

Yankton County Register of Deeds 2020 Report

Yankton County Register of Deeds staff collected \$344,130 in fees in 2020. That total includes \$119,276 in Land Transfer Fees from \$119.3 million in sales of residential properties, commercial properties and farmland last year.

Yankton County Register of Deeds staff completed over 9,000 transactions in 2020 involving vital records, land records, copy requests and liens. Records, reports and documents processed by ROD staff in 2020 include:
