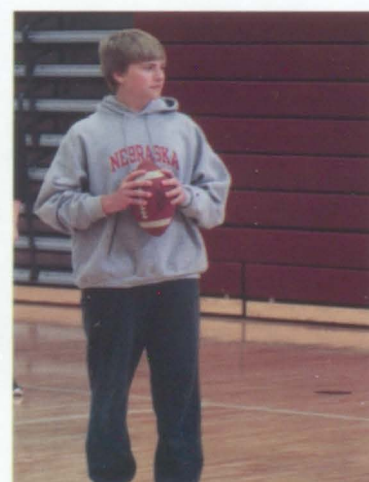

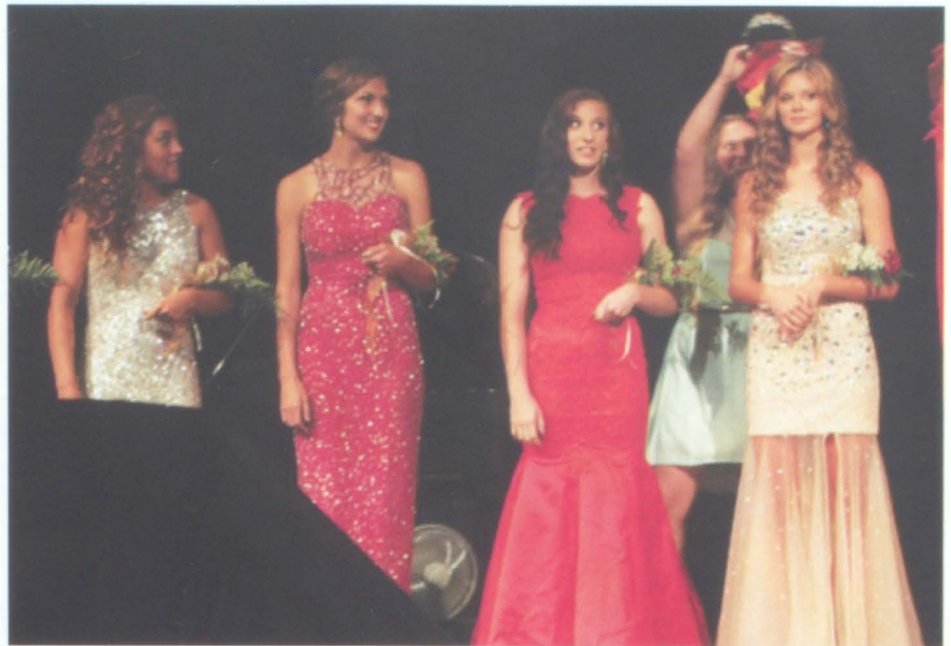

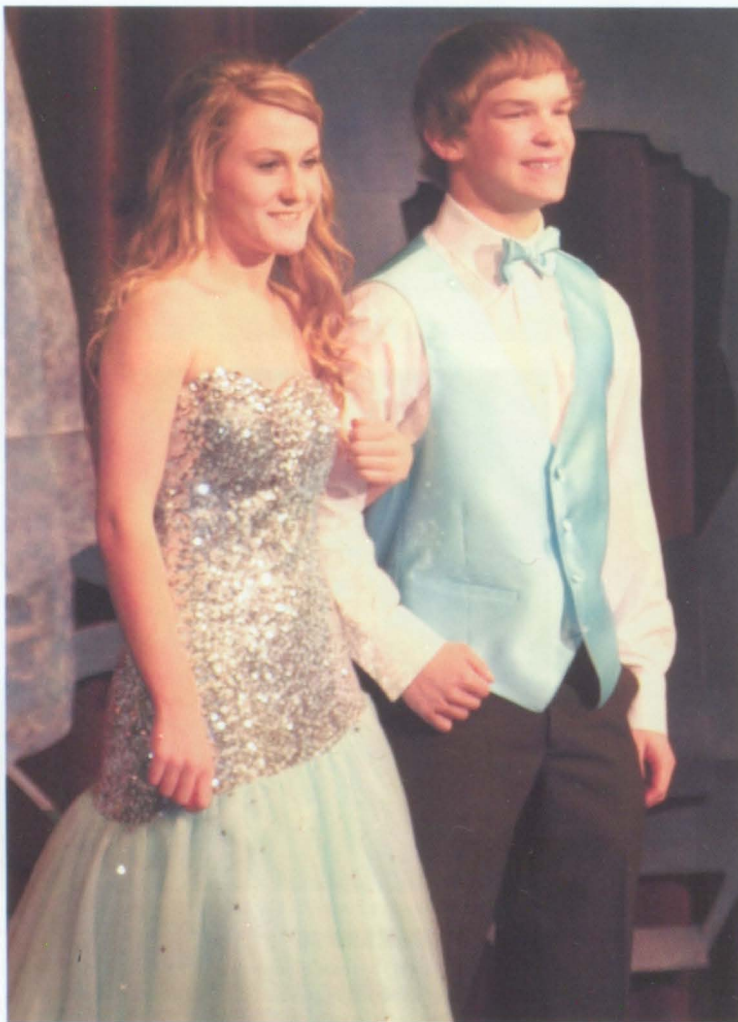

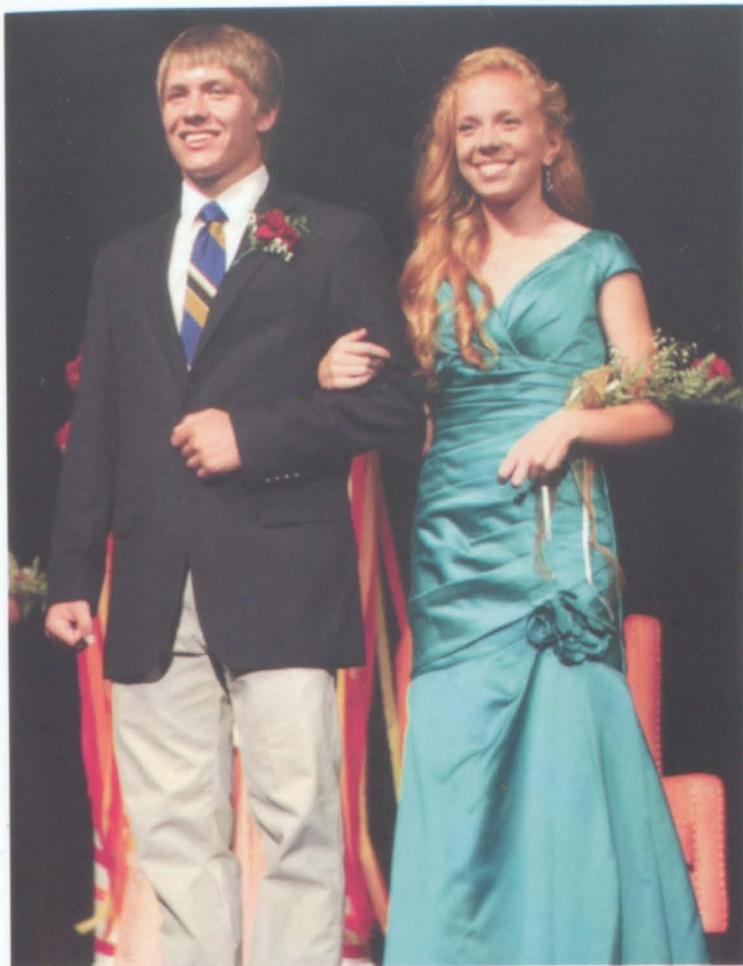

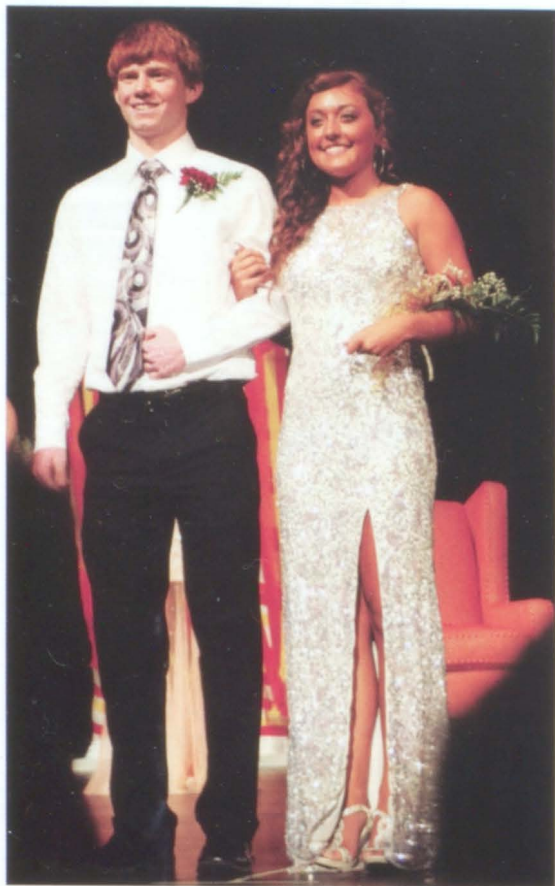

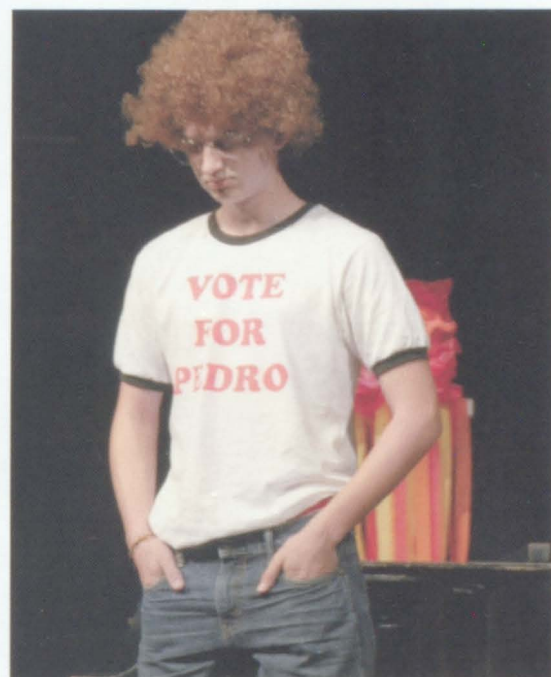

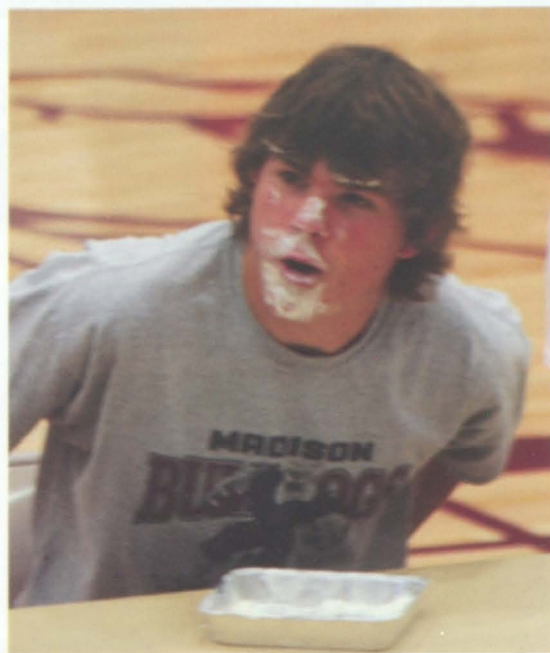

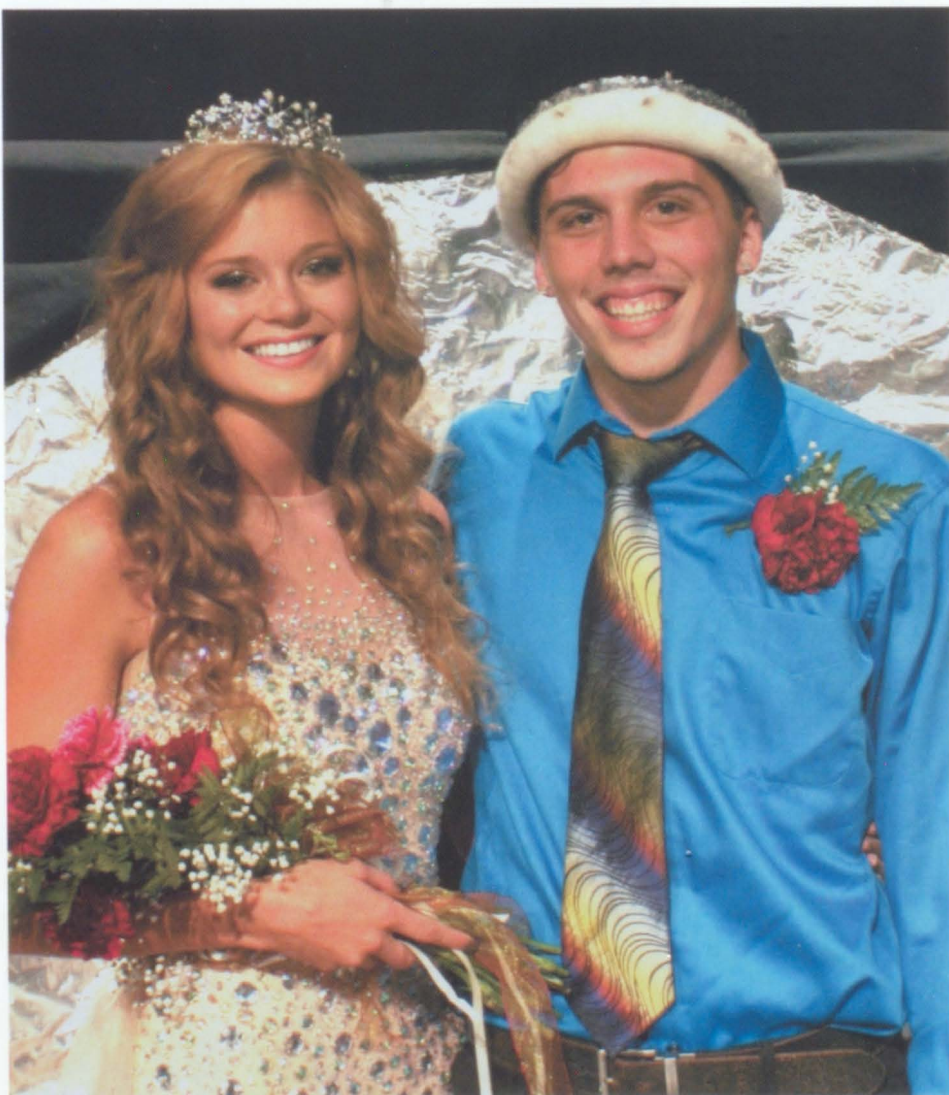

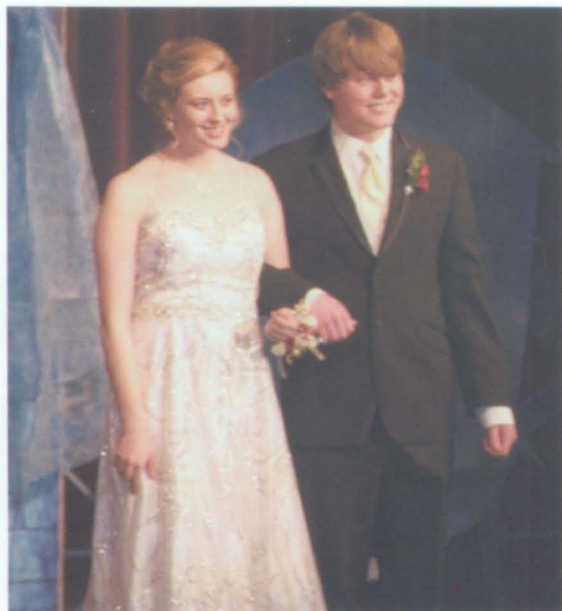

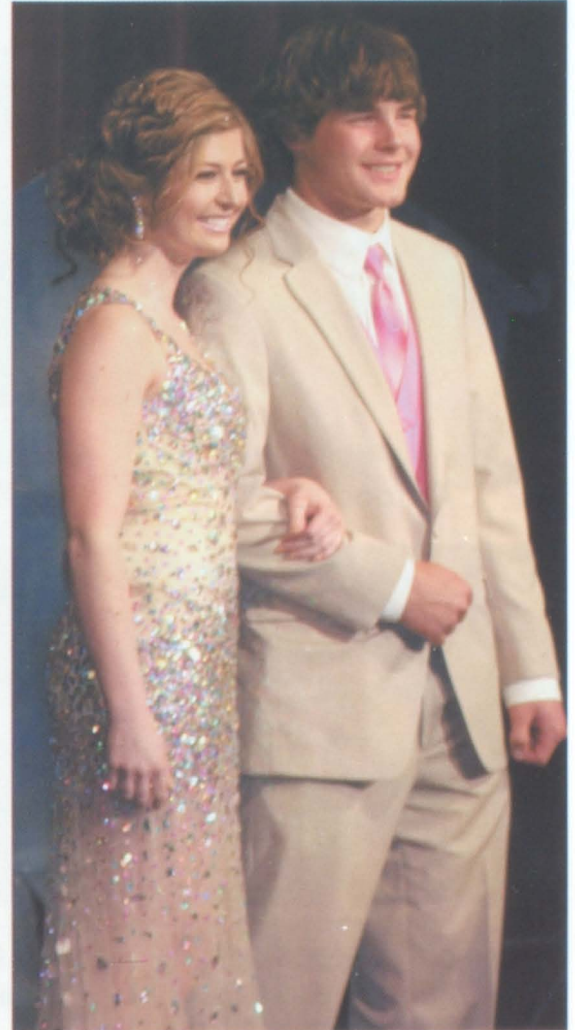

Amanda Ricke, a junior, offered a plan for *The Sweet Things*, a small shop in Brookings that sells cupcakes at an affordable price. Her business will feature gluten-free baked goods and will cater events such as weddings, birthdays, and other parties.

Heith Williams, a senior, had a plan for *The Putting Greens*, a mini golf course in Madison. The 9-hole outdoor mini golf course also features an 18-hole indoor black light gold course that will include an arcade and concession stand.

