

## YANKTON COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

January 28, 2019

A special meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chairman Dan Klimisch at 9:00 am Monday, January 28, 2019.

Roll call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Gary Swensen, Cheri Loest, Joseph Healy, Dan Klimisch; Absent: Don Kettering.

There were no conflicts of interest reported by Commissioners.

**Action 1929C:** A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Swensen to approve the meeting agenda with the following additions: guest speaker at planning and zoning meeting and snow removal. All present voted aye; motion carried.

There was one public comment from Louis Johnson.

**Action 1930C:** A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Healy to approve the bid from Loiseau Construction, Inc. for Grind with layback process from Brown County bid dated February 27, 2018. All present voted aye; motion carried.

**Action 1931C:** A motion was made by Healy and seconded by Loest to approve the resolution for no through trucks signs on Deer Boulevard between Highway 314 and Highway 50. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Commissioner Healy said Gregg Hubner will be a guest speaker at the March, 2019 Planning and Zoning meeting. The board also discussed snow removal. There was one public comment by Jody Kludt.
