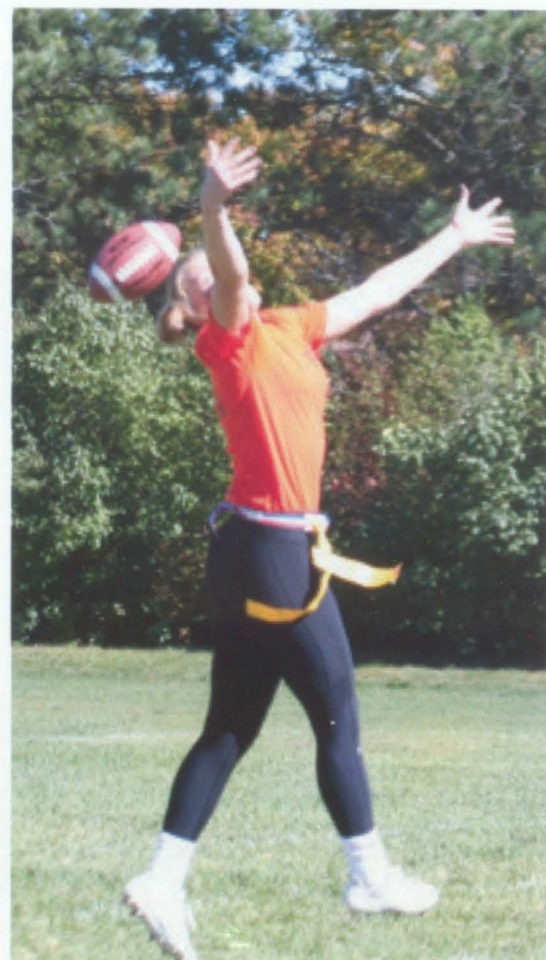

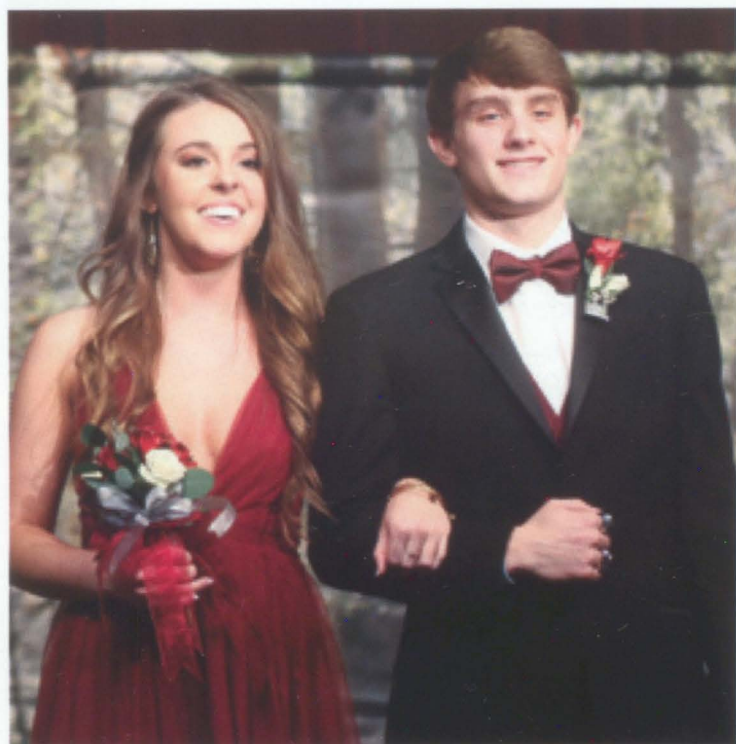

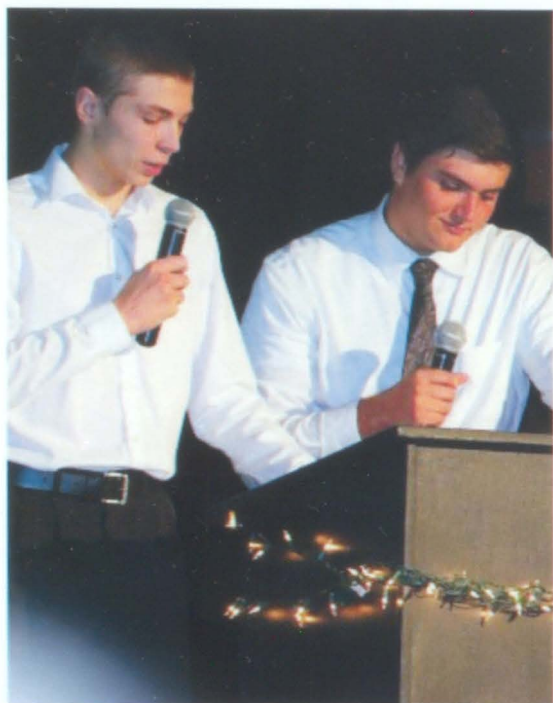

Boys State Delegates

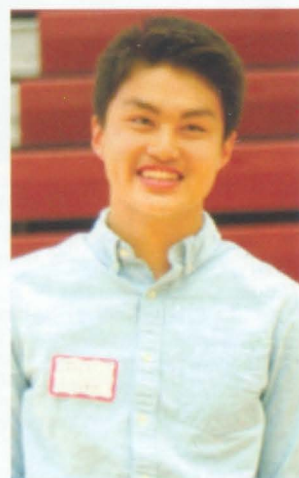
Thomas Gors and Bear Shipley have been selected to attend the South Dakota American Legion Boys State in Aberdeen.

