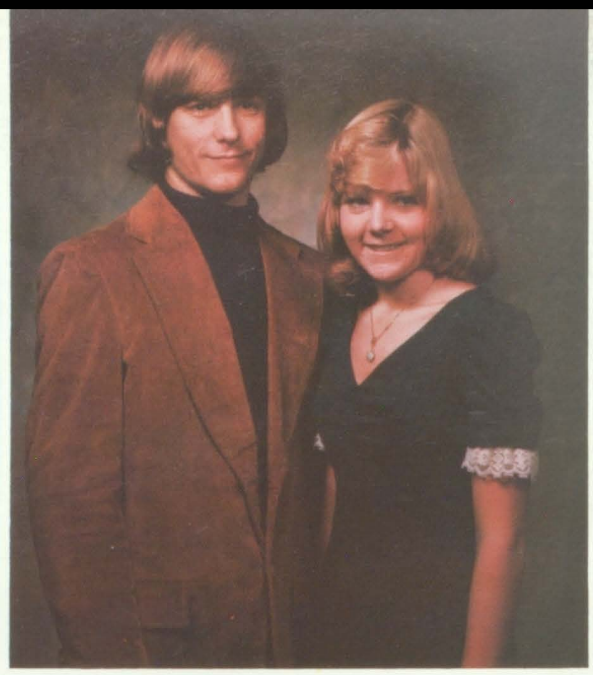
Homecoming Festivities

The coaches and returning wrestlers hope to increase the number of participants for the 75-76 season.



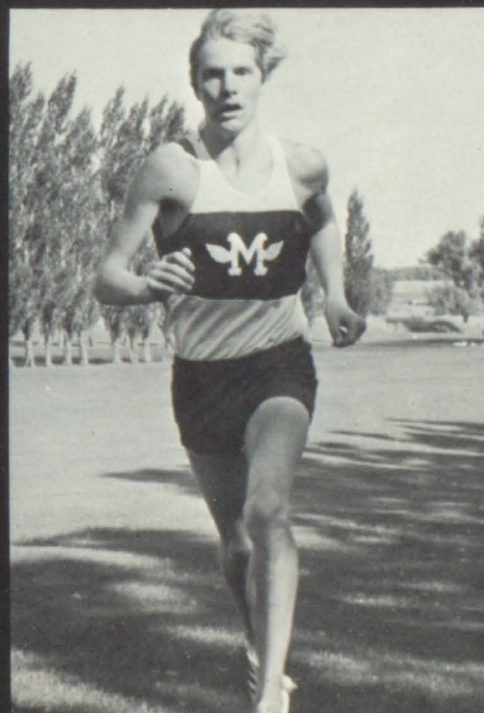
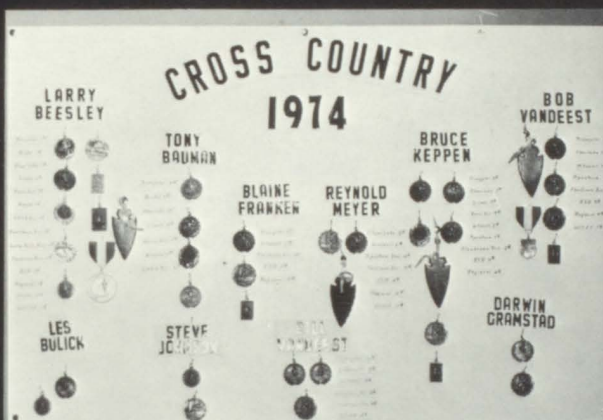

The Maroon

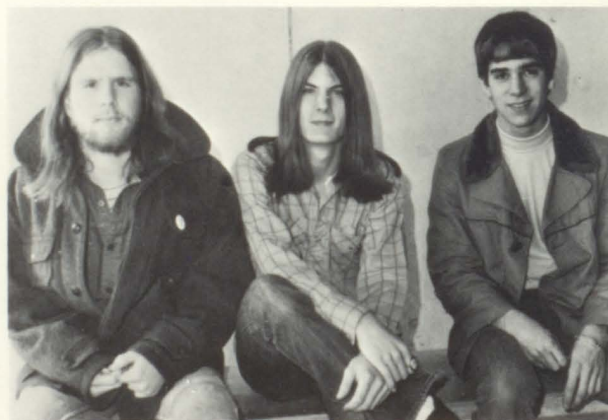
