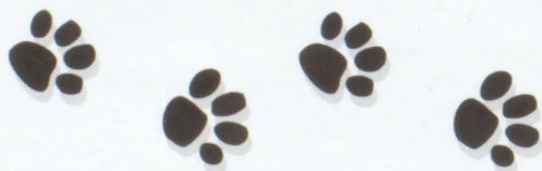

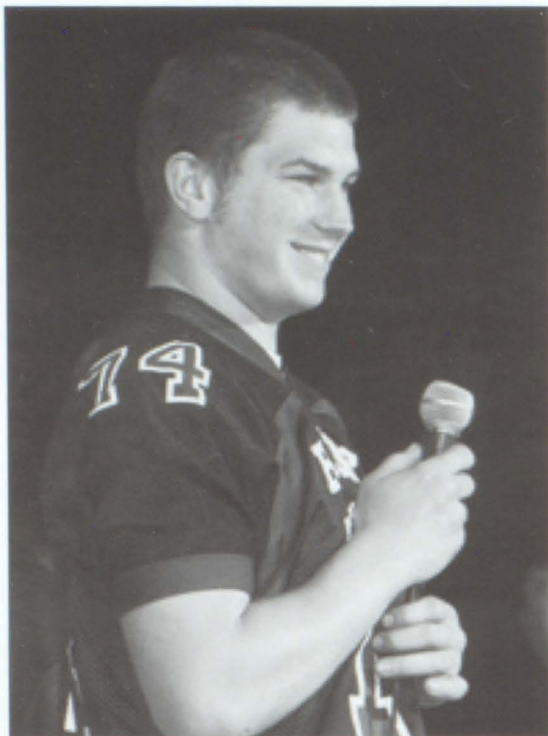

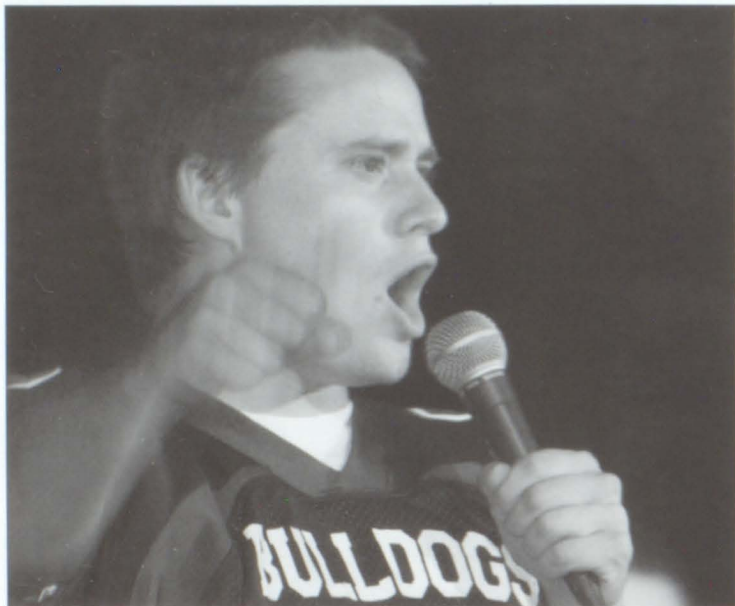

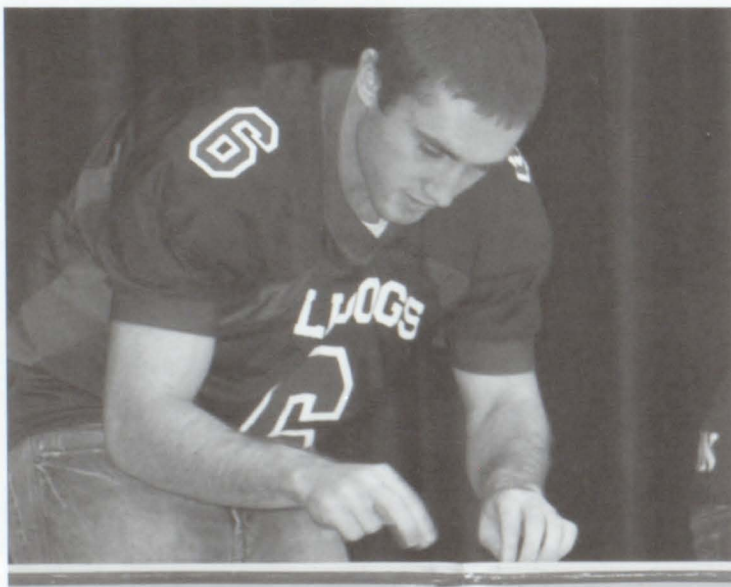

MHS students celebrated an awesome week during this year's homecoming. The theme this year was "Blockbuster." The students got to compete in various fun and challenging activities.

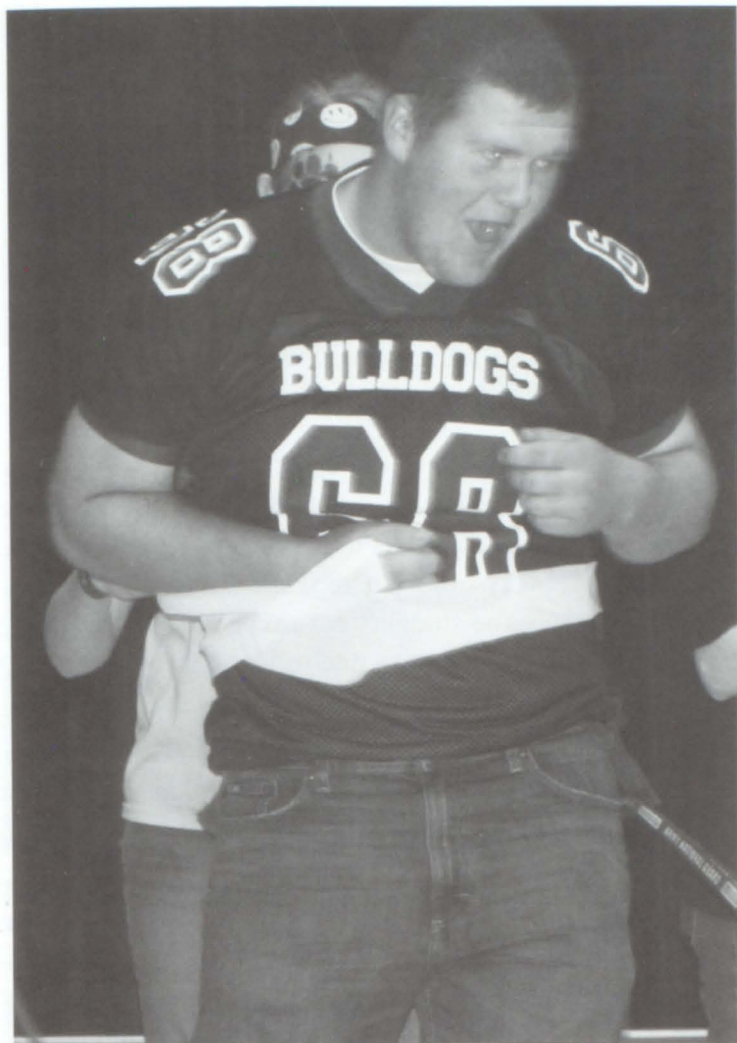

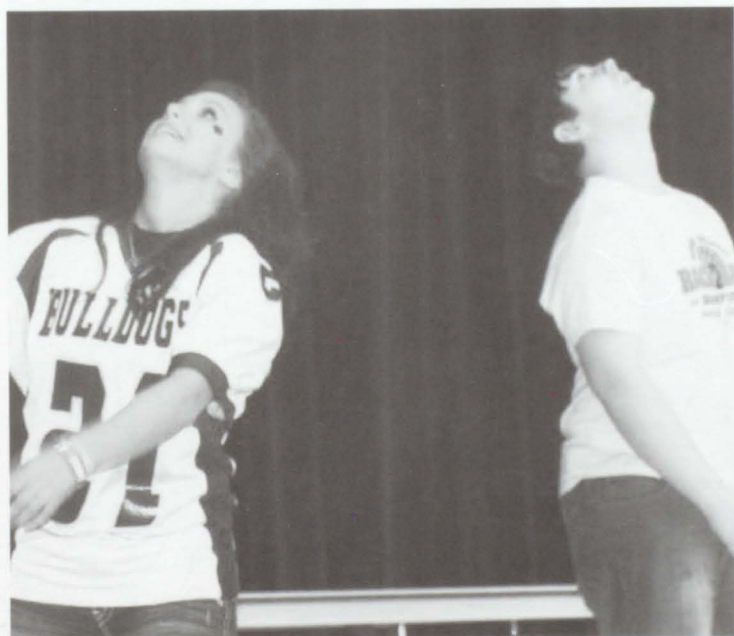

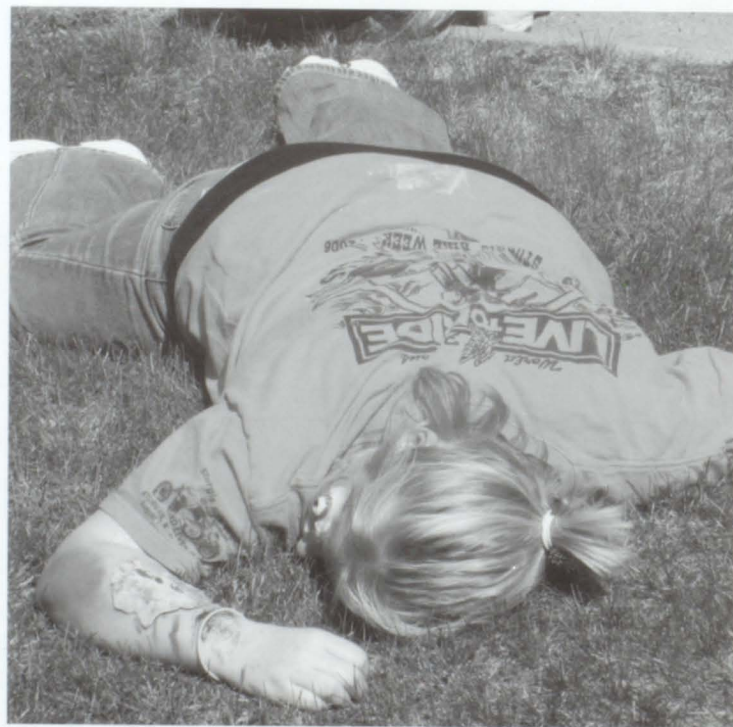

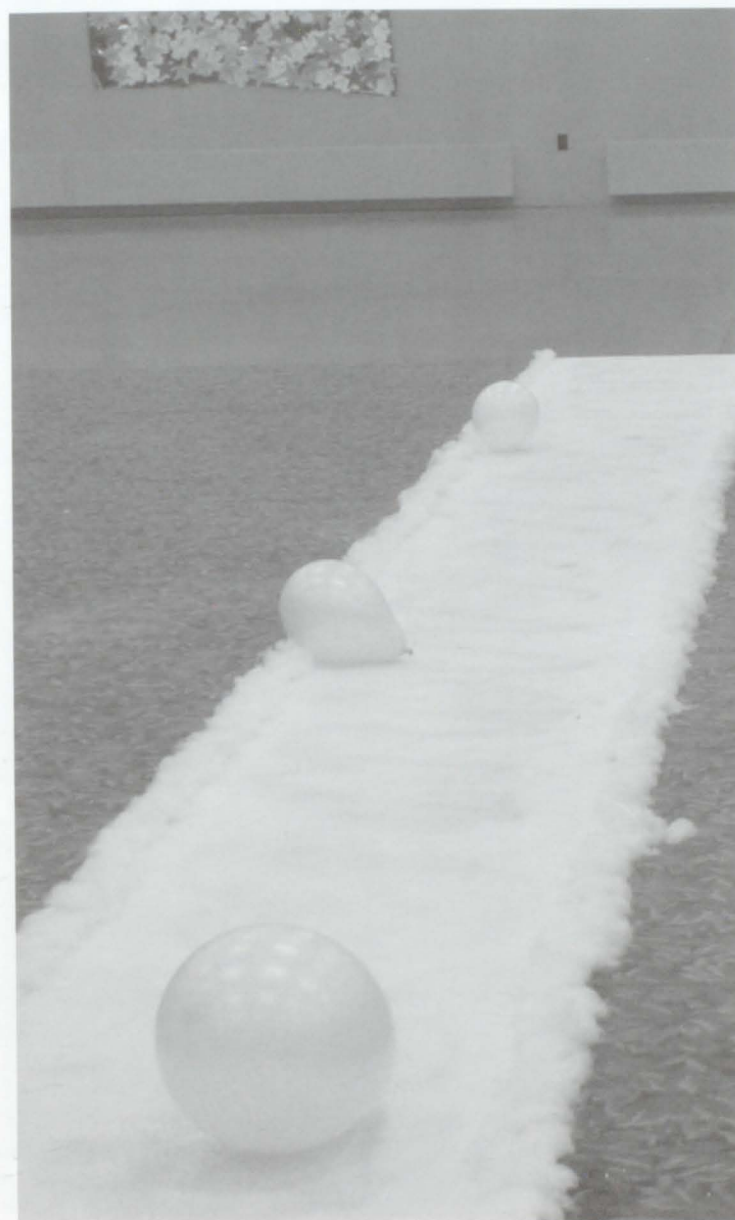

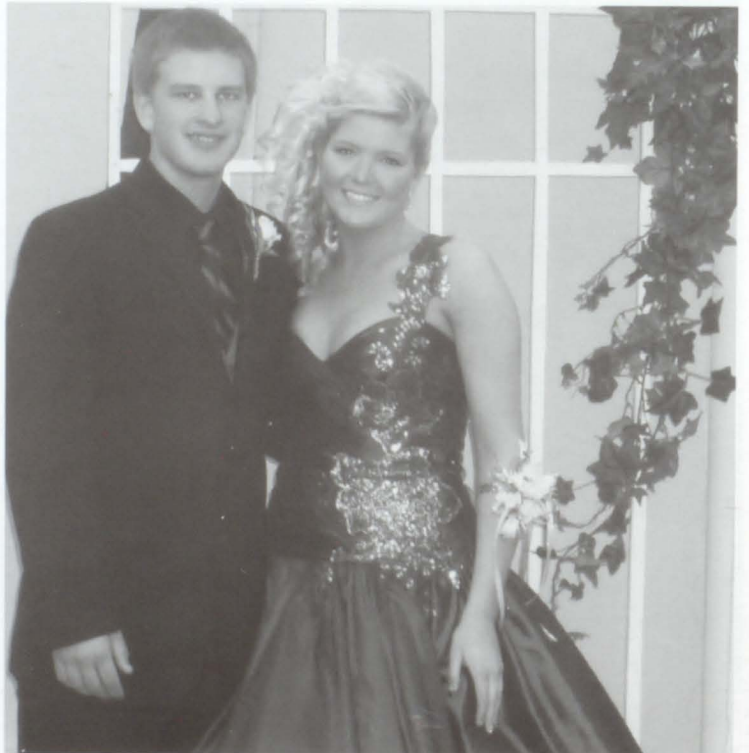

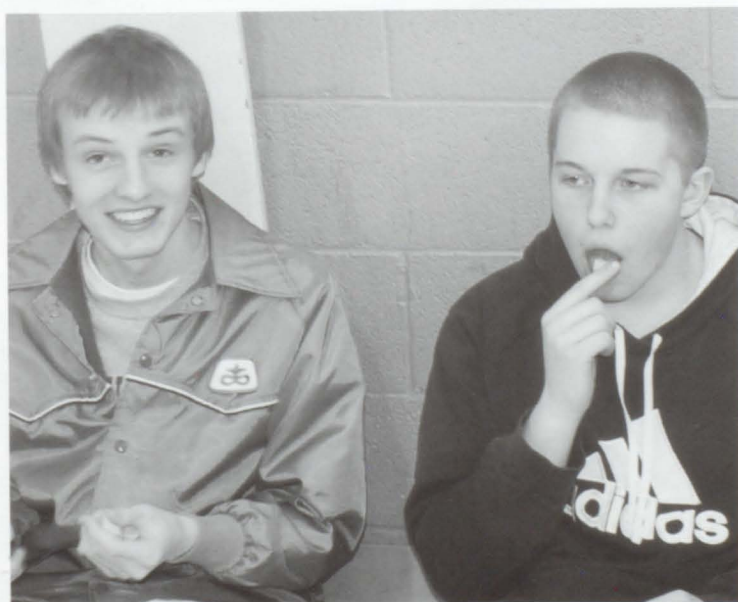

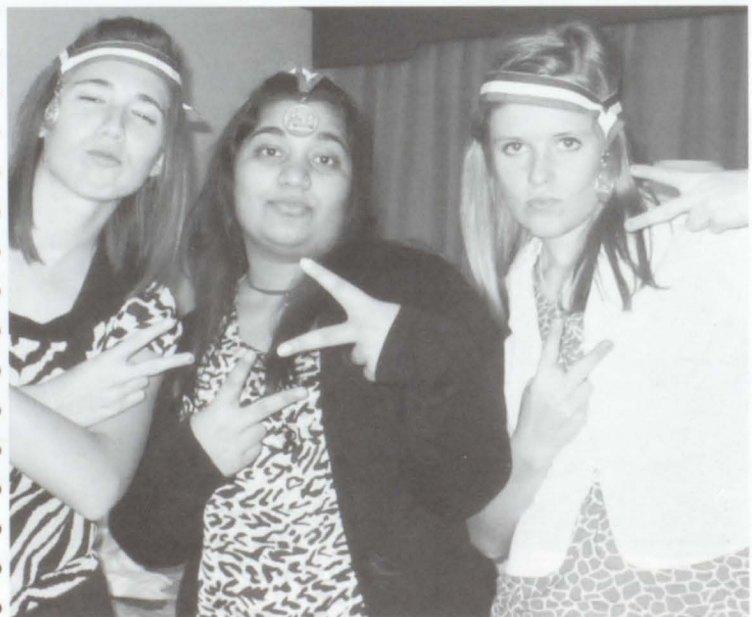

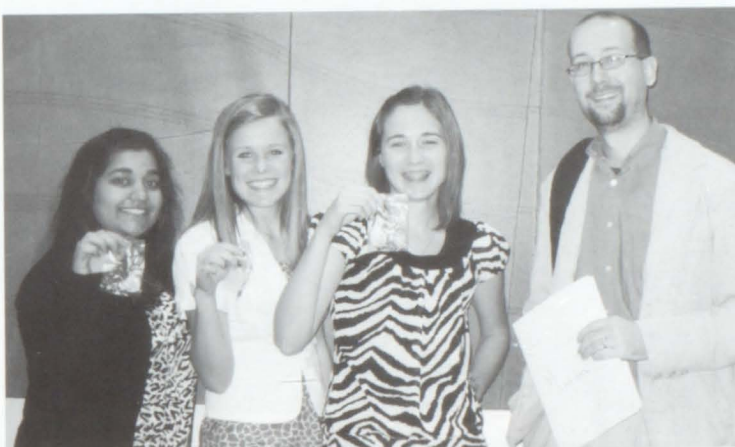

What is Oral Interp All About?

In Oral Interp you can choose from multiple categories such as poetry, prose, drama, duet, humor, reader's theatre, and oratory. In competition, you must interpret a piece from one of these categories. The rules are that you have to have your script in front of you even if you have your piece memorized. When you compete, you do your piece for three different judges and they give you a