Working Together

The "Maroon" staff is a group of students working together to publish the school newspaper. If one does his part, he can gain a feeling of satisfaction from having contributed.

The editors are responsible for the completion of assignments, rechecking the stories and seeing to it that all information is turned in on time.

News reporters are an important part of the staff. They must gather all necessary information on timely topics and write accurately from their

Photographers are the people who add a bit of illustrative interest to the pages. Pictures must be well planned and are to be clear and interesting. Other writers, such as editorial and feature writers, and columnists,

provide something to be enjoyed in the paper.

Merlin Hiaring, adviser, assists and gives suggestions. He must oversee activities and edit what the editors have already done.

Staff members gain knowledge and experience from Journalism I and Journalism II. They study such topics as photography, headline writing, canons of journalism, editorial and feature writing, news writing, typing up the stories, paste-up, gathering of facts, writing leads, advertising, newspaper functions, news media, newspaper history, copyreading, proofreading, and responsibilities of the staff. Lectures and dittoed handouts give much additional information.

Much time and effort is needed in publishing the paper. First, there are many hours of preparation. Staff members express their assignment preferences. Assignments for each page are made. The paper is generally divided into four pages. First page is the news; second is the editorial page; third is

sports and fourth is the catch-all page. Editors must be sure that all events are covered.

The reporters, columnists, and other writers go to work, seeking information, writing, rechecking, and making sure that the deadline is met.

The copyreaders must recheck stories for errors. All material must be

The copyreaders must recheck stories for errors. All material must be typed and rechecked. All photographs have to be planned and taken. Headlines and cutlines are written correctly. Words have to be counted in each story so that it is known whether or not enough material has been written to fill the newspaper as planned. Mr. Hiaring helps a few students decide on headline size and column widths. Students suggest several possible heads for their stories.

After all material is completed it is taken to the Madison Daily Leader to be set into print on slicks for the offset printing process. When copy is ready a handful of staff members, with their adviser, do the paste-up at the Leader office. The Leader then prints the paper on its large offset web press and it is ready for distribution to the student body.

Prerequisite to becoming a staff member or member of the journalism classes is a "C." or above, grade average.

Every fall there is a High School Press Convention at South Dakota State University. It is open to any interested staff members. Various activities, classes, and meetings are held, presenting correct and new ways of publishing a school paper and yearbook.
