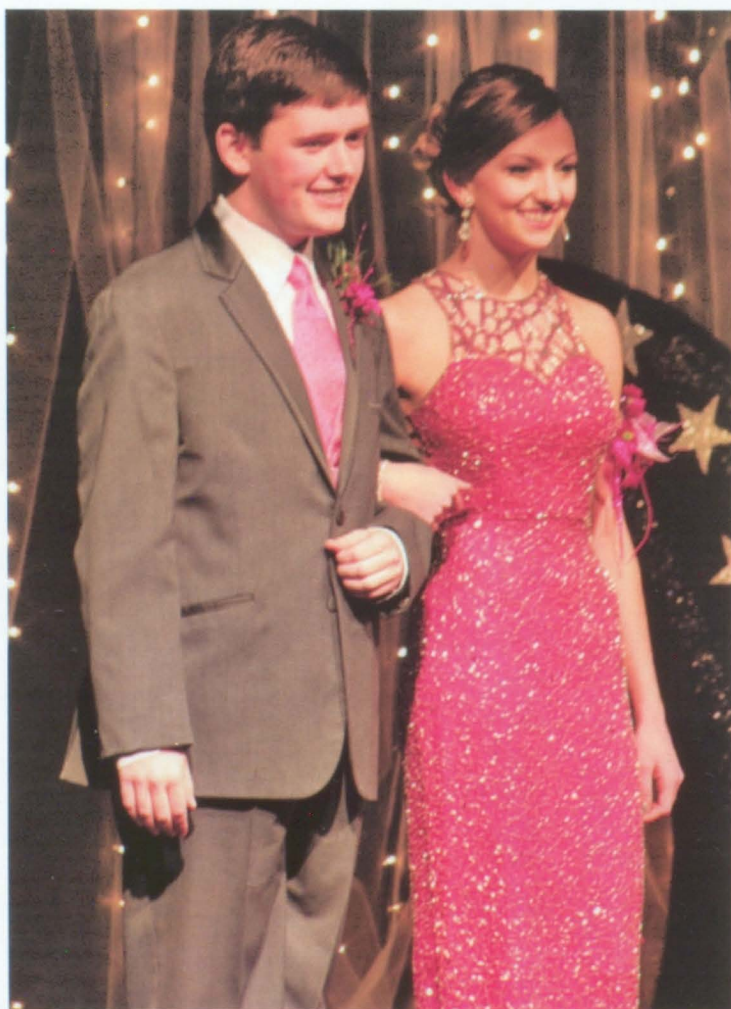

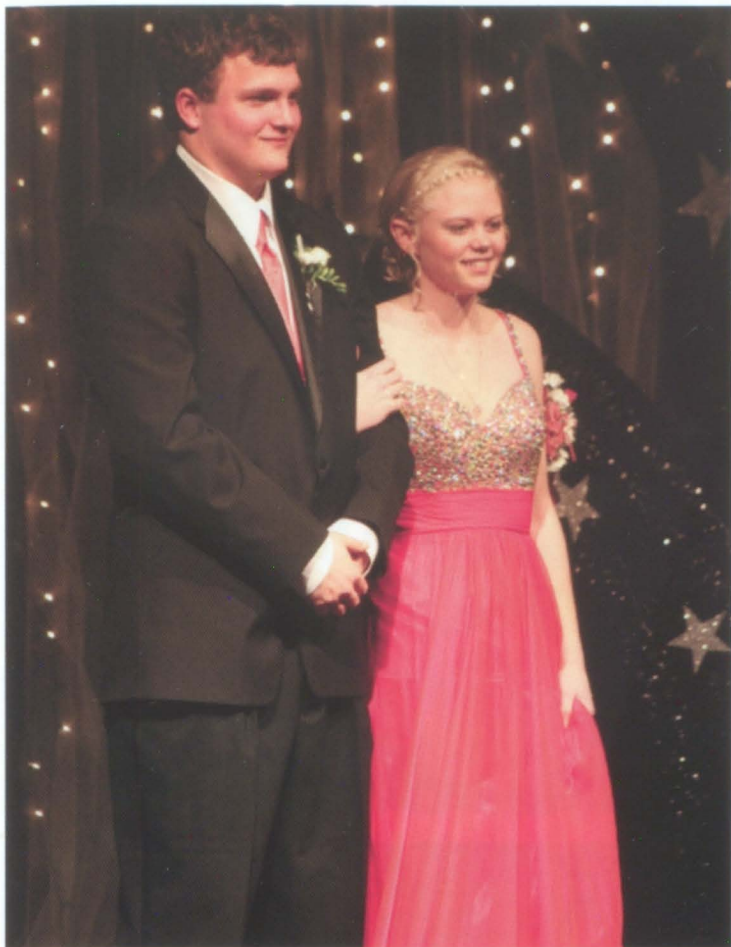

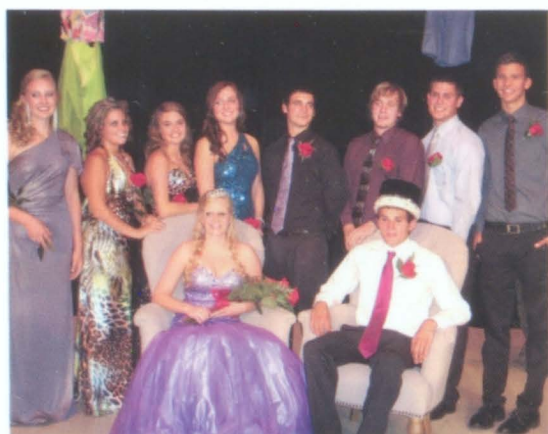

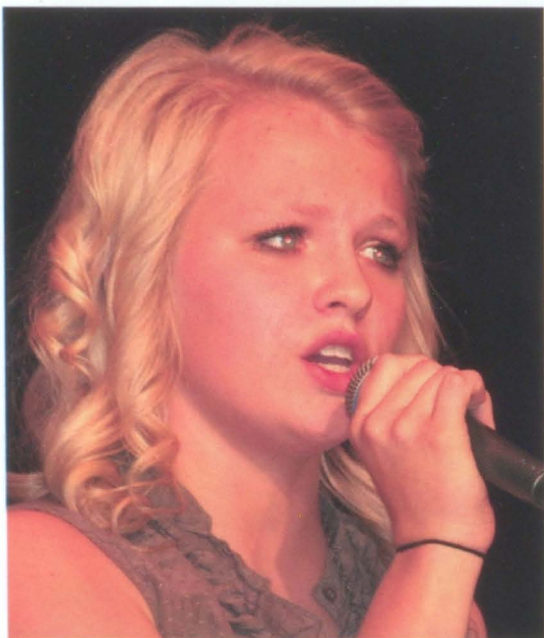

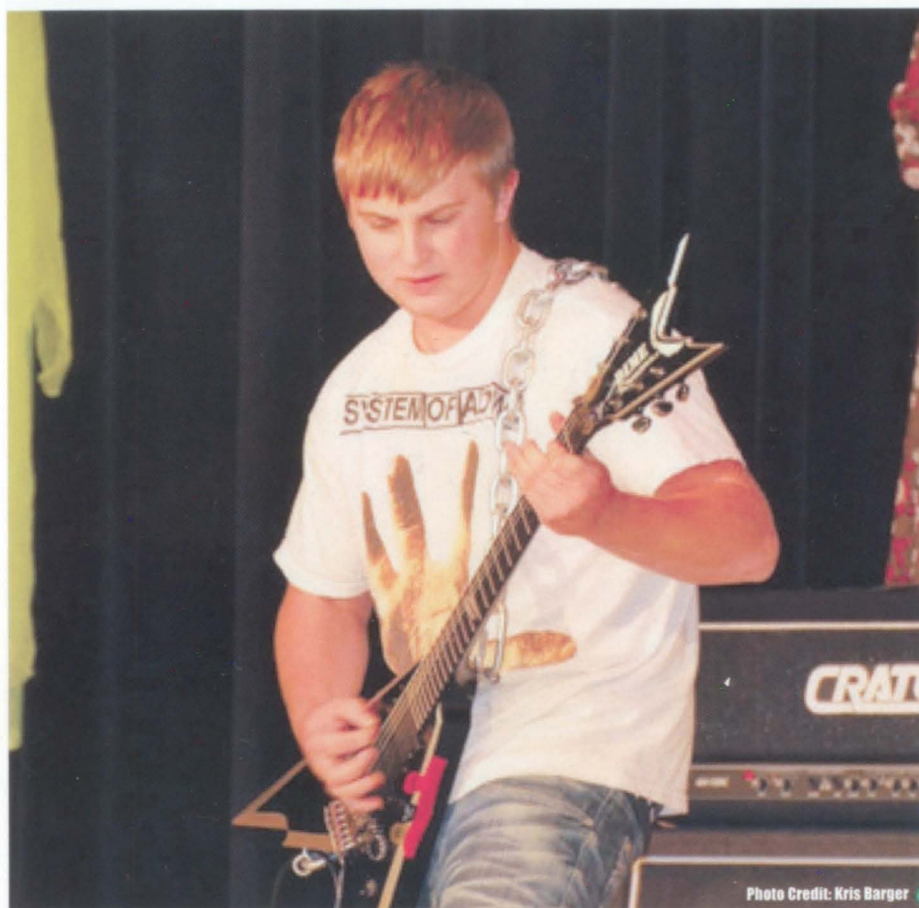

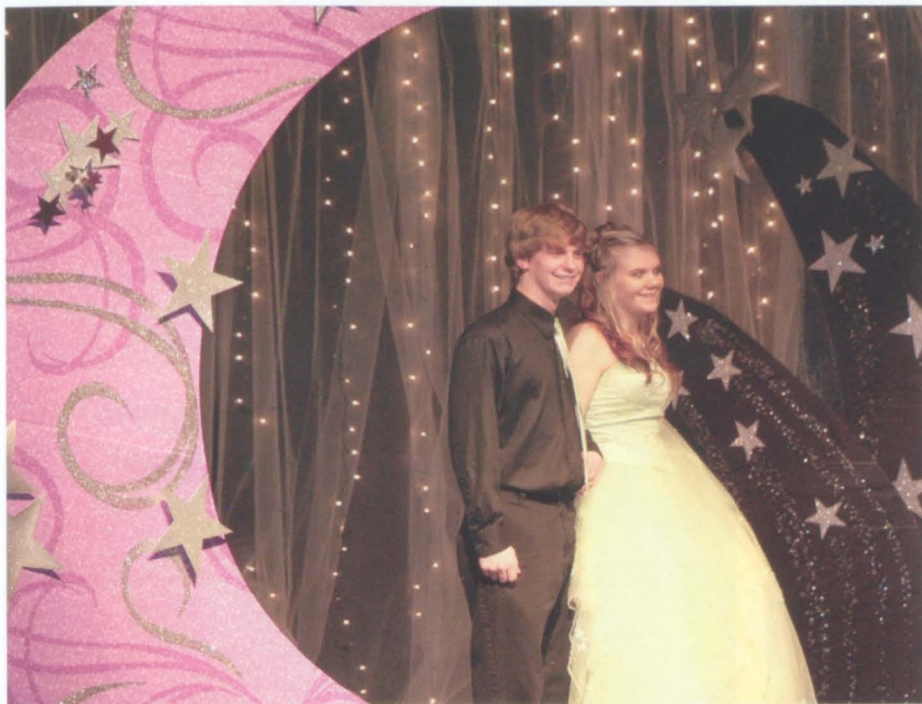

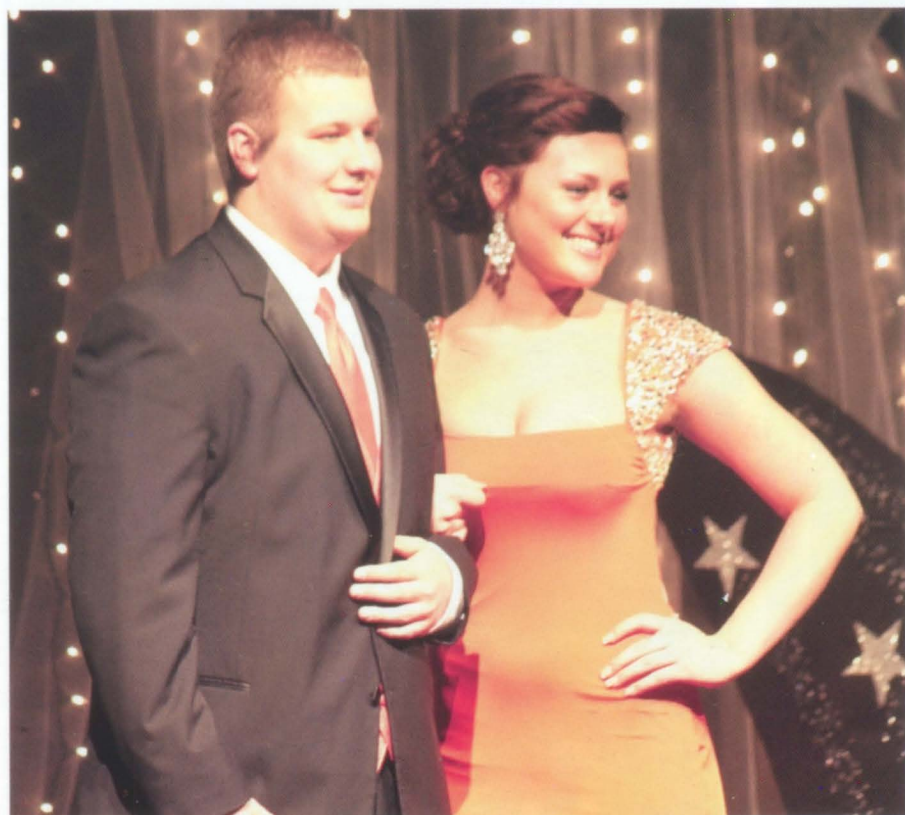

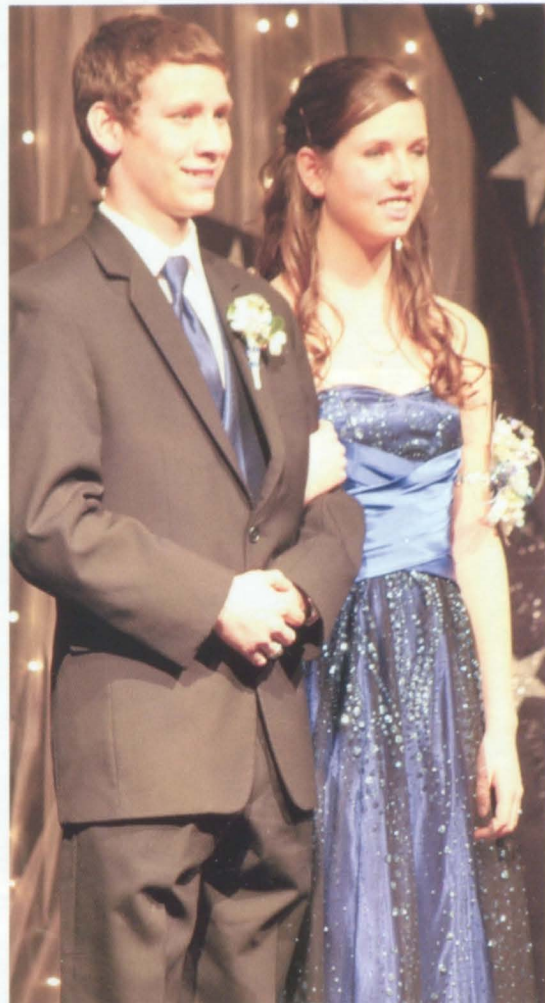

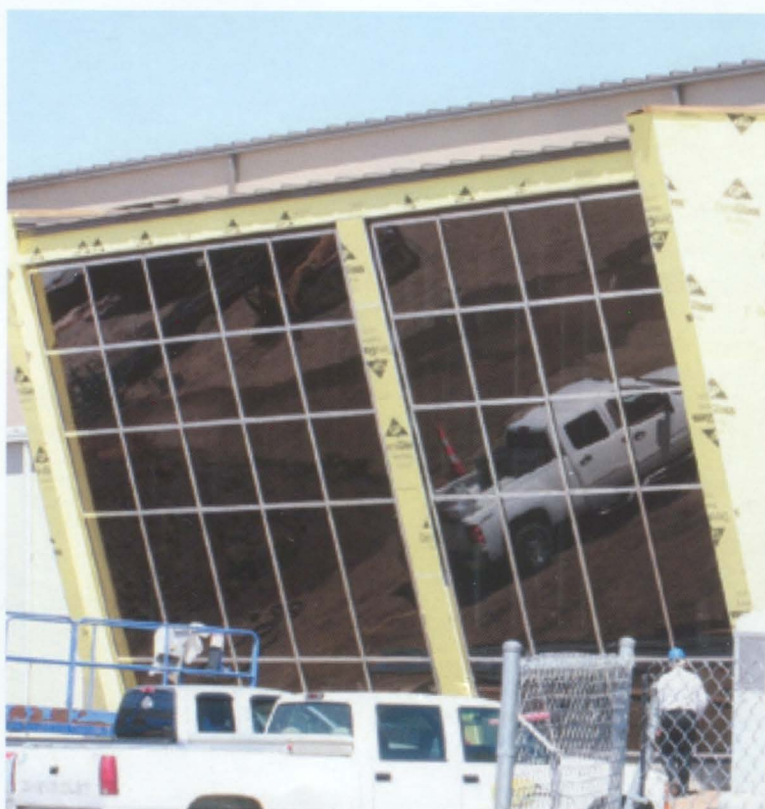

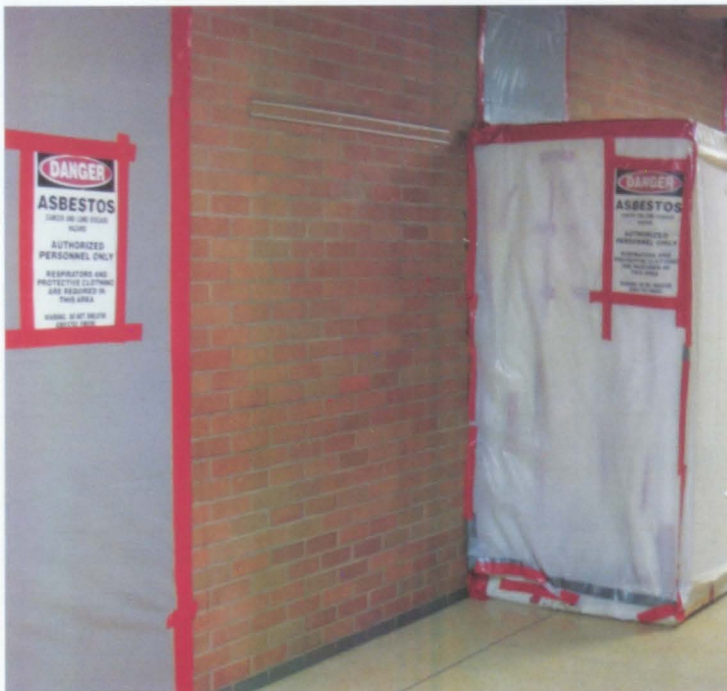

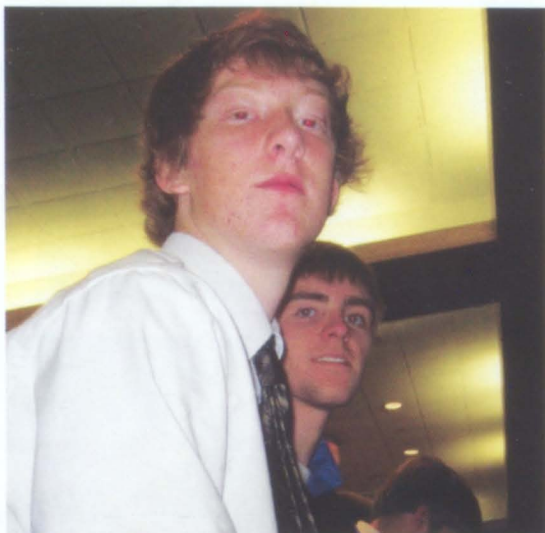

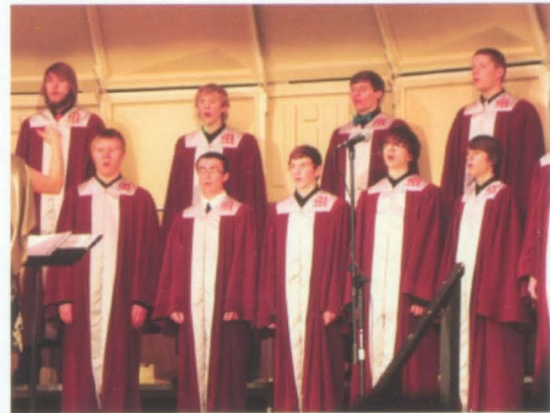

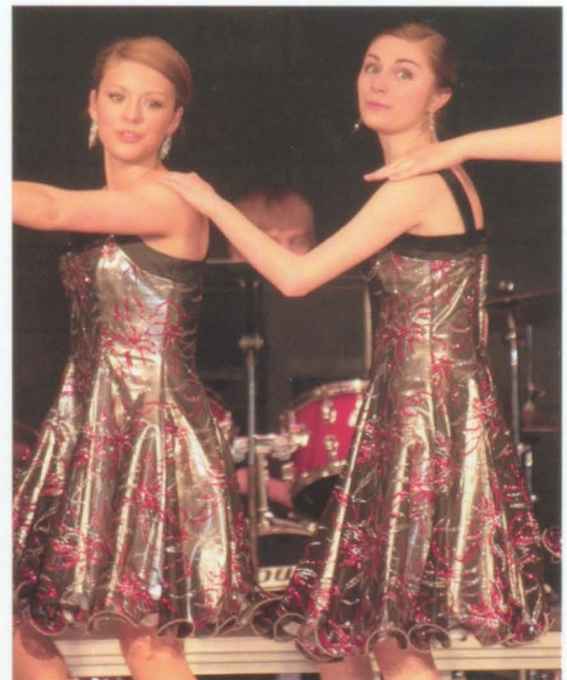

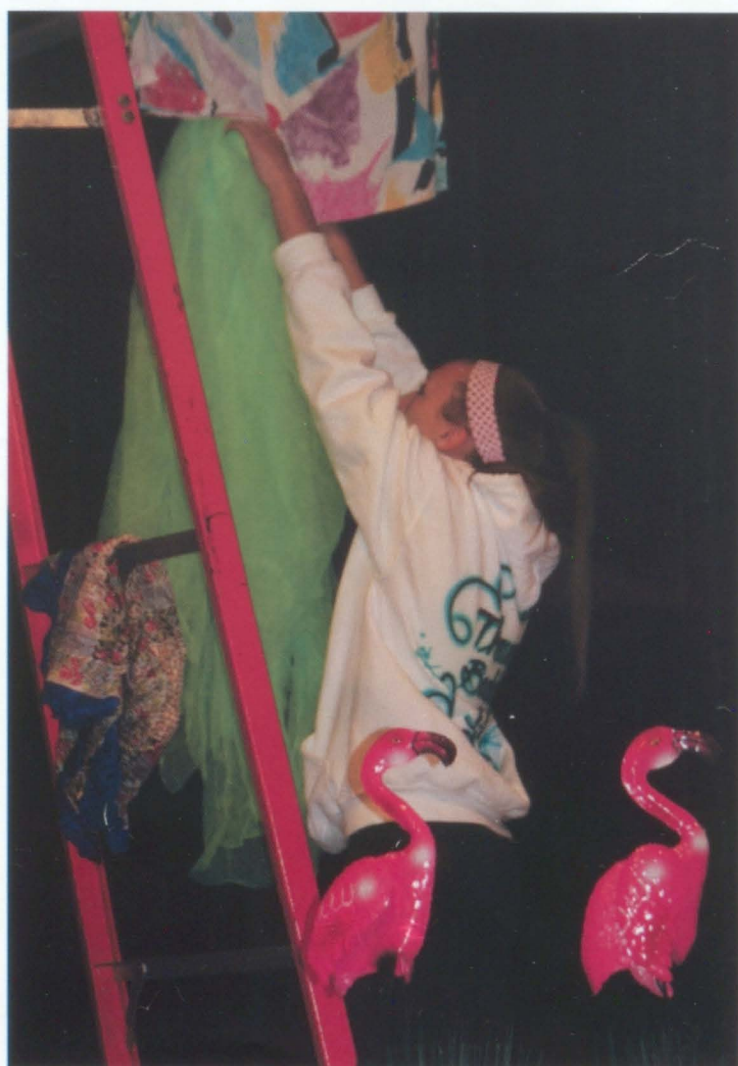

Audiences will love this spoof of 1950's TV sitcoms like 'Leave It to Beaver' and 'Father Knows Best.'"