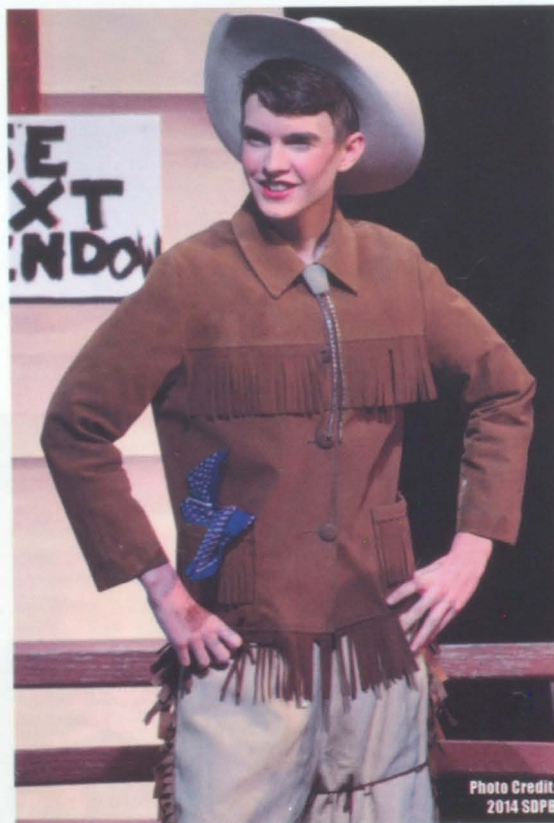

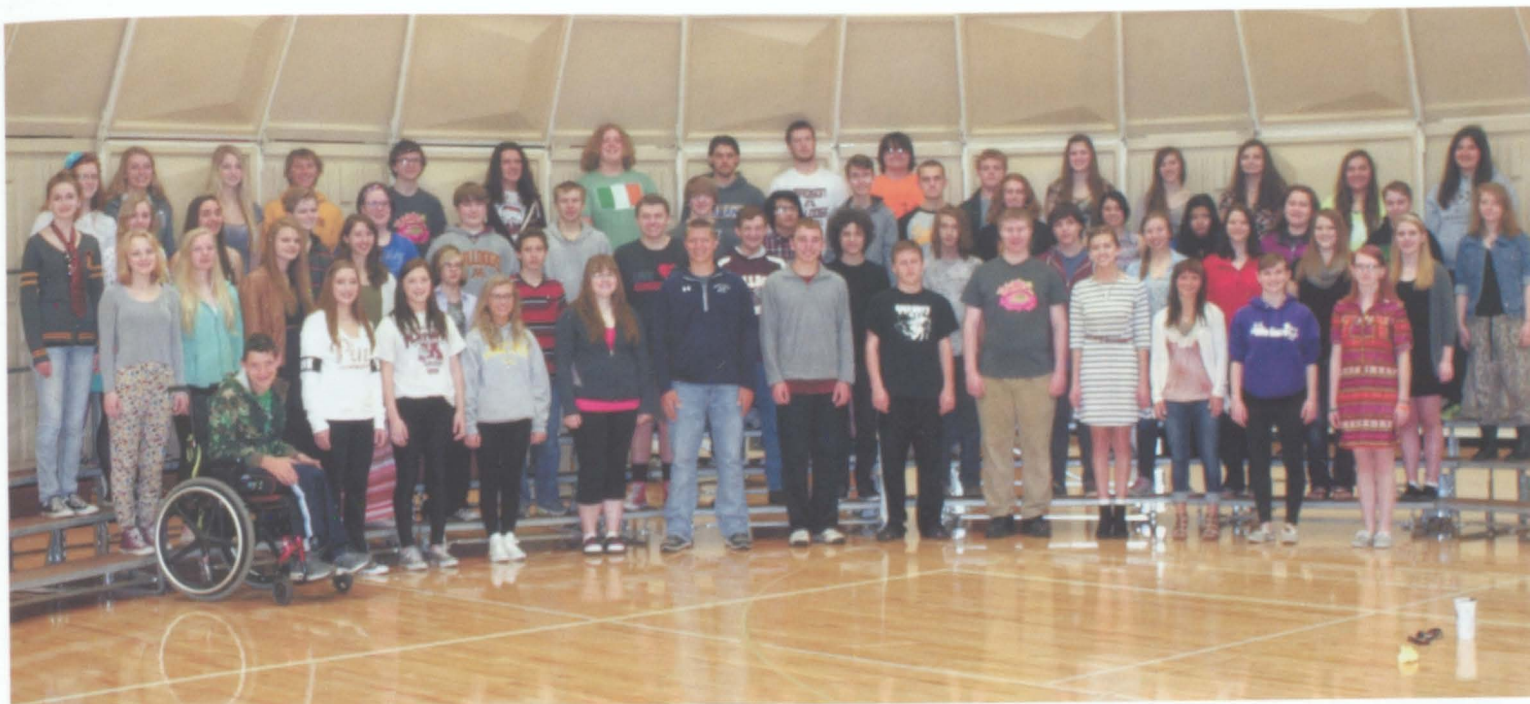

As I interviewed the women who help organize it and the pastor, they stressed that there is a broad effort to continue providing the Gathering, some "30-40 organizations buy and serve the food." Along with that, "Some donate money, but we do not advertise [to receive charity]."

The Gathering has a very successful backstory, it started "About 10-12 years ago." and it occurred "Every other week." until they had the resources to bump it to the current every week. It started off "With deliveries, using coolers to bring food to people who would call." Now it has grown to being able to serve "100-120 people with no restriction on who can come."

As strongly as the Gathering is going, it's always in need for volunteers. As I was told, "It's very nice to see the young people helping out the way they do." Also, there used to be music provided, but they no longer have anybody to play, "So if anybody wants to come to play music they are fully welcome too." Most hope to see the Gathering continue for as long as possible, and the Methodist Church is optimistic about that, "I think it's going very well." And as far I see, it's going to go well for a very long time.

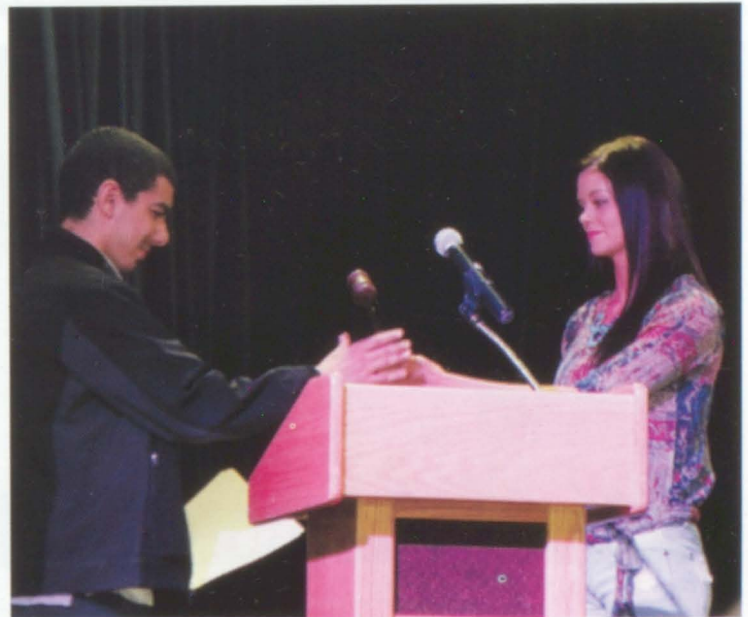

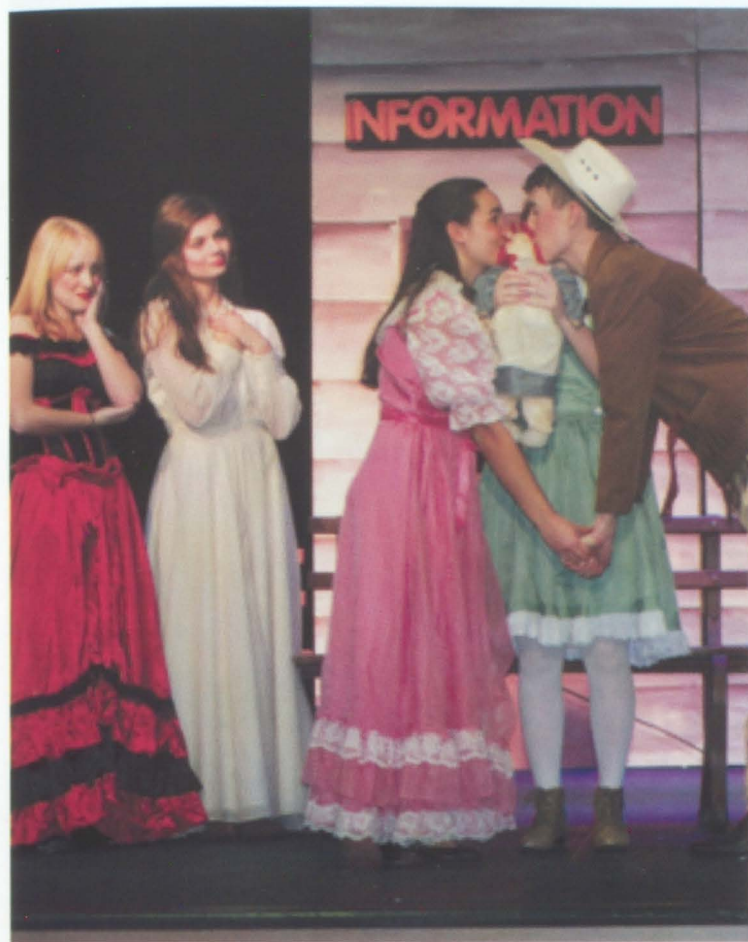

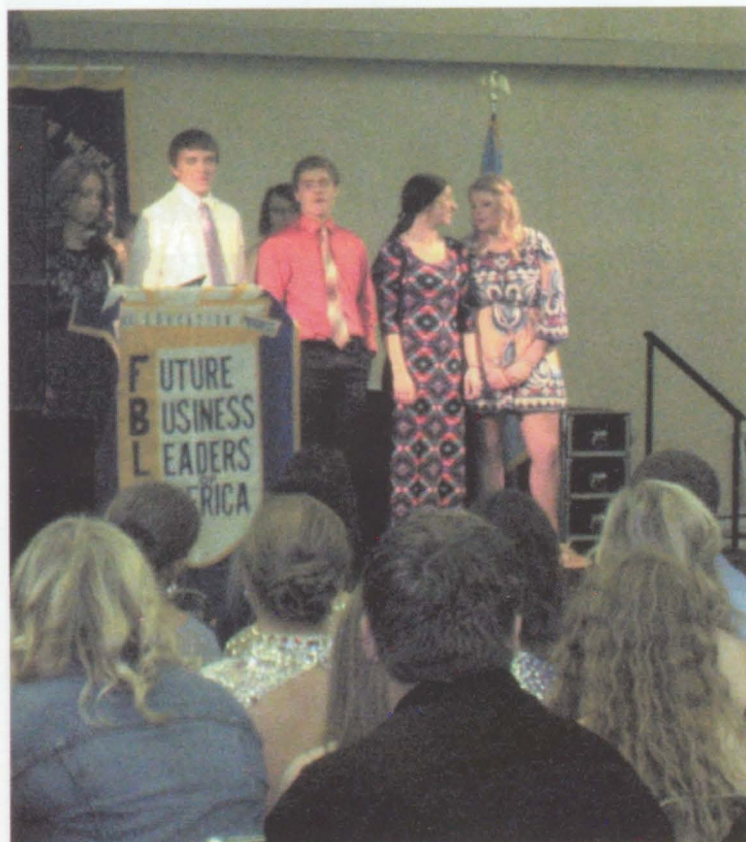

