Tim Tolley, Lake County Highway Superintendent, announced today the seasonal road restrictions will become effective at:

08:00 A.M. on March 6, 2025 due to the unusual warm weather conditions. (SDCL 32-22-24). All hard surface and gravel roads are restricted to 7-Ton per axle.

Exceptions:

County Road #51 (446 Ave) from SD Hwy #34 north for 7 miles - restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

County Road #53 (445 Ave) from County Road R22 (226 Street) north for 6 miles - restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

County Road #19 (462 AVE) OFF SD HWY 34 (235 Street) 462 Ave, 461 Ave, & 461A Ave, south on R19 (462 Ave) for 3.64 miles - restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

County Road #21 (461 Ave) at 461 Ave & 238 Street south on R21 (461 Ave) for 6 miles - restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

Seasonal road restrictions will remain in effect until lifted by the Lake County Highway Superintendent.
