The Auditor presented contingency transfers as follows. Commissioners \$44,800; Elections \$6,050; Auditor \$31,150; Treasurer \$7,200; Data \$6,200; Director of Equalization \$1,300; Coroner \$29,600; Public Health Nurse \$2,550; Mental Illness Board \$30,150; Jail Building \$8,165.

**Action 17393A:** A motion was made by Woods and seconded by Bodenstedt to approve the contingency transfers as presented. All present voted aye; motion carried.

**Action 17394C:** A motion was made by Epp and seconded by Woods to approve the budgeted cash transfer of \$50,000.00 from the General Fund to Emergency Management Services. All present voted aye; motion carried.

The County Auditor presented the 2018 meeting calendar. Commissioner Woods stated he would like to include the dates when agenda requests are due.

**Dakota Plains**: Matt Winsand, general manager of Dakota Plains, appeared before the board to discuss the Dakota Plains Ag Center and business opportunities. Winsand also thanked the board for their continued support.

**Action 17395C**: A motion was made by Woods and seconded by Epp to adjourn. All present voted aye; motion carried.