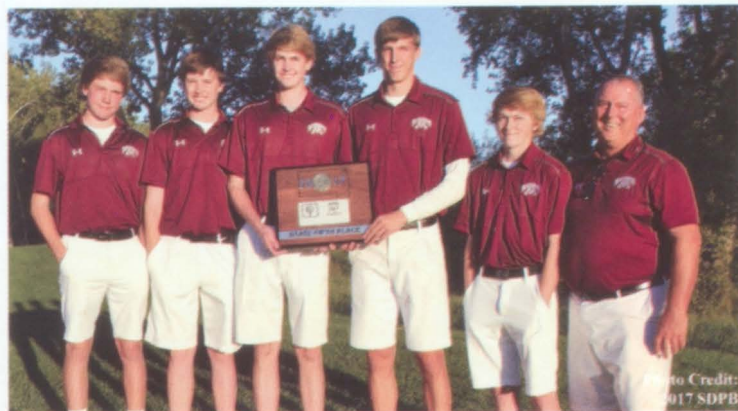

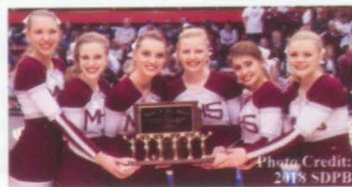

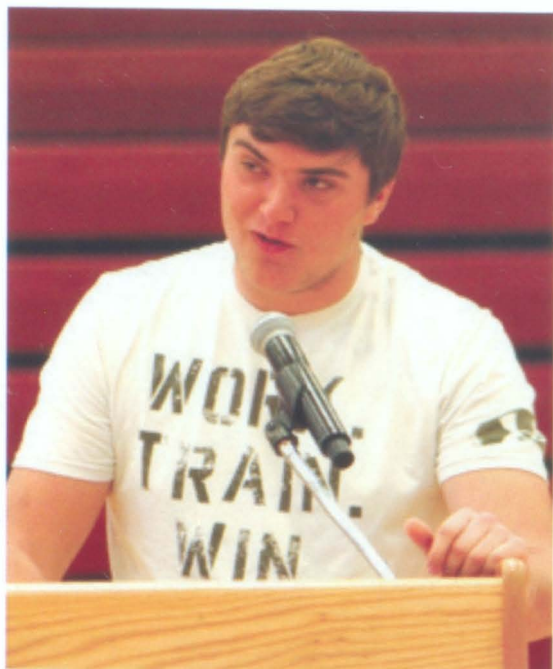