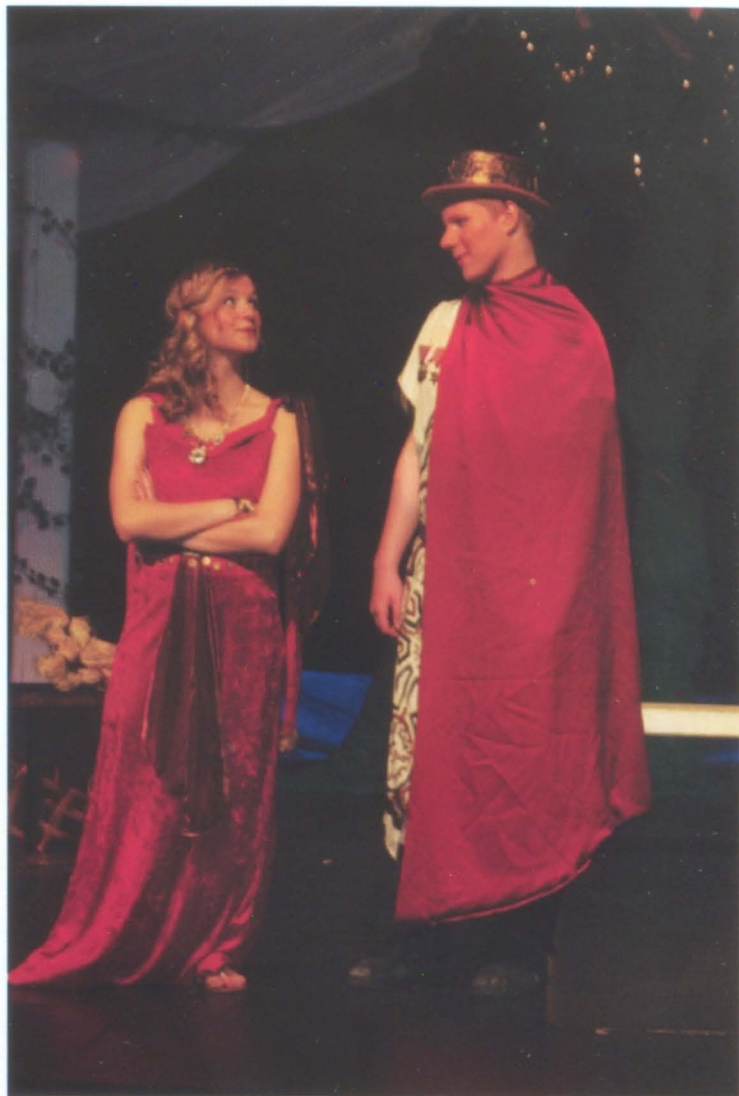

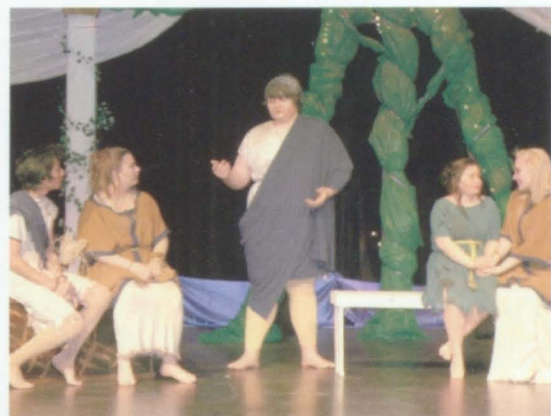

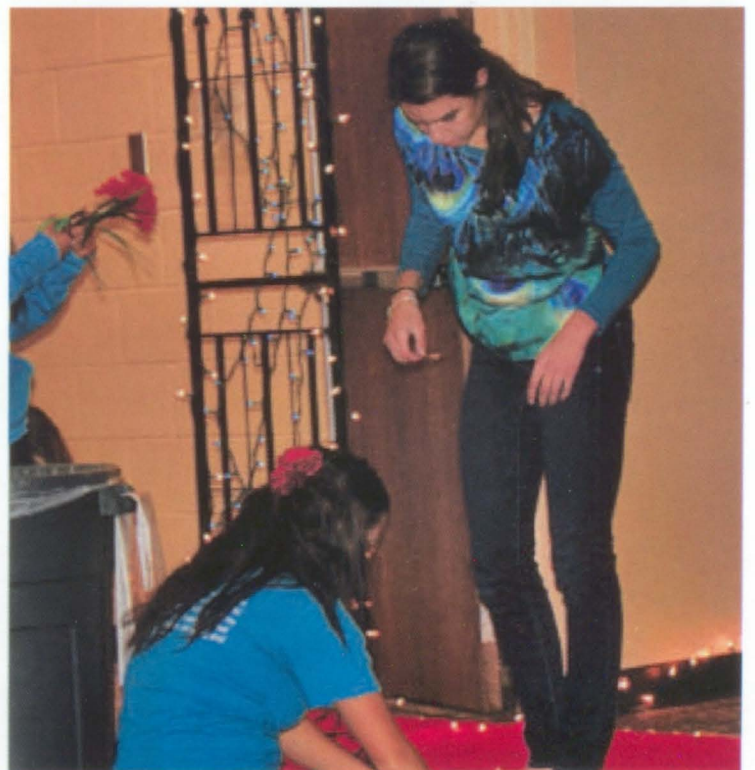

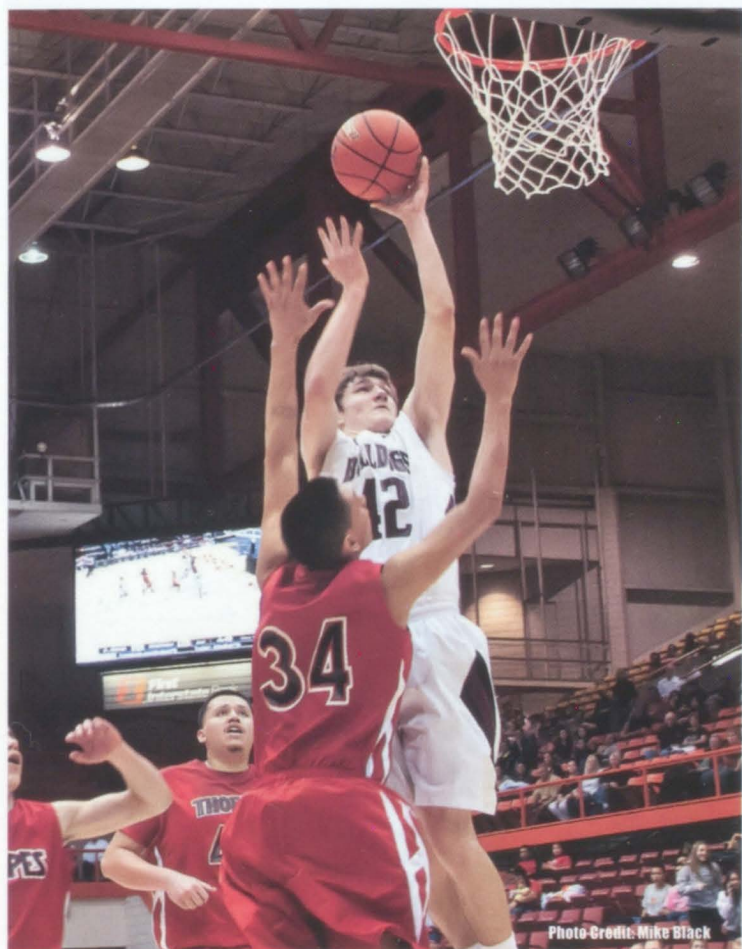

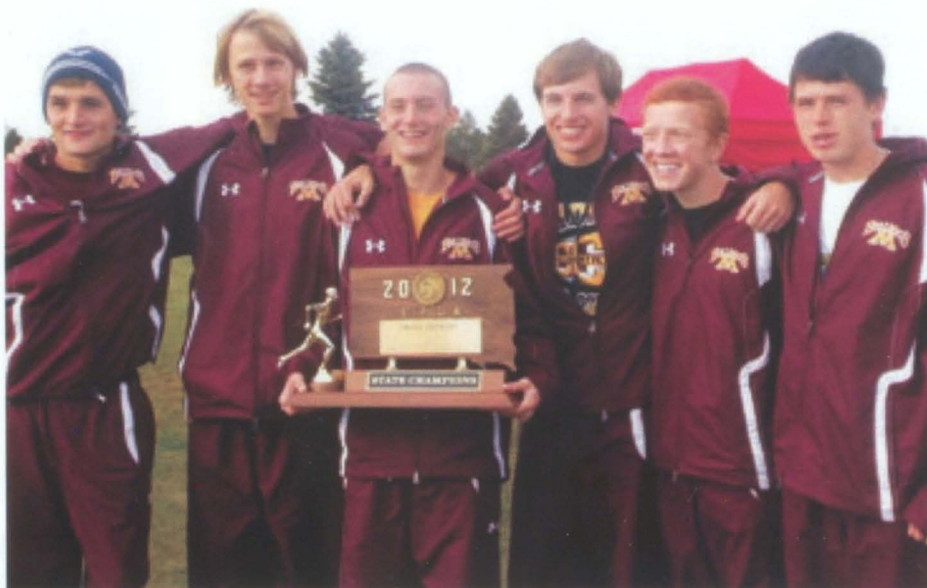

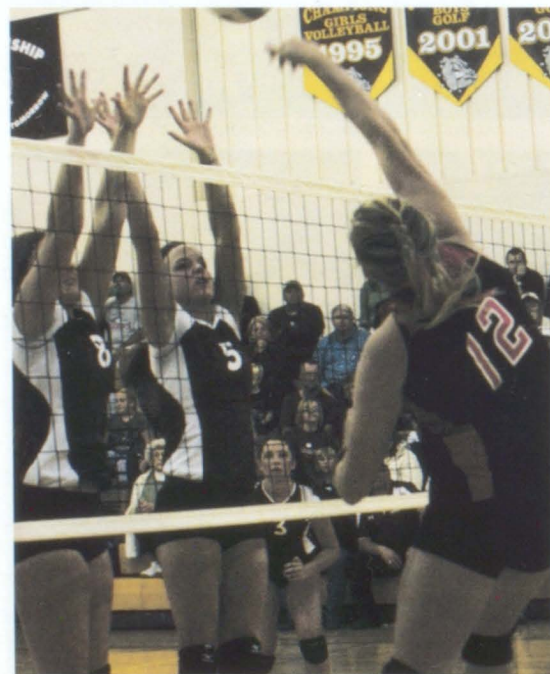