score. This year, regions were at SDSU. Breanna Rowland's Oratory piece titled "A Left-handed Commencement Address" placed second at regions. The Reader's Theatre consisted of Eshita Trivedi, Aly Boldt, and Breanna Rowland. Their piece was titled "Animal Kingdom" and also made it to state by placing second at regions. The State Competition was held in Aberdeen this year. Breanna's Oratory piece received a superior rating and the Reader's Theatre also received a superior rating at state. It is a great honor to be awarded a superior rating because it is the highest rating you can receive in Oral Interp. Since these ladies were awarded two superior ratings in two categories, they also received a Plaque of Excellence!

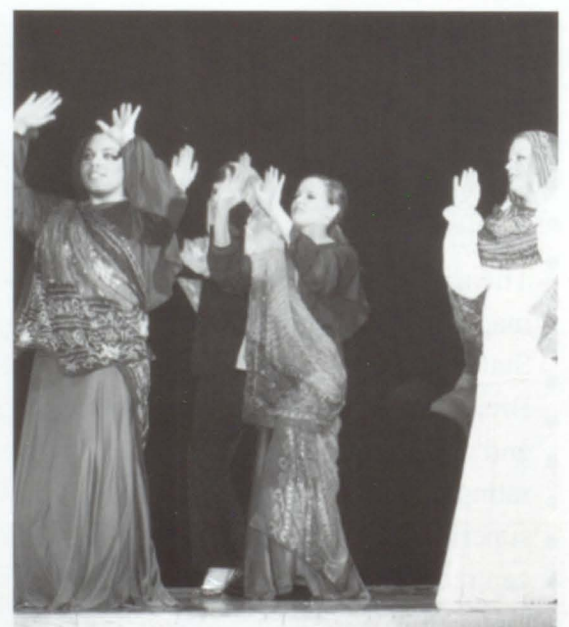

This year's One-Act play was titled "All the World's a Stage." The play was two folk tales combined, *Kismet* and *The Handless Maiden*. The first story, *The Handless Maiden*, begins when a poor miller is offered wealth by a mysterious dark figure if the miller will give him what stands behind his mill. Thinking that there is only an apple tree, the miller agrees, not realizing he has sacrificed his only daughter. The second play, *Kismet*, begins when a young princess Shanta defies her father and explains that she believes that each person is responsible for their own luck. She is forced to leave her family and wealth behind and make her own way in the world with the help of a friendly beggar woman. 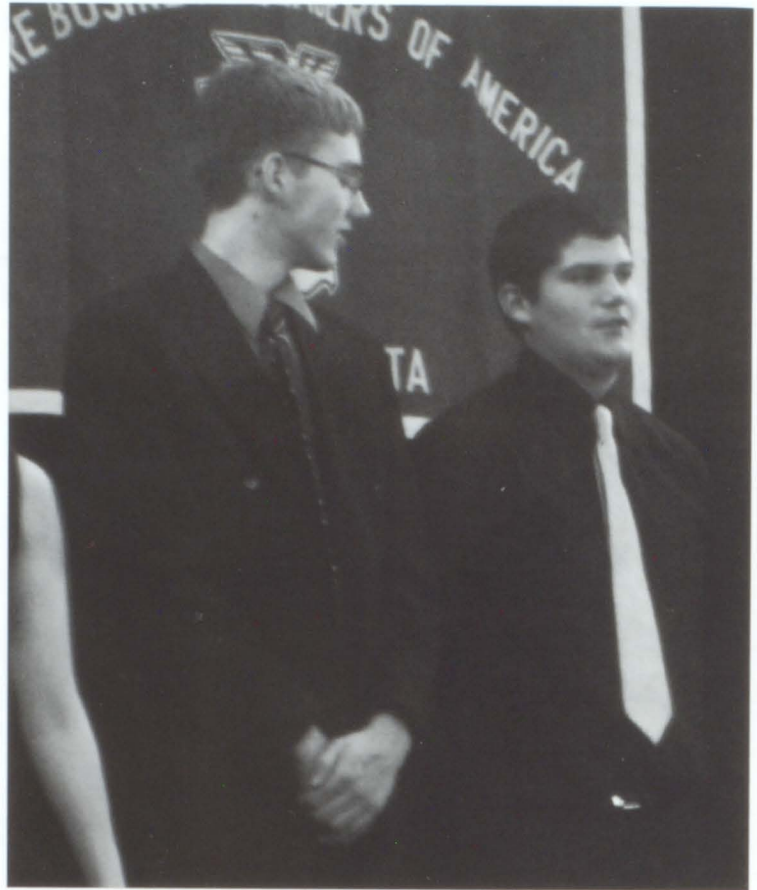

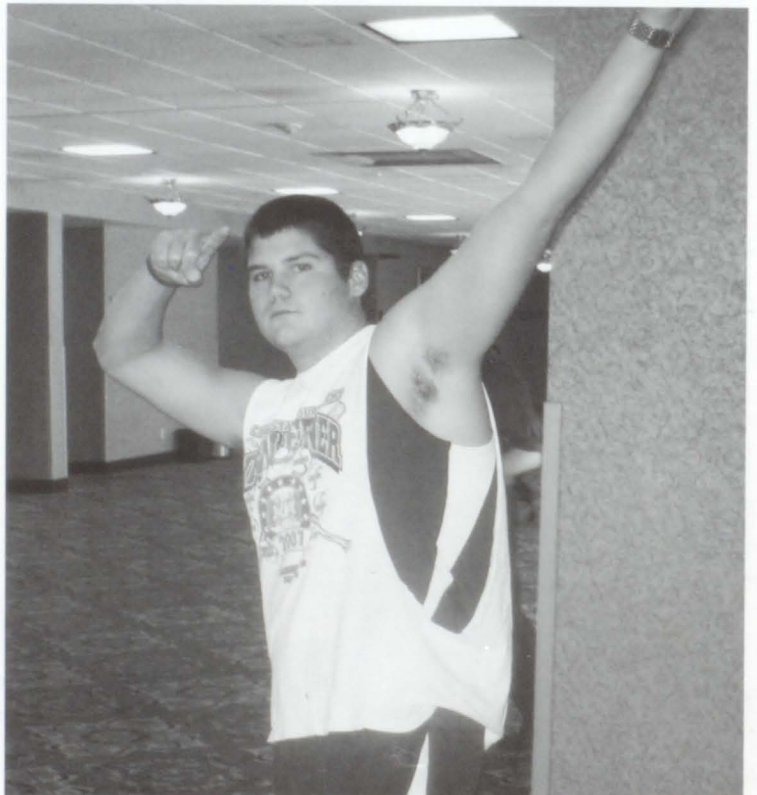

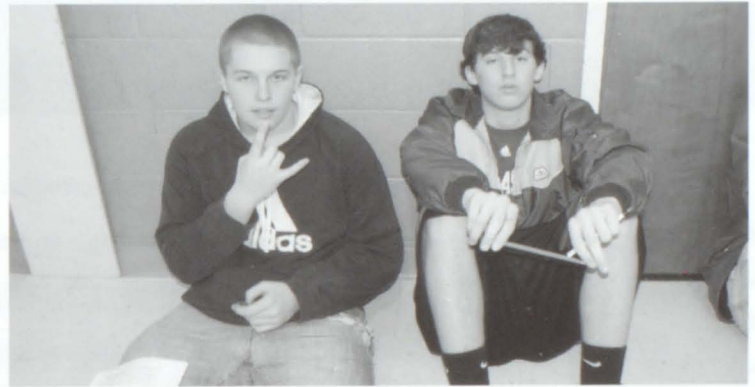

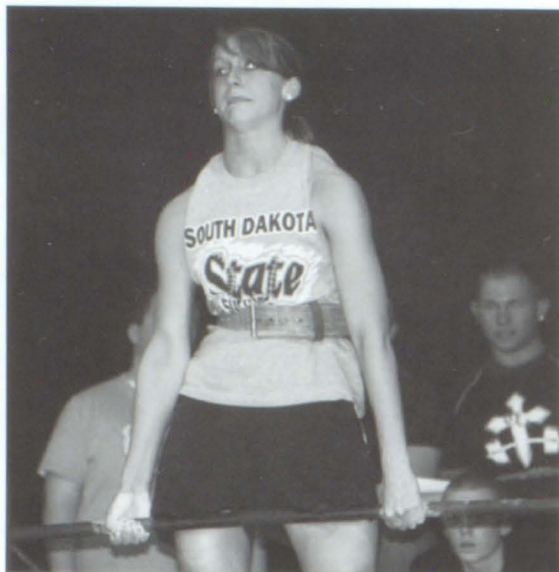

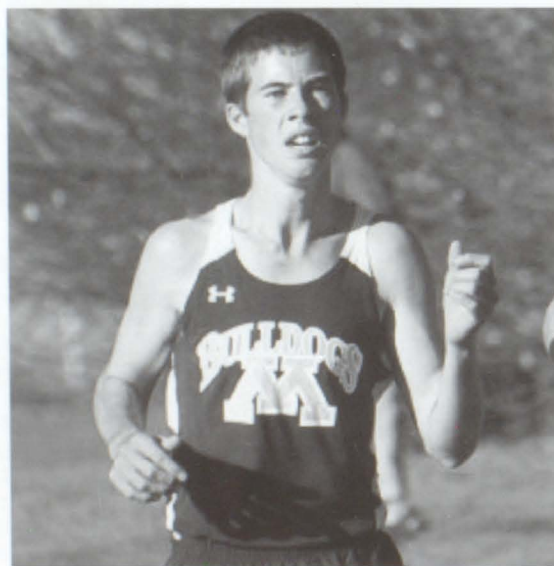

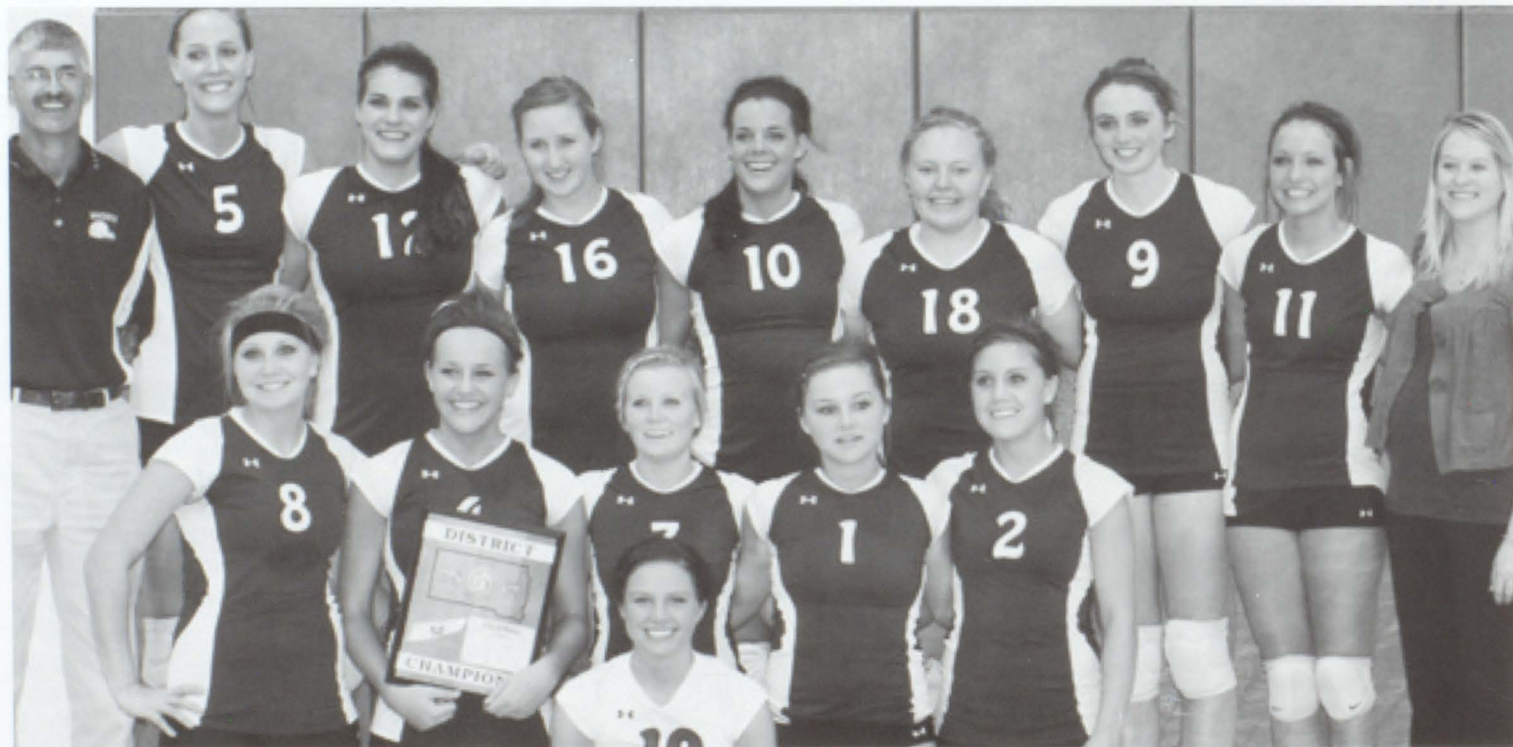

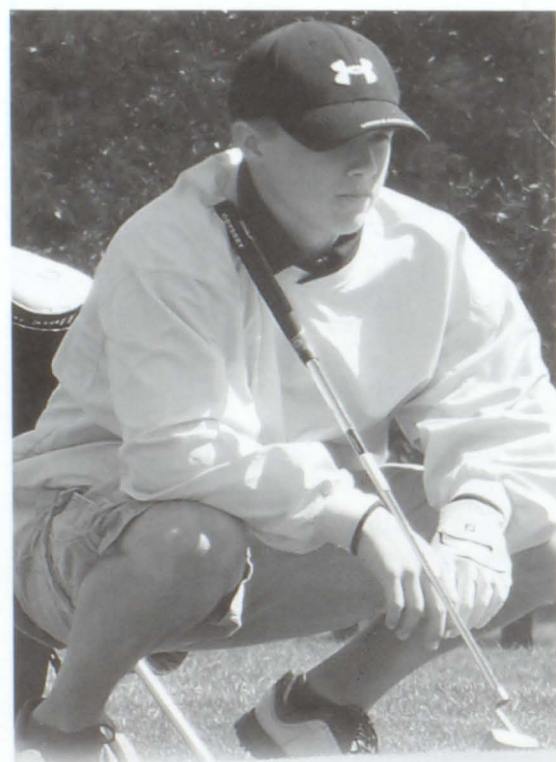

