



# 2025 South Dakota Legislature

# House Bill 1043

Introduced by: Representative Emery

An Act to require counties and municipalities to provide emergency medical services within their jurisdictions, increase liquidated court costs, and create the emergency medical services fund and make an appropriation therefor.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

### Section 1. That § 23-3-52 be AMENDED:

**23-3-52.** In addition to any other penalty, assessment, or fine provided by law, there—shall\_must be levied liquidated costs—in the amount of fifty-five dollars for partial reimbursement to state government and its subdivisions for—law enforcement and judicial expenses incurred in providing the personnel, training, and facilities, relative to the criminal justice system and—to—the—911 emergency—reporting response system, on each conviction for the following:

- (1) Violation of state statutes or <u>regulations</u> rules having criminal penalties; or
- (2) Violation of county or municipal ordinances.

If a fine is suspended in whole or in part, the liquidated costs for law enforcement and training may not be reduced, except that the judge may waive all or any part of the payment of liquidated costs-which that would work be a hardship on the person convicted or on the person's immediate family.

## Section 2. That § 23-3-53 be AMENDED:

23-3-53. After a determination by the court of the amount <u>due</u>, as provided in § 23-3-52, the clerk of courts shall collect the amount due and transmit the amount monthly to the state treasurer. The state treasurer shall-<u>place-thirty-seven</u> distribute the fifty-five dollars in liquidated costs as follows:

(1) Thirty-seven dollars of the fifty dollar fee into the law enforcement officers training fund, seven;

1	(2) Seven dollars and fifty cents of the fifty dollar fee into the court appointed attorney
2	and public defender payment fund <del>, two</del> ;
3	(3) Five dollars into the emergency medical services fund established in section 5 of
4	this Act;
5	(4) Two dollars of the fifty dollar fee into the court appointed special advocates fund,
6	two;
7	(5) Two dollars and fifty cents-of-the-fifty-dollar-fee into the 911 telecommunicator
8	training fund <sub>7</sub> ; and- <del>one</del>
9	(6) One dollar of the fifty dollar fee into the abused and neglected child defense fund.
10	Section 3. That § 34-11-1 be AMENDED:
11	<b>34-11-1.</b> A county or municipality may:
12	(1) Provide shall provide, or contract for the provision of, ambulance services; and
13	(2) Contract within its jurisdiction.
14	A county or municipality may contract with another political subdivision or other
15	person for the provision of moneys to support to provide ambulance services.
16	Section 4. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:
17	Each county and municipality shall ensure that a minimum level of emergency
18	medical service is available within its jurisdiction for prehospital emergency medical
19	treatment and transport.
20	The department shall promulgate rules, in accordance with chapter 1-26, to
21	establish minimum levels of emergency medical service that must be available within a
22	county and municipality. The rules must address:
23	(1) Response times;
24	(2) Required staff and licensed personnel;
25	(3) Treatment and transport protocols; and
26	(4) Quality assurance standards.
27	Section 5. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:
28	There is created in the state treasury the emergency medical services fund.
29	The fund consists of liquidated costs, as provided in § 23-3-53, and all other
30	moneys designated for deposit in the fund. Interest on moneys credited to the fund must
31	remain in the fund.

11	The emergency medical services fund is continuously appropriated to the

13	Section 6. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:
14	To be eligible for a grant from the emergency medical services fund, a county or
15	municipality must:
16	(1) Submit an application in the time and manner prescribed by the department, as
17	provided in section 8 of this Act; and
18	(2) Demonstrate that the county or municipality has insufficient moneys or is unable
19	to raise sufficient moneys, to meet the minimum levels of emergency medica
20	services or maintain emergency medical services personnel.
21	Section 7. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:
22	In awarding grants pursuant to section 5 of this Act, the department shall prioritize
23	(1) Counties with a population of five thousand or fewer;
24	(2) Municipalities with a population of one thousand or fewer; and
25	(3) Counties and municipalities that collaborate in the provision of emergency medica
26	services.
27	Section 8. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:
28	The department shall promulgate rules, in accordance with chapter 1-26, to
29	establish:
30	(1) An application process for grants from the emergency medical services fund;
31	(2) A timeline for the submission of applications and selection of awardees;

- 2 (4) A process for the disbursement of grants.
- The department shall make the grant application available on its website.

### 4 Section 9. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-11:

- On or before August 1, 2026, and on or before August first of each year thereafter,
- 6 the department shall submit a report to the special committee created by § 4-8A-2, for
- 7 the previous fiscal year, on:
- 8 (1) The counties and municipalities that received grants from the emergency medical
- 9 <u>services fund;</u>
- 10 (2) The amount of each grant awarded; and
- 11 (3) The intended use of the grant by the county or municipality.
- 12 **Section 10.** The state treasurer shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the general fund to the
- 13 emergency medical services fund created in section 5 of this Act.
- **Section 11.** This Act is effective beginning June 30, 2025.

### PUBLIC INFORMATION MEMO

The Board of Clay County Commissioners has passed a Resolution for Opt Out for 2025 property taxes payable in 2026 in the amount of \$750,000. The Board of County Commissioners take this opportunity to convey to the taxpayers that the opt out was a necessary step to operate the county government without cuts to services and personnel.

The Board began work in 2018 to replace the aging county facilities and has faced unprecedented expenses since the jail was transitioned to a temporary holding facility in 2021. After a bond issue to replace the jail, law enforcement center, and courthouse failed in 2021, a subsequent bond issue was passed to replace the jail and law enforcement center. Inmates were housed at other jails, increasing costs for the county, creating the need for opt out resolutions in several subsequent tax years. While the new Public Safety Center has been under construction, renovations have been underway in the courthouse to make the existing facilities better serve county government needs. More renovations will take place in 2026, bringing the County's cost of all planned courthouse and current safety center projects to an estimated \$4.34 million, with grant funding covering an additional \$336,000 in construction, for a total of \$4.68 million.

In addition, the software program(s) used by all county offices have become obsolete and unavailable, leaving the Commissioners no option but to purchase new software programs, at cost of approximately \$350,000 from the period of 2021-2026.

The County's agreement with the City for Vermillion/Clay County EMS includes replacement of an ambulance every five years at the County's cost. The County purchased an ambulance in 2023 at a cost of \$248,000. Due to ongoing mechanical issues with an existing ambulance, rapidly escalating costs, and an approximate delivery timeline of 18 months from the date of order, the Commissioners authorized the order of a replacement ambulance ahead of the normal replacement schedule. The cost is \$361,000.

County officials have requested additional staff for 2026 to mitigate increasing workloads, but only the most essential staff were added for operation of the new Public Safety Center. The personnel requests from other offices were denied as funds were not available without a larger opt out. Other budgetary requests were also reduced or eliminated from the departments' budgets.

Changes in salary or wage rates are normally made on an annual basis in December of each year, with any adjustments to be effective January 1<sup>st</sup> of the following year. Pay increases will only be considered during the budgeting process.

#### **612 POSITION CHANGES**

<u>New Positions</u> - New positions may be requested by the Department Head. The County Commission must approve all new positions and the position's associated pay grade. New position requests will typically be considered as part of the annual budget process. When necessary, new job descriptions will be developed in cooperation with the Department Head.

Re-filling Current Positions during Hiring Freeze – At the discretion of the County Commission, current positions may be re-filled during a hiring freeze. Department Heads must submit a justification letter to re-fill to the Commission for review, which will then be added as a meeting agenda item at next meeting date for approval or denial.

<u>Transfers</u> - County employees may apply for job openings in other County departments. If the new position is at the same level of responsibility as the current position, the employee will receive the same rate of pay.