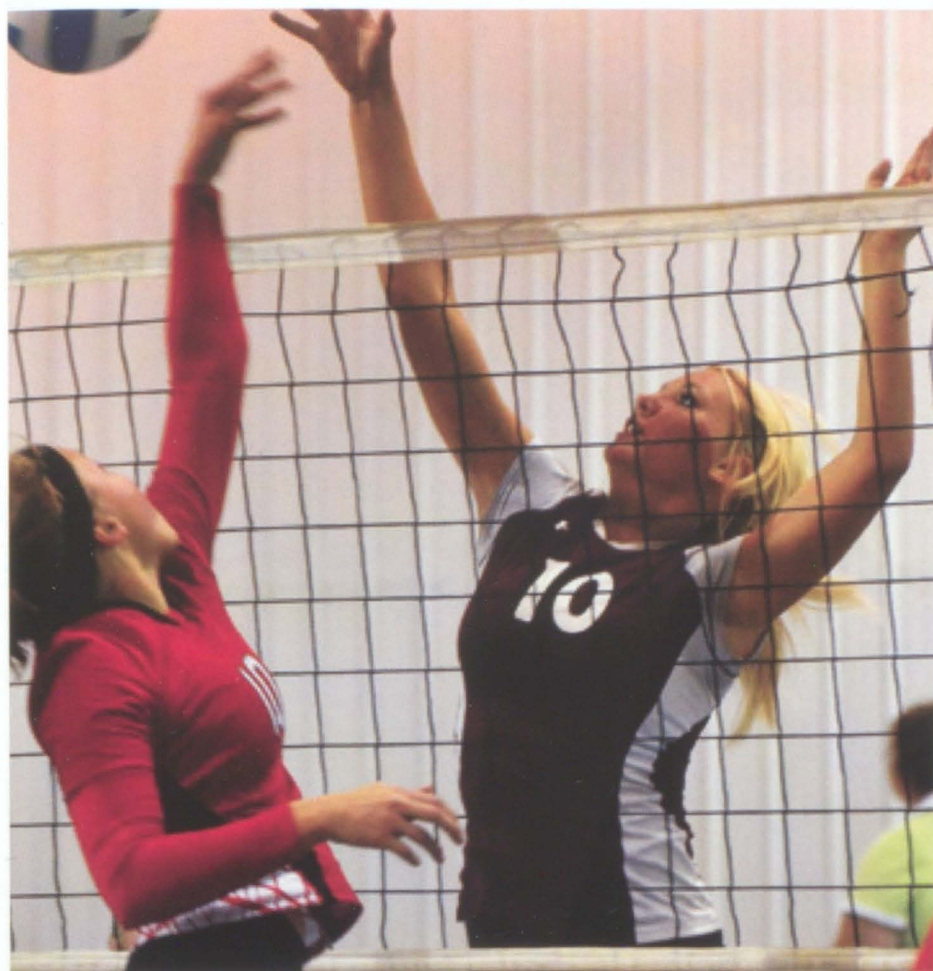

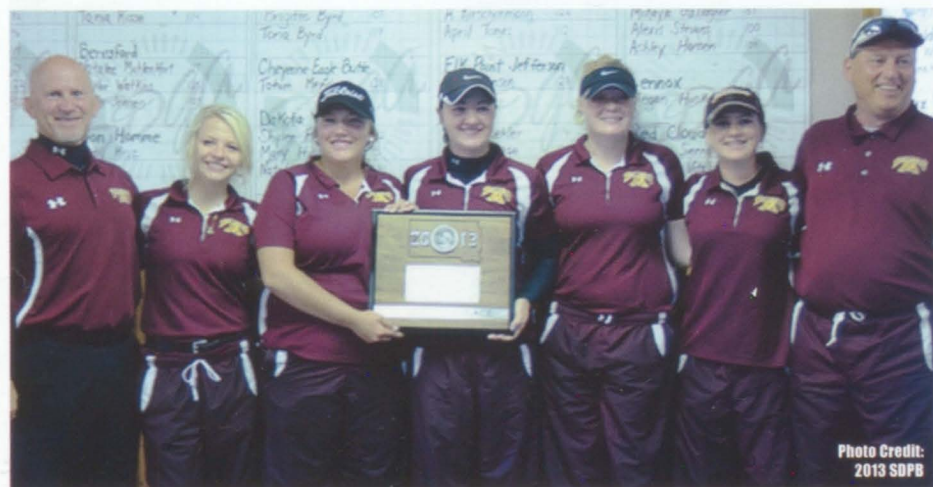

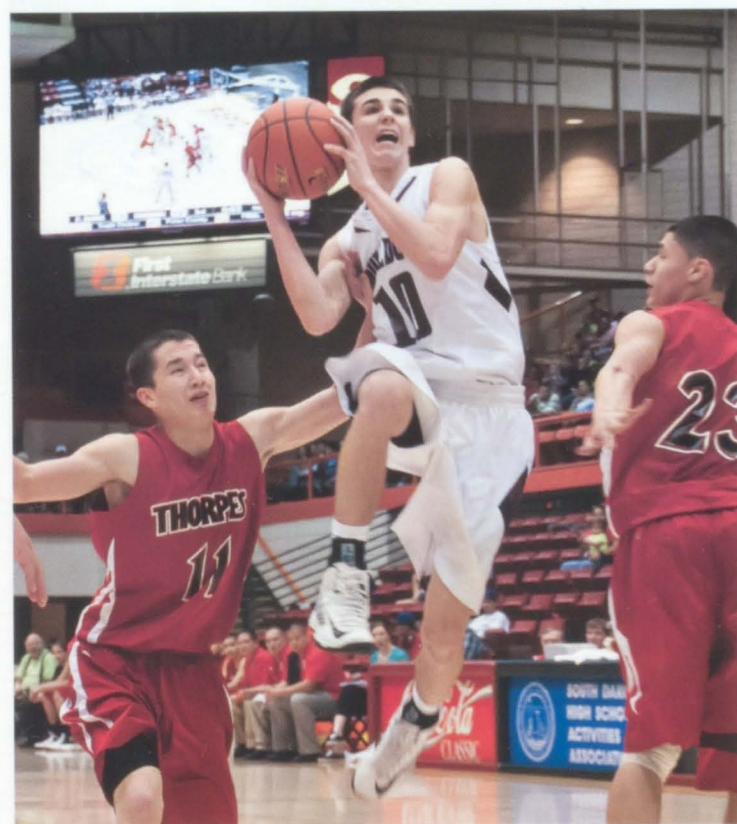

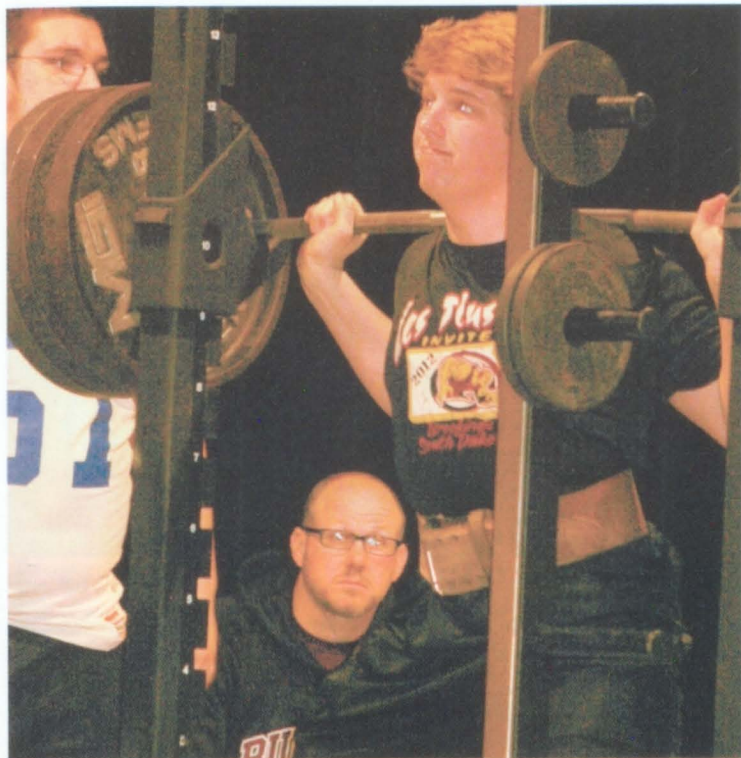

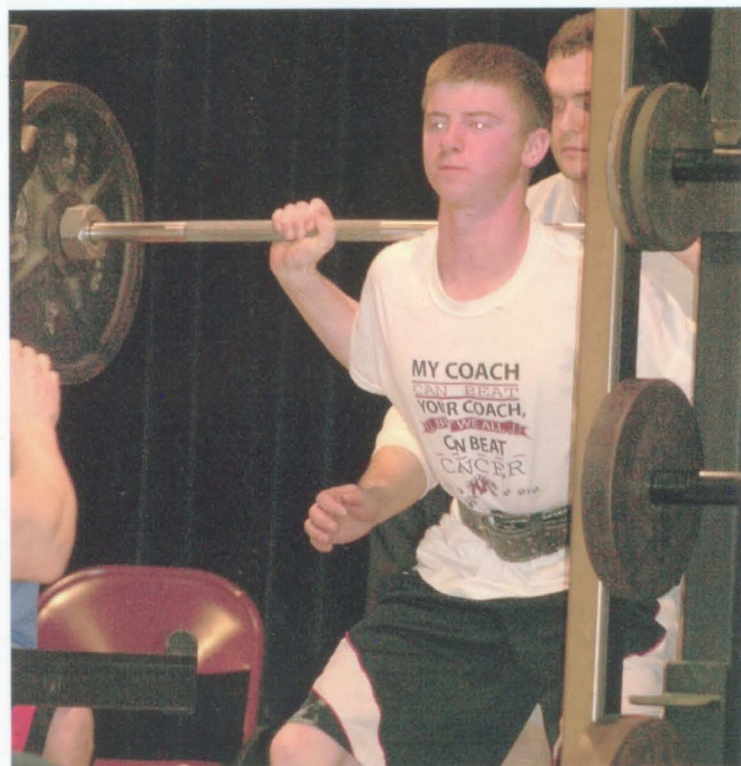

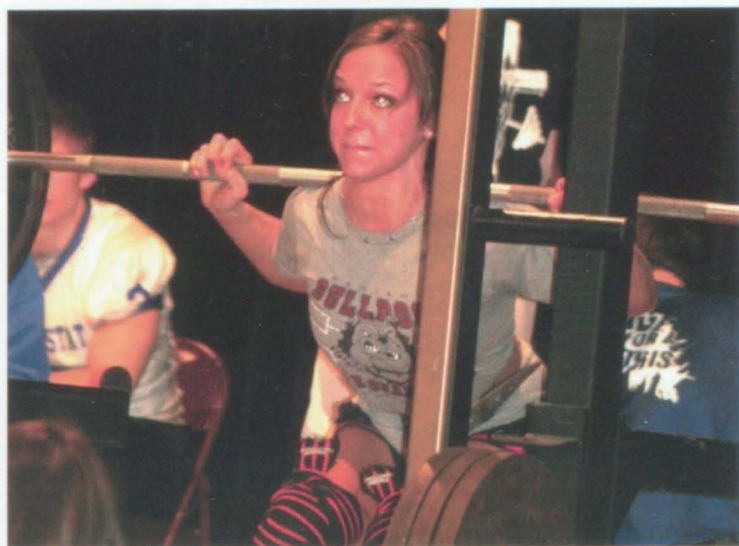