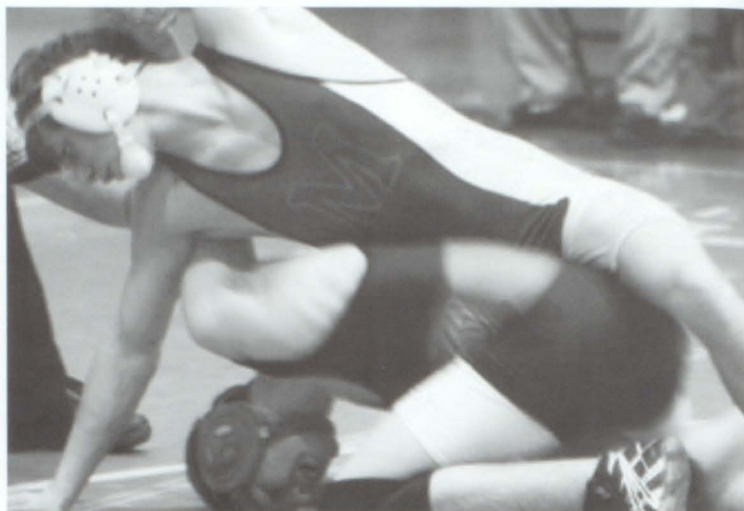

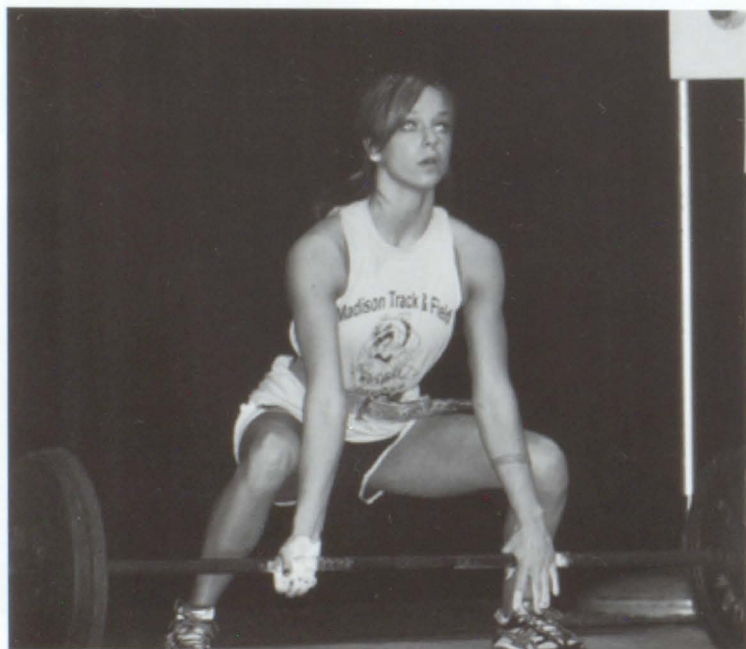

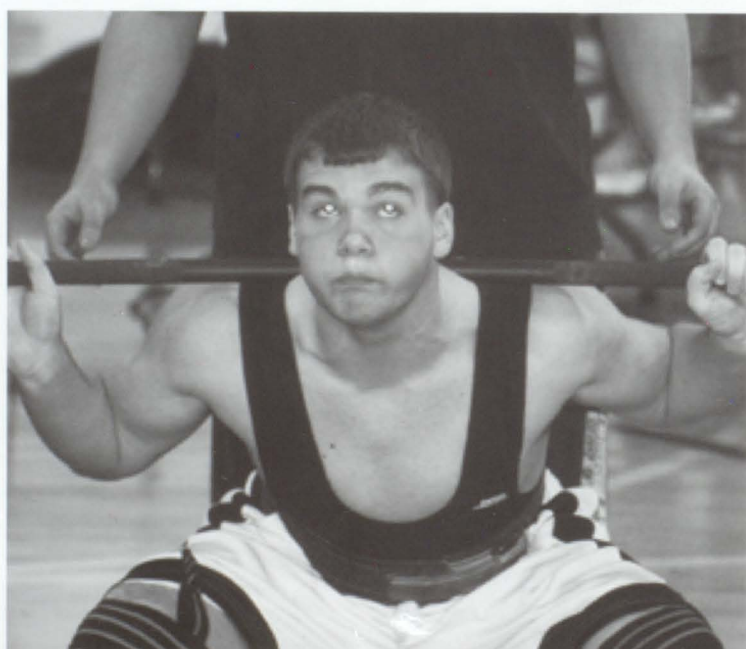

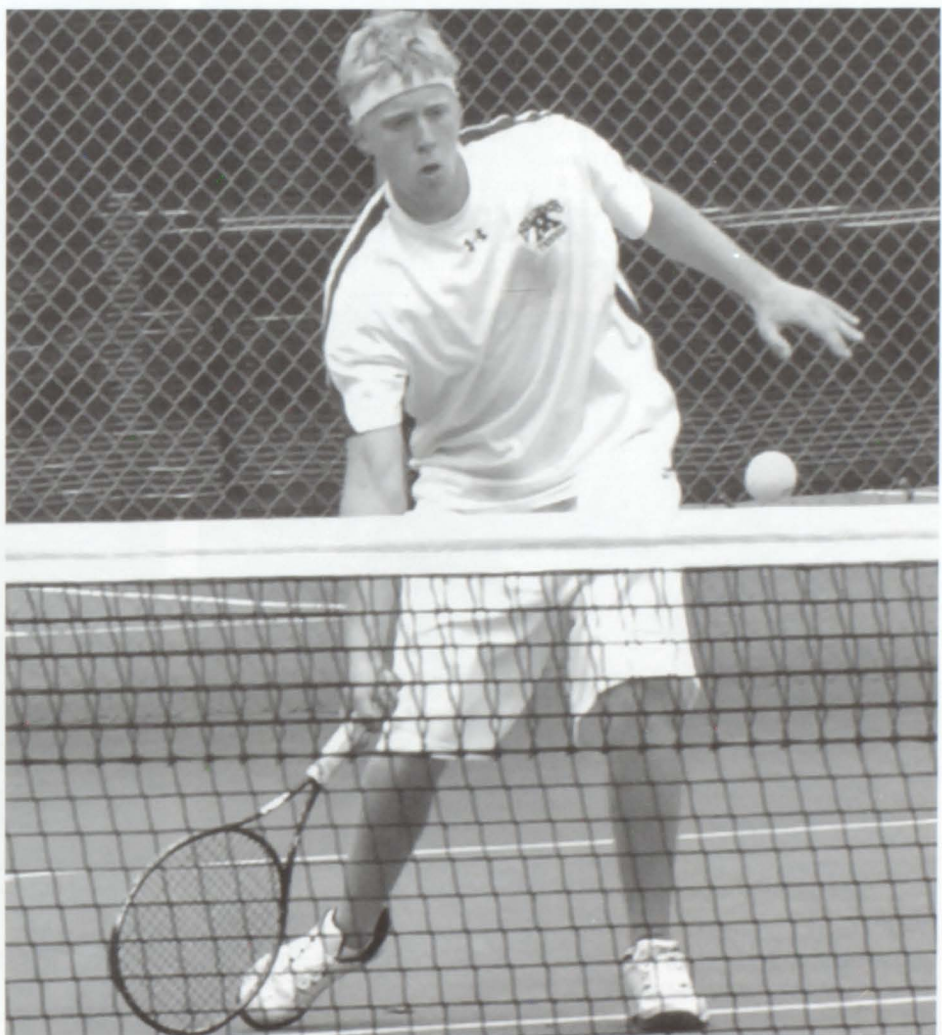