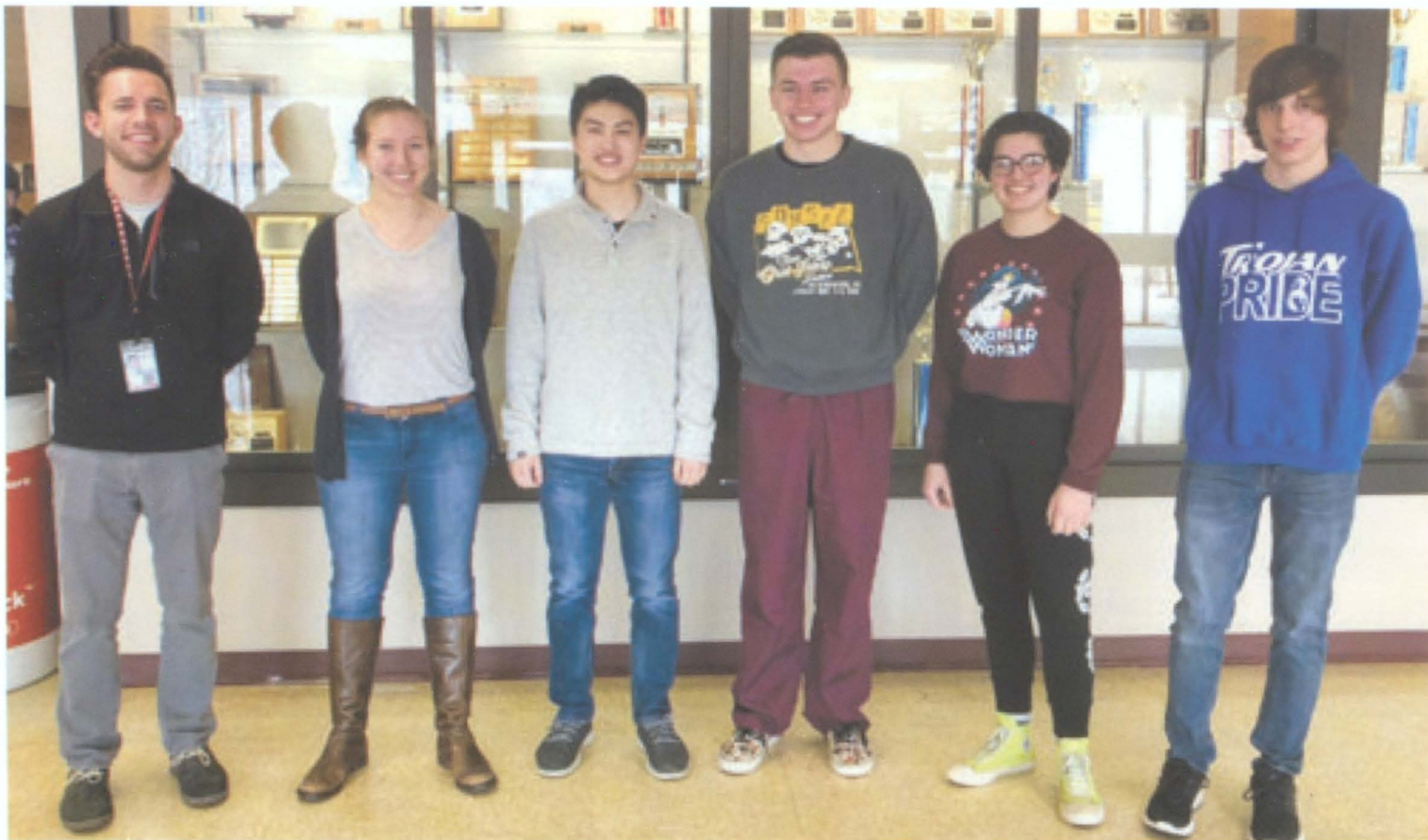

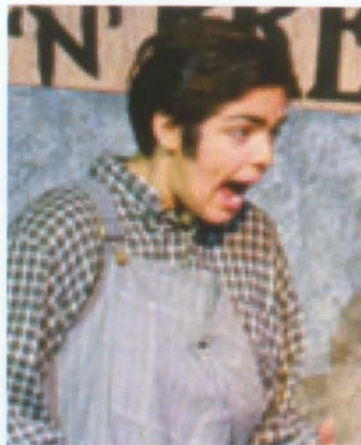