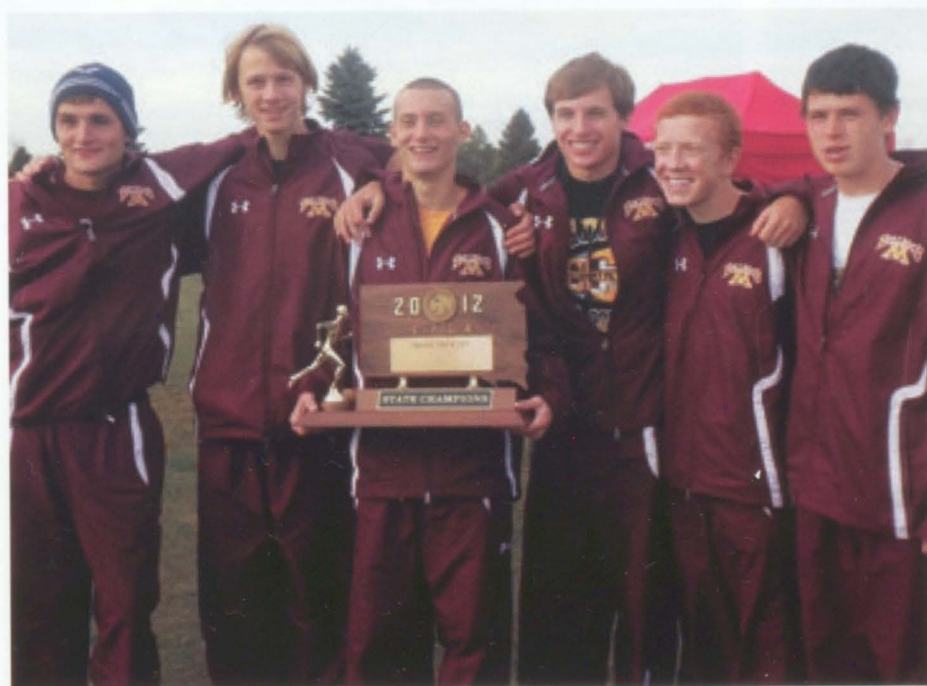

On March 20, eight Madison High School culinary arts students and their instructor, Mrs. Sarah Perez, attended the 2013 South Dakota Pro Start Competition at Mitchell Technical Institute, Mitchell, SD. Schools in attendance