A special meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chair Cheri Loest at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 7, 2020.

Roll call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Dan Klimisch, Joseph Healy, Gary Swensen and Cheri Loest; Absent: Don Kettering.

There were no conflicts of interest reported by Commissioners.

Action 20257C: A motion was made by Healy and seconded by Klimisch to approve the meeting agenda with the following correction; executive session will be on personnel. Healy, Klimisch and Loest voted aye; Swensen voted nay; motion carried. 3-1

There was one public comment from Gary Swensen.

Action 20258C: A motion was made by Healy and seconded by Klimisch to recess the regular session at 9:08 a.m. and convene in executive session to discuss personnel issues SDCL 1-25-2(1). Healy, Klimisch and Loest voted aye; Swensen voted nay; motion carried. 3-1

Action 20259C: A motion was made by Swensen and seconded by Healy to adjourn the executive session at 9:30 a.m. and reconvene in regular session. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Chair Loest reported no action would be taken as a result of the executive session for Personnel.

Commissioner Kettering entered the meeting via telephone.

Budget Hearings: The Board began hearings for the 2021 budget, with several of the County department heads presenting their requests for 2021.

The board also discussed increasing the wheel tax to \$5.00 per wheel and implementing tax opt out for secondary roads and tax levy for country roads.