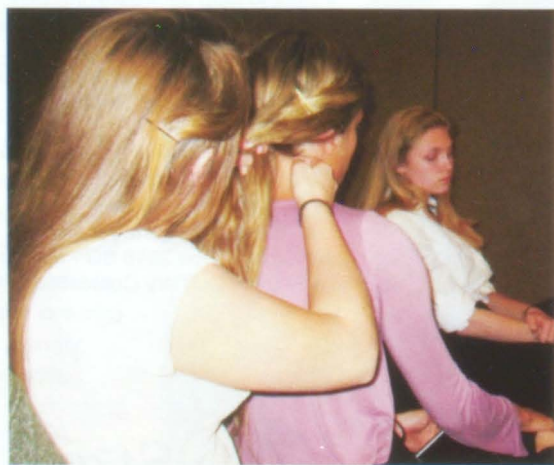

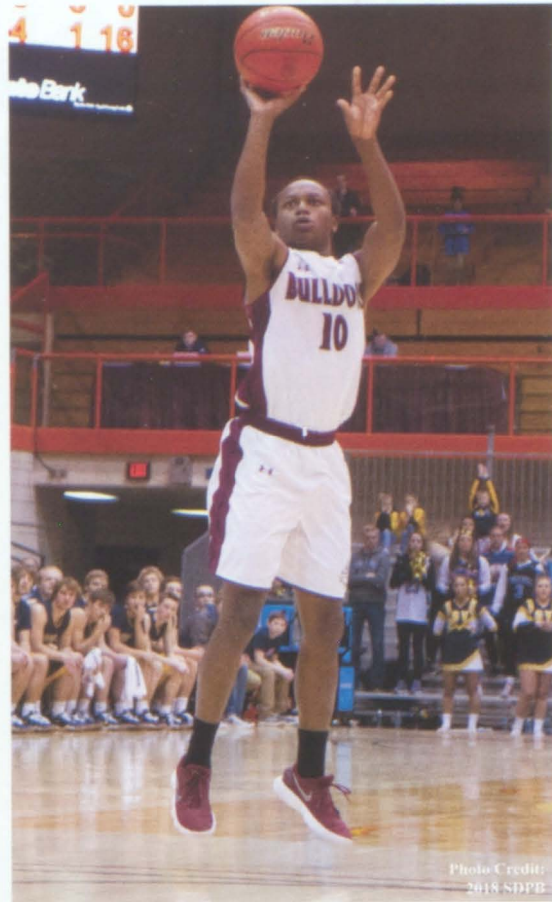

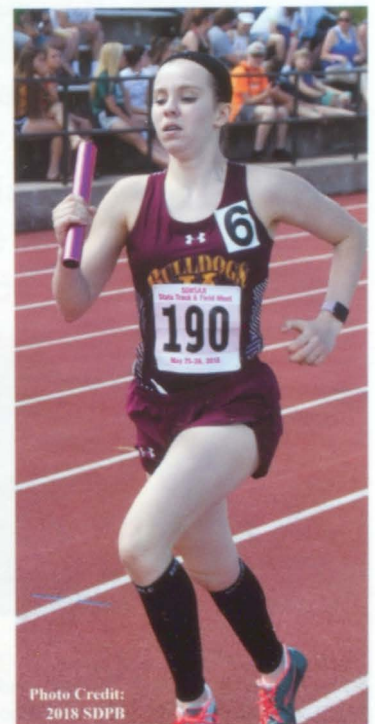

