







Baccalaureate for the fifty graduating seniors was held May 27, 1962 at 8, in the high school auditorium. Relatives and friends were present.




Reverend Condon Terry gave the invocation, the baccalaureate sermon, and the closing benediction. His message, "The Search For the Best Good," was enjoyed by all.
