YANKTON COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

October 4, 2022

The regular meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chairman Joe Healy at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 4, 2022.

Roll call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Dan Klimisch, Cheri Loest, Don Kettering, Wanda Howey-Fox and Joe Healy.

There were no conflicts of interest reported by Commissioners.

Action 22391C: A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Fox to approve the meeting agenda with removal of Item 8. All present voted aye; motion carried, 5-0.

There were public comments from Louis Johnson and Lauren Nelson. Chairman Healy closed public comment.

Register of Deeds Brian Hunhoff appeared before the board to ask for approval of Native American Day as an official county holiday in 2022 and years to follow.

Action 22392C: A motion was made by Klimisch and seconded by Loest to close Monday, Oct. 10 for Native American Day. Klimisch, Loest and Healy voted aye; Fox and Kettering voted nay; motion carried, 3-2.

Commissioner Loest asked that amending of the employee handbook's county holiday schedule be included on the agenda for the Tuesday, Oct. 18 meeting.

Highway Superintendent Mike Sedlacek appeared before the board for approval of the 5 year Highway Plan and a Bridge Improvement Grant. Sedlacek also requested authorization to advertise for gravel.

Action 22393Hwy: A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Kettering to approve the 5 Year Plan. All present voted aye; motion carried, 5-0.

Action 22394Hwy: A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Fox to approve the Bridge Improvement Grant for Structure 68-134-120. All present voted aye; motion carried, 5-0.

Action 22395Hwy: A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Kettering to approve the Highway Superintendent to advertise for gravel. All present voted aye; motion carried, 5-0.

The board discussed the request to remove the Minimum Maintenance sign and to receive maintenance on 310th Street west. The board agreed to blade and remove the snow on the Street.

Rezone: There was a first reading on the request from East River Electric to rezone two parcels from Rural transitional (RT) and Low Density Residential (LD) to Moderate Density Resident (MD) per Article 1809 and Article 20 Section 203. Said property is legally described as Lots 1 and Lots 2 Lewis and Clark Substation Addition in the SW4, SW1/4 of Section 15 and the NW1/4, NW1/4 of Section 22-T93-R56 West of 5th Principal Meridian, Yankton Count, South Dakota. Containing 3.00 Acres more or less. The second reading of the rezone request will be at the next commission meeting on October 18, 2022.

Jerae Wire and Steve Harbock representing East River Electric spoke on the rezone. Greg Henderson, Amy Neu and John Neu and commented on the request.

Chairman Healy denied allegations about members of the Yankton County Commission in the Facebook post. He said allegations about DOE staff were under investigation by state officials. Chairman Healy discussed a letter he had written in response to the Facebook allegations. The letter stated that the accusations were false and asked members of the County Commission to sign agreeance 15 minutes before this meeting began. Chairman Healy said Commissioner Klimisch was the only commissioner who declined to sign his letter. Commissioner Klimisch said he was not given enough time to make the decision to sign the letter.
