Notes & Public Input

Road Improvement

- Mike, Yankton County Superintendent, started the meeting by saying Yankton County Highway Department does a 5-Year Plan each year so that Yankton County can apply for grant money.
- The first item discussed was the Revenue Table which shows the breakdown of the various sources of income for budgeting for the plan.
- Mike discussed the roads being worked on for each year. He used maps of Yankton County showing which category of work the roads were assigned for each year. The roads fell into three basic groups: Crack Seal, Asphalt Overlay, and Chip Seal. The order these categories needed to be followed was pointed out.
- A Project Plan for each year was also provided. The data on these sheets listed the specific areas
 on the roads being repaired. This information provides the county residents with information on
 planned upcoming work.
- There was a question on 294th Street as this road was ground up and the dust is bad. The person wanted to know what could be done and if the road would be hard surfaced again. Also there was a question on 304th as to whether this would become a hard surface road again.
- One person asked about the shoulders on the roads as they are needing attention from when larger equipment has to pull over onto the shoulder to allow traffic to pass.
- There was a question on micro surfacing and if it could be used. The cost and benefits of this type of road maintenance were compared to chip sealing.
- A Project Status List for roads showed where the county is on the chip seal, edge repair/patch and crack seal. It shows the number of completed projects and those in progress or cancelled.

Bridge Repair/Replacement

- Mike said the goal was to replace 1-2 bridges every year if possible.
- The use of steel structures was discussed in conjunction with the impact that weather, water and salt have on them.
- Mike said that using concrete bridges for hard surface roads and steel culverts on gravel roads is the plan. Also the use of hydraulic studies and 2 year inspections were mentioned as factors in determining bridge replacements
- Two bridges have already been replaced by using multiple culverts and rip rap per bridge.
- The Sufficiency Rating information on the Yankton County bridges showed which bridges had a sufficiency rating above 60. The list indicated the number of bridges with this higher rating is increasing. The goal is to continue to increase the number of bridges to this level or above.
- The Project Status List for Bridges showed the status on bridges replaced or to be replaced. This list showed which bridges could be eligible for grants.