included: Brookings, Lake Area Multi District, Lemmon, McIntosh, Madison, Sturgis, Sioux Falls CTE Academy, Mitchell CTE, and Huron.

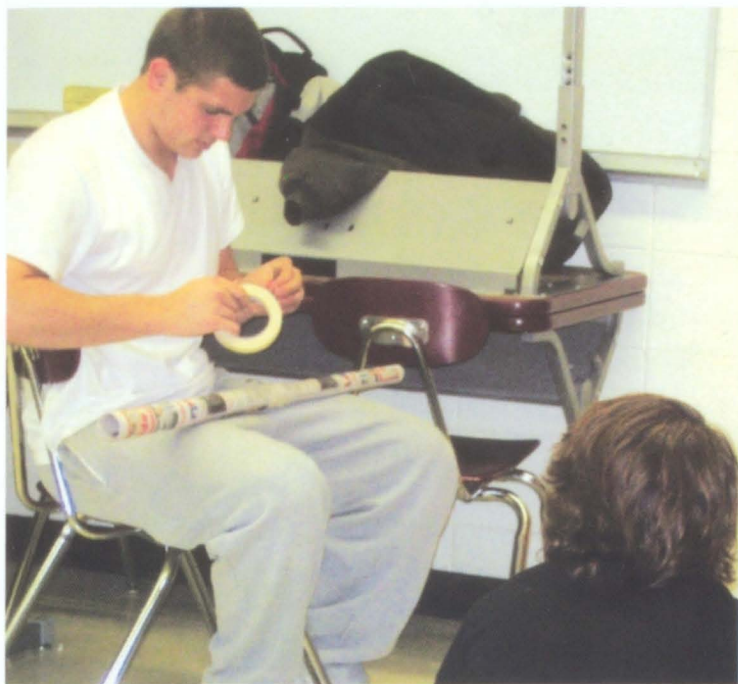

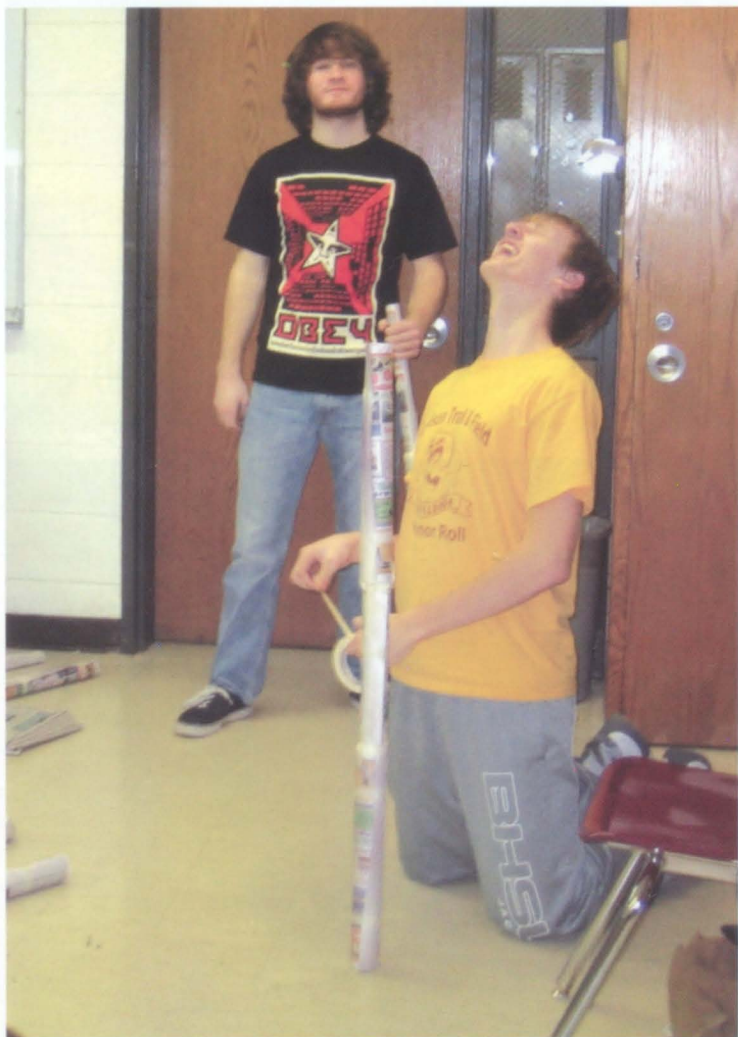

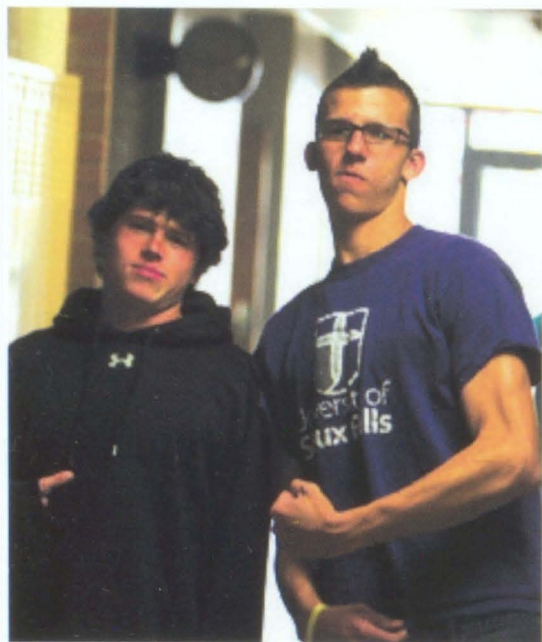
