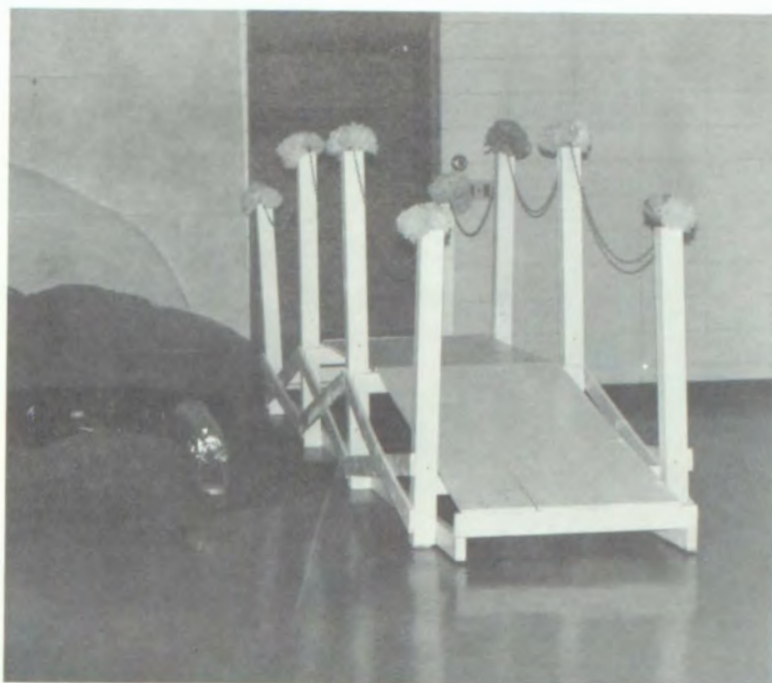




# PROM 1978
