A special meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chair Cheri Loest at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, February 5, 2021.

Roll call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Wanda Howey-Fox, Don Kettering, Joseph Healy, Dan Klimisch and Cheri Loest.

Action 2174C: A motion was made by Healy and seconded by Fox to approve the meeting agenda. All present voted aye; motion carried.

There were no public comments.

The board reviewed an application to collaborate with the Boys and Girls Club in applying for a 21st Century Grant for the Yankton Club. The grant will focus on reading, math, and homework help. These academic programs will run every day after school in each of the elementary schools.
