The Marjorie Haskins scholarship is provided to a MHS senior. Because of Marjorie's passion for fine arts, all seniors are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Preference given to students who have participated in multiple fine arts. Preference also given to those majoring or minoring in Music.

Funds awarded must be used for educational expenses incurred during the following school year. This award will be directed to the recipient's chosen institution. If no student is eligible, funds will be carried forward in the following years until an eligible student is identified.
