because it conflicts with any provisions of any constitution or statute or rule of public policy, or for any other reason, such circumstances shall not have the effect of rendering the provision in question inoperative or unenforceable in any other case or circumstance or rendering any other provision or provisions herein contained invalid, inoperative, or unenforceable to any extent whatever.

The invalidity of any one or more phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs in this Revised Agreement contained shall not affect the remaining portions of this Revised Agreement or part thereof.

Sub-section c. This Revised Agreement may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

Section 4. Except as amended by this Tenth Amendment, the provisions of the Original Agreement remain in full force and effect, and from and after the date hereof, the Original Agreement and this Tenth Amendment shall be construed as one instrument.

Section 5. If any provision of this Tenth Amendment shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact be inoperative or unenforceable as applied in any particular case in any jurisdiction or jurisdictions or in all jurisdictions or in all public policy, or for any reason, such circumstances shall not have the effect of rendering the provision in question inoperative or unenforceable in any other case or circumstance or of rendering any other provision or provisions herein contained invalid, inoperative, or unenforceable to any extent whatever.

The invalidity of any one or more phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs in this Tenth Amendment contained shall not affect the remaining portions of this Tenth Amendment or part thereof.

Section 6. This Tenth Amendment may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

# **ARTICLE 6**

# LOW DENSITY RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R1)

#### Section 601 Intent

The intent of Low Density Rural Residential Districts (R1) is to provide for residential uses of larger lots and other compatible uses in a pleasant and stable environment.

## Section 603 Permitted Principal Uses and Structures

The following principal uses and structures shall be permitted in a Low Density Rural Residential District (R1):

- 1. Day cares, family;
- 2. Dwellings, single-family;
- 3. Governmental services;
- 4. Horticulture;
- 5. Modular homes; (Amended December 19, 2023) and
- 6. Solar Energy Conversion Systems (SECS) under 50 Kilowatts alternating current (AC) (Amended December 19, 2023) and
- 7. A person may possess up to six (6) chicken hens, so long as the hens are confined. No roosters are allowed. The confined hens must be located at a minimum setback of twenty-five feet (25') from any property line and may not be located in the front yard. In addition, when kept in the ordinary course of business, fowl may be temporarily kept at a public auction ring, veterinary clinics and treatment facilities, locker plants and hatcheries. Fowl may also be transported through the County.

# ARTICLE 7

# MODERATE DENSITY RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R2)

#### Section 701 Intent

The intent of Moderate Density Rural Residential Districts (R2) is to provide for residential uses of moderate lots and other compatible uses in a pleasant and stable environment.

#### Section 703 Permitted Principal Uses and Structures

The following principal uses and structures shall be permitted in a Moderate Density Rural Residential District (R2):

- 1. Day cares, family;
- 2. Dwellings, single-family;
- 3. Governmental services;
- 4. Horticulture;
- 5. Modular homes; (Amended December 19, 2023)
- 6. Utility facilities. and (Amended December 19, 2023)
- 7. Solar Energy Conversion Systems (SECS) under 50 kilowatts alternating current (AC). (Amended December 19, 2023) and
- 8. A person may possess up to six (6) chicken hens, so long as the hens are confined. No roosters are allowed. The confined hens must be located at a minimum setback of twenty-five feet (25') from any property line and may not be located in the front yard. In addition, when kept in the ordinary course of business, fowl may be temporarily kept at a public auction ring, veterinary clinics and treatment facilities, locker plants and hatcheries. Fowl may also be transported through the County.

# **ARTICLE 8**

## HIGH DENSITY RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R3)

#### Section 807 Conditional Uses

After the provisions of this Ordinance, relating to conditional uses have been fulfilled, the Board of Adjustment may permit as conditional uses in a High Density Rural Residential Districts (R3): (Amended June 21, 2022)

- 1. Day cares, group family home;
- 2. Dwellings, multi-family;
- 3. Dwellings, two family;
- 4. Manufactured homes, pursuant to Section 1507;
- 5. Parks;
- 6. Signs, off-site;
- 7. Towers; and
- 8. One Accessory Structure exceeding 1,600 square feet or Accessory Structures with an aggregate maximum floor area exceeding 1,600 square feet and/or exceeding a sidewall height of twelve (12) feet and (Amended May 19, 2020)
- 9. Utility Facilities; and
- 10. A person may possess up to six (6) chicken hens, so long as the hens are confined. No roosters are allowed. The confined hens must be located at a minimum setback of twenty-five feet (25') from any property line and may not be located in the front yard. In addition, when kept in the ordinary course of business, fowl may be temporarily kept at a public auction ring, veterinary clinics and treatment facilities, locker plants and hatcheries. Fowl may also be transported through the County.

#### Public Defender Contract

This contract entered into  $\underline{\text{the}}_{fd}$  day of May, 2022, and pursuant to the terms and conditions of SDCL 23A-40 *et seg.*, by and between YANKTON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, a subdivision of the State of South Dakota ("COUNTY") and Luci Youngberg, Esquire ("ATTORNEY" or "FIRM").

### ARTICLE I TERMS

- A. The term of this agreement is from June 1, 2022 through May 31, 2025.
- B. This agreement shall automatically renew under the same terms and conditions unless either party gives 90 days written notice of their intention not to renew the contract.

### ARTICLE II

### APPOINTMENT AS PUBLIC DEFENDER

- A. During the term of this agreement Attorney shall, when duly appointed by a judge or magistrate, provide the following professional services in Yankton County, South Dakota as public defender:
  - All indigent criminal defendants and detained persons charged with misdemeanor offenses appearing in magistrate court entitled to appointment of counsel pursuant to SDCL 23A-40-6 in conjunction with the other public defender contract for magistrate, abuse and neglect, and juvenile matters.
  - All representation of indigent children or the children's parents, guardian or other custodian in proceedings under SDCL Chapters 26-7A, 26-8A, 26-8B or 26-6C, pursuant to SDCL 26-7A-52 and 26-9A-18 in conjunction with the other public defender contract for magistrate, abuse and neglect, and juvenile matters.
  - Attorney reserves the right of first refusal to assume the duties associated with the public defender contract of Dan Fox, Esquire should be terminate his contract with the County.
- B. The Attorney shall not be appointed to represent the above-described clients when:
  - 1. The representation would be directly adverse to another client constituting a conflict of interest pursuant to the ethical code.

- 2. The representation is for post-conviction relief including appeals and habeas corpus proceedings.
- C. Attorney shall perform services under this contract in a manner consistent with applicable statues, rules of the Court and the Code of Ethical Conduct.

### ARTICLE III ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

- A. Attorney shall maintain professional liability insurance and furnish proof of coverage to County, if requested.
- B. Attorney shall maintain a record for each indigent client itemizing Attorney's times, charges and expenses incurred, and shall submit these statements to the Court within thirty (30) days after the entry of a dismissal, judgment of conviction or suspension of imposition of sentence in criminal cases, or in an order constituting a final order in a case was entered. Failure to submit a timely bill may result in the County being entitled to an offset against the contract for the amount that should have been submitted.
- C. Attorney shall maintain a record of the reasons for declaration of conflict in every case.
- D. The County may request any or all such records for the declaration of a conflict upon demand. The parties agree that such declaration of conflict need not divulge privileged information.

### ARTICLE IV COUNTY'S PERFORMANCE

- A. The County shall pay Attorney the sum of \$2,500 per month for each full calendar month beginning June 2022.
- B. This amount shall be increased at the end of each contract year based upon the same percentage increase for Yankton County employees for said calendar year.
- C. Payment shall be made at the first regular meeting of the Yankton County Board of Commissioners which is scheduled for the payment of claims, but in no event less frequently than once a month. In the event this contract is terminated as hereinafter provided prior to the end of the month, the County shall pay Attorney for all services rendered to the date of the termination on a pro-rata basis.

### ARTICLE V EXPENSES

- A. In exchange for the payment set forth in Article IV, Attorney shall assume responsibility for all expenses related to the completion of Attorney's duties. Said expenses shall include, but not be limited to support staff, necessary mileage within Yankton County, long distance telephone calls, copies and postage.
- B. County shall reimburse Attorney for the following expenses relating to representation of indigents under this Contract as follows:
  - 1. Necessary mileage outside of Yankton County at the state rate;
  - 2. Subpoena expenses;
  - 3. Witness fees shall be paid by the County pursuant to SDCL 23A-14-3;
  - 4. Investigative expenses, expert witness expenses, fees charged by other agencies for copies and records, and exhibit preparation expenses will also be reimbursed by the County, but only after Court approval for such expenses.

### ARTICLE VI INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

- A. Attorney shall at all times during and after the expiration of this contract remain an independent contractor as that term is defined by case law and state statute. Attorney understands that at no time will the members of the Attorney or its agents be considered employees of or partners with the County. Attorney will retain discretion over the manner in which the duties under this contract are performed and shall retain the final decision on all professional and legal issues required for case management.
- B. Attorney will be responsible for payment of its income taxes, FICA, withholding and other wage related obligations. Attorney and its attorneys and agents will not be considered employees of the State of South Dakota or County for purposes of retirement, insurance programs or other benefits.

### ARTICLE VII

### TERMINATION

- A. This contract may be terminated by mutual agreement of both parties in writing.
- B. Further, this contract may be terminated on 30 days notice by a majority vote of the County Commission. Termination must be based on performance deficiency rising to levels egregious enough to constitute substandard representation of clients, ineffective assistance of counsel, or unsatisfactory performance of other provisions of this contract.

C. In the event this contract is terminated by mutual agreement, by the expiration of this contract, or terminated by the County with good cause, Attorney shall continue to represent its indigent clients to the conclusion of their cases or appointment of substitute counsel, and the County shall pay Attorney according to the hourly billing policies of the Unified Judicial System; and Attorney shall be further reimbursed by County for those expenses enumerated herein.

### ARTICLE VII SEVERABILITY

Should any part of this agreement be declared to be illegal, unconstitutional or unenforceable, the rest, residue and remainder of this contract is to remain in full force and effect. The rest of the contract shall be interpreted without reference to that part so declared illegal, unconstitutional or unenforceable.