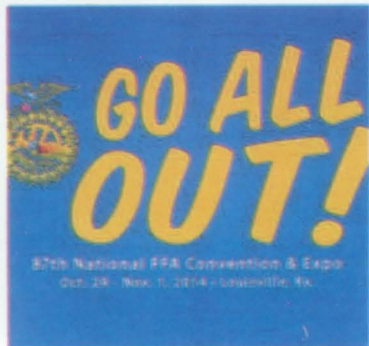

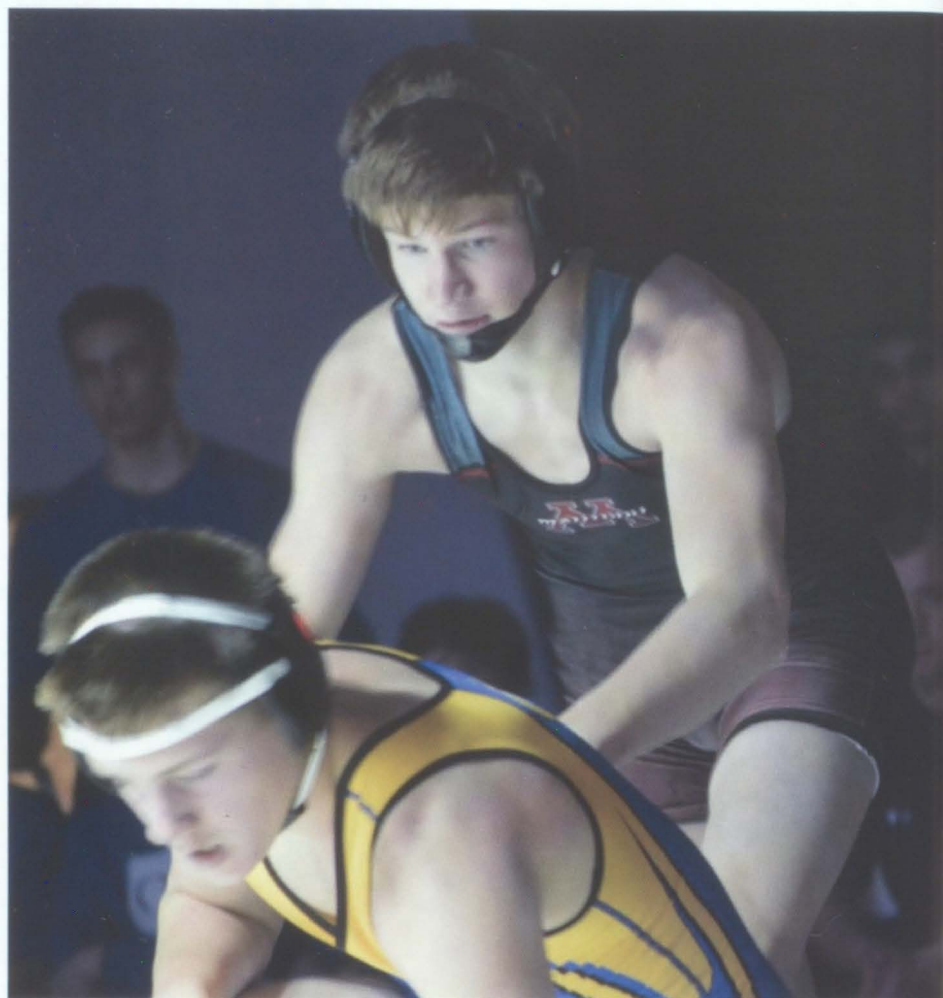

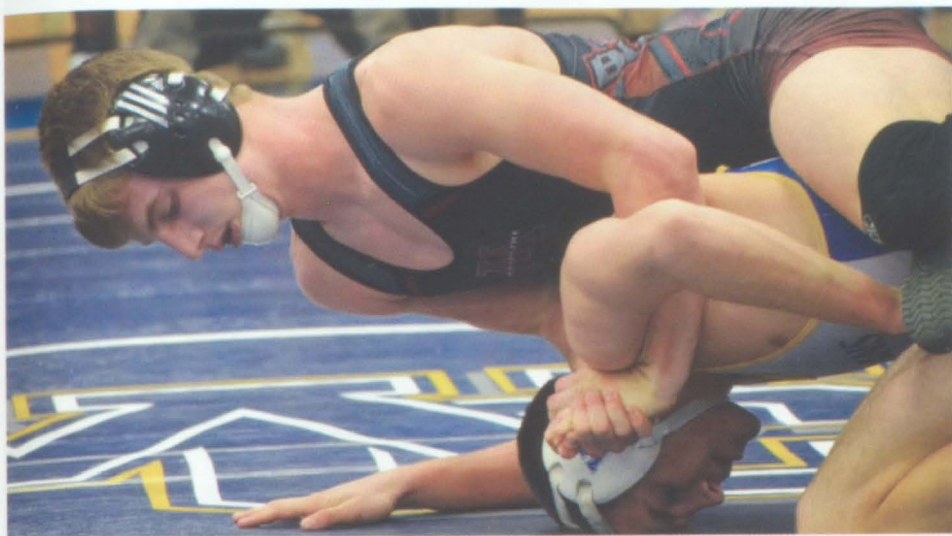

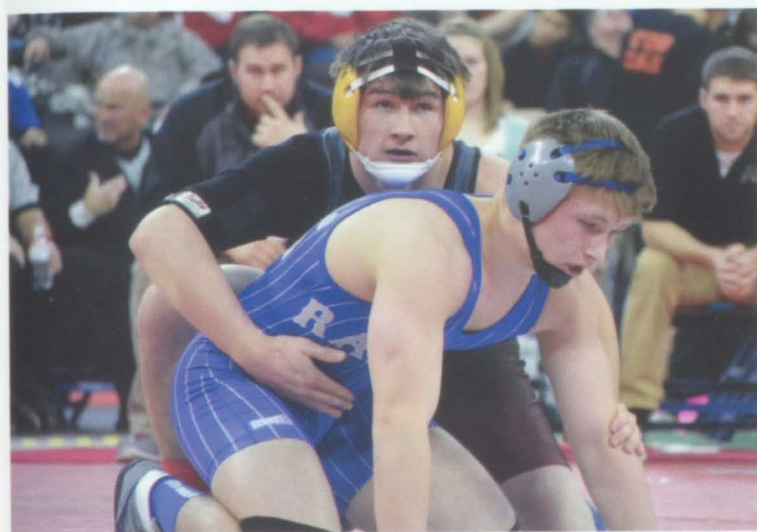

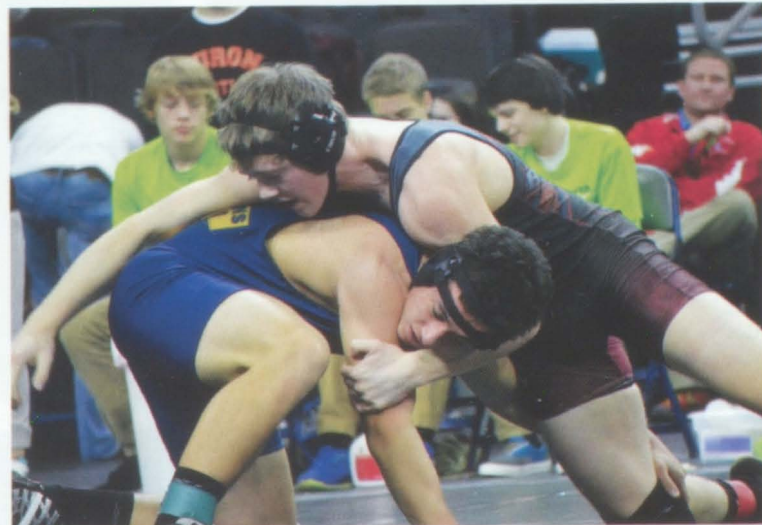

