



























Noah Salmen Wins First Place Prize in 26th Annual Business Plan Competition

Two students from Madison High School, Noah Salmen and Paige duRandt, were chosen as finalists in the South Dakota Banker's Foundation's 26th Annual Business Plan Competition.

As part of their Entrepreneurship class, students were required to create a business plan written as if they were to create their own business. The plans were to state where the business would be located, list what was needed for start-up, and project sales and expenses for one month. The plan needed to also include business goals.

First-place winner, Noah Salmen provides locally-grown popcorn in different varieties, each with unique characteristics - gold that produces fluffier popcorn, white that produces less hulls, mauve that produces an even fluffier version, and mini-multi that produces a less fluffy version that appeals to little children. Noah's business plan was developed to include new products and flavors and to market his family's product beyond its existing communities.

Paige duRandt Photography's main goal is to provide high quality digital pictures at affordable prices. Pictures will be sold as enhanced digital that can easily be shared with friends and family. Paige received a runners-up award at the finals in Pierre.



















































Raku Pottery

Ancient Japanese Pottery Technique

Mrs. Evans' art students were treated to a Raku pottery workshop put on by Tom and Wanda Clarke of Dakota Potter's Supply out of Sioux Falls. Raku is an ancient Japanese pottery technique where hand-made pottery pieces are covered in special glazes and then fired in a kiln and placed on different combustible materials that ignite. The pieces are then covered with metal buckets that deplete the oxygen and forces the glaze into the clay pottery. Combustible materials that may be used include: sawdust, leaves, shredded newspaper, and horse hair. Chemical reactions happen during the cooling process and create beautiful colors with flashes of metallic copper, gold, and silver visible in the pottery.

This year, seventy-six art students participated in the Raku workshop. The Clarkes used the classroom setting to explain the different glazes and how the oxidation reduction process works. The students then glazed their pottery projects. The projects were then taken outside to complete the firing and oxidation process. Combustible materials were prepared and students were allowed to cover their kiln-fired pottery and await the finish product. The unique pottery projects were put on display for public to enjoy.





Classroom to Courtroom

Business Law Students Conduct the State vs. Pat Morton Trial

Students in Mrs. Olson's Business Law class used a mock trial this year as their final project to show their understanding of courts and trial procedures. Students needed to become familiar with the role of a trial court from the court procedures to the importance of various people in the courtroom. The trial also gave students the opportunity to practice communication as they prepared and presented their case.

The mock trial used was a theft in the first degree case - the State vs. Pat Morton. Business Law students were each assigned a role in the courtroom. The presiding judge was Tanner Burg; bailiff, Matt Palli: prosecuting attorney, Hunter Jamison; defense attorney, Samantha Langford; witnesses for the prosecution, Martha Aguirre and Katie Bergheim; witness for the defense, Cole Inhofer; and the defendant, Mason Leighton. Once the roles were assigned, each student was given a script and time to prepare their part.

After the preparation time, students from outside of the class were asked to be a part of the jury. Kyla Kasuske, Paige duRandt, and Peityn Roemen served as the jury and were given juror instructions. The mock trial was held and the jury had time to deliberate. The jury came back with a not guilty decision. After the trial and decision, the Business Law students completed debriefing questions and then the class discussed the whole courtroom process.