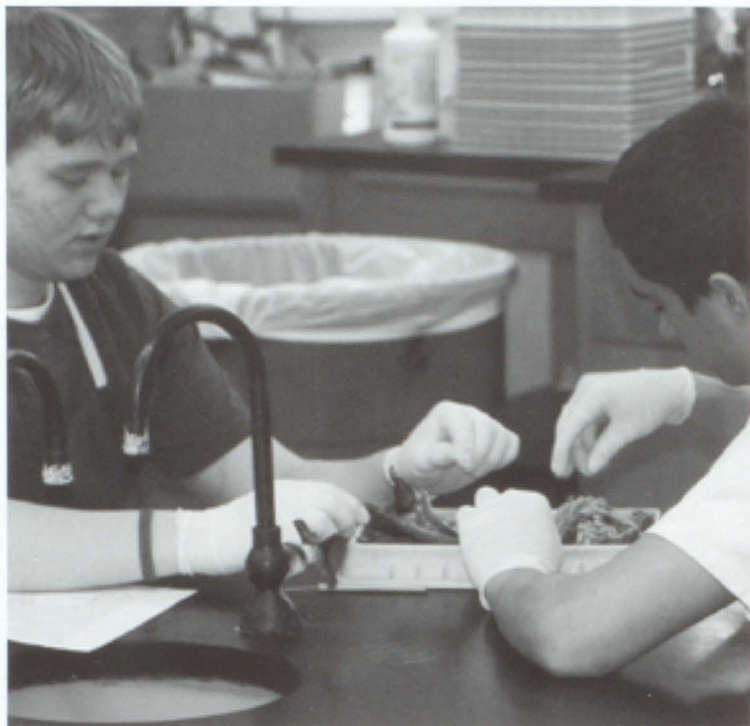

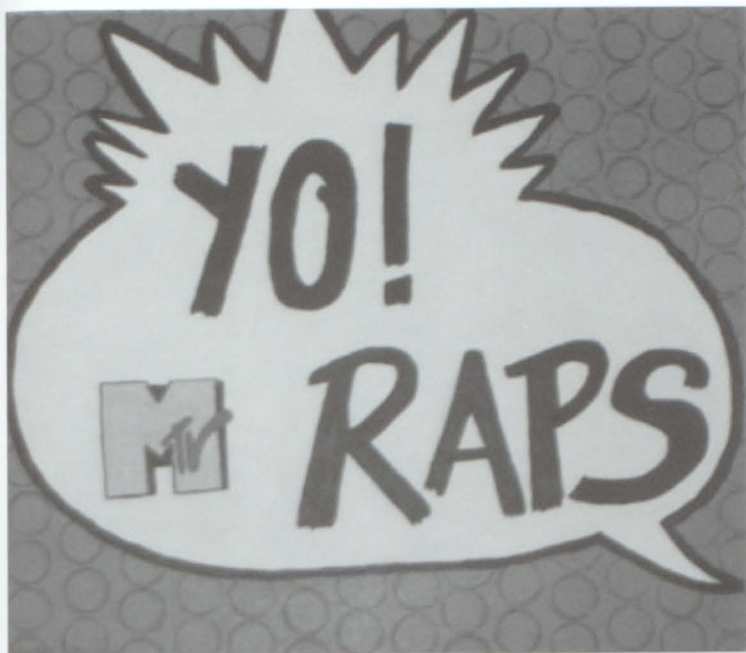

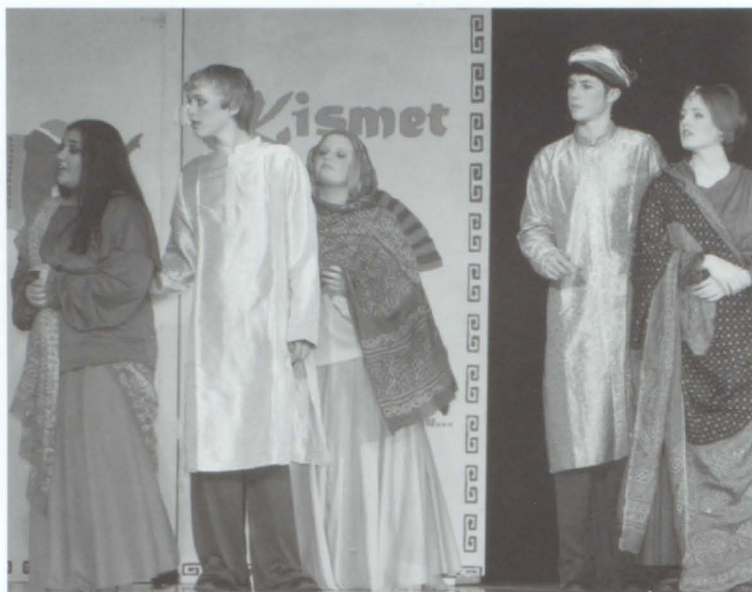
