

Yankton County Register of Deeds 2021 Report

Yankton County Register of Deeds staff collected an office record \$418,773 in total fees in 2021. That total includes \$176,337 in Land Transfer Fees resulting from a county record \$176.3 million in sales of residential properties, commercial properties and farmland last year.

Register of Deeds staff completed over 8,000 transactions in 2021 involving vital records, land records, copy requests and liens. Records, reports, requests and documents processed by ROD last year included:

Notes: Yankton County grew by 872 people (3.9 percent) from 2010 to 2020. Yankton County grew by 786 people (3.6 percent) from 2000 to 2010.

Our county population quadrupled (+6,293) during the Dakota Boom of Homesteaders from 1870 to 1880. Since then, Yankton County has settled into an average growth of 1,066 people every 10 years.

The only 10-year decline in County's population history occurred in 1980 when Census showed a decrease of 87 people from 1970.
