

YANKTON COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

May 13, 2019

A special meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chairman Dan Klimisch at 3:30 pm Monday, May 13, 2019.

Roll call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Cheri Loest, Joseph Healy, Gary Swensen, Don Kettering and Dan Klimisch.

There were no conflicts of interest reported by Commissioners.

Action 19206C: A motion was made by Kettering and seconded by Healy to approve the meeting agenda. All present voted aye; motion carried.

There was a public comment from Craig Ernster.

There was a public comment from Jerry Webber.

Action 19207C: A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Kettering to approve to add infertility coverage with the health insurance renewal with Wellmark BC/BS. Roll call vote was taken with Loest, Healy, Swensen, Kettering and Klimisch voting Aye; Motion carried 5-0.

Action 19208C: A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Kettering, dependent on availability of the Treasurer's office, to approve a temporary employee at a maximum cost of \$21/hour which is based on a \$15/hour work rate for 25 hours per week until office is being staffed and services are no longer needed. Roll call vote was taken with Loest, Healy, Klimisch voting Aye; Swensen and Kettering voting Nay; Motion carried 3-2.

Action 19209C: A motion was made by Swensen and seconded by Loest to adjourn. All present voted aye; motion carried.