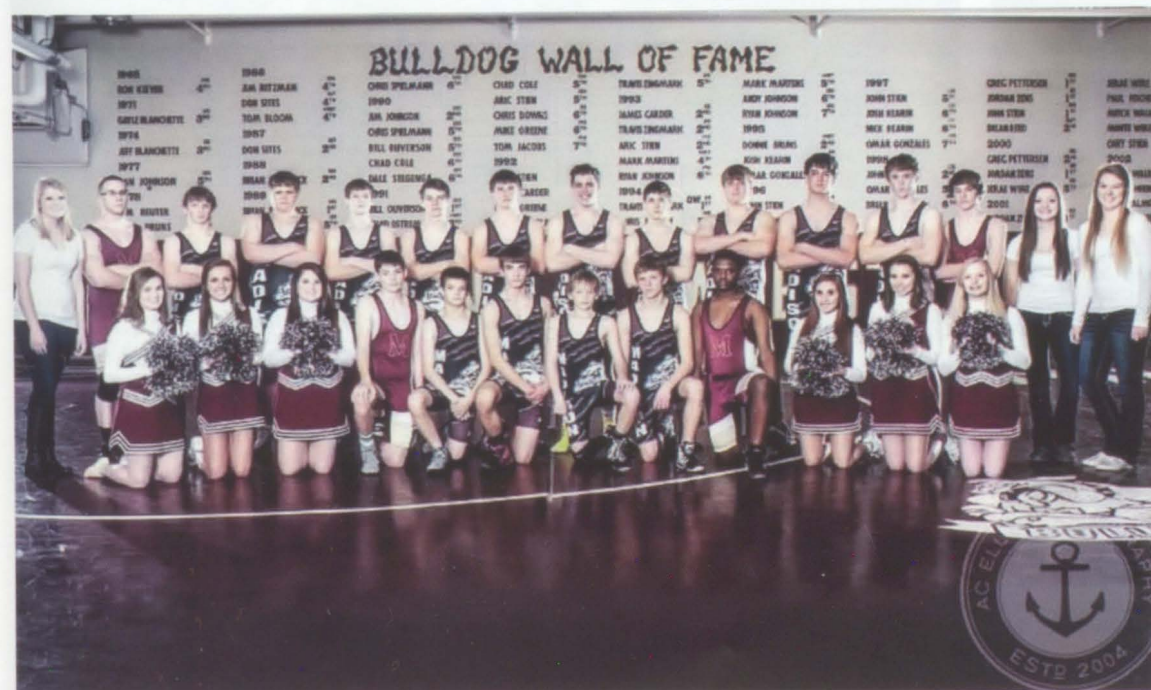

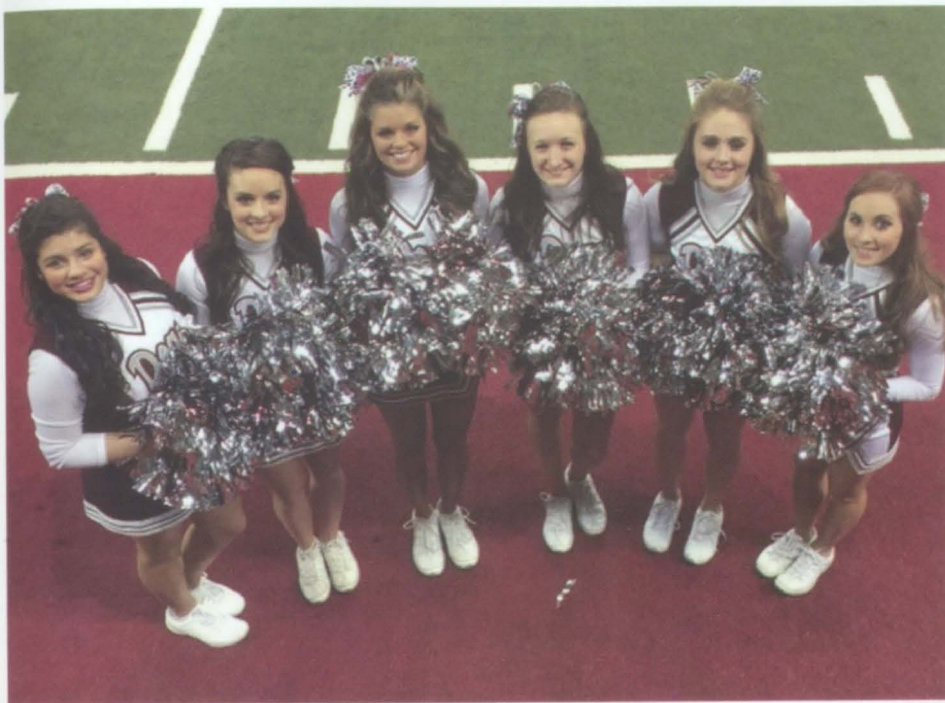

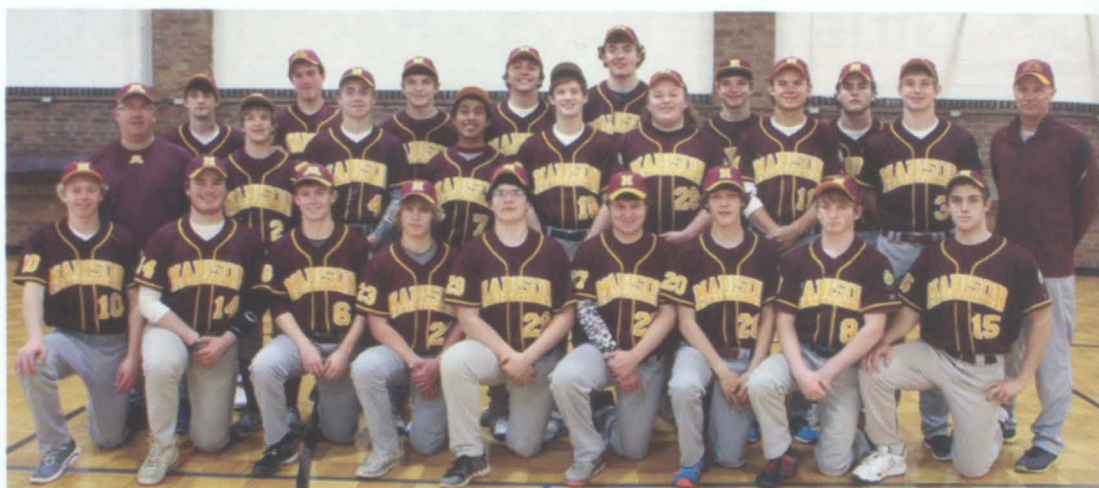
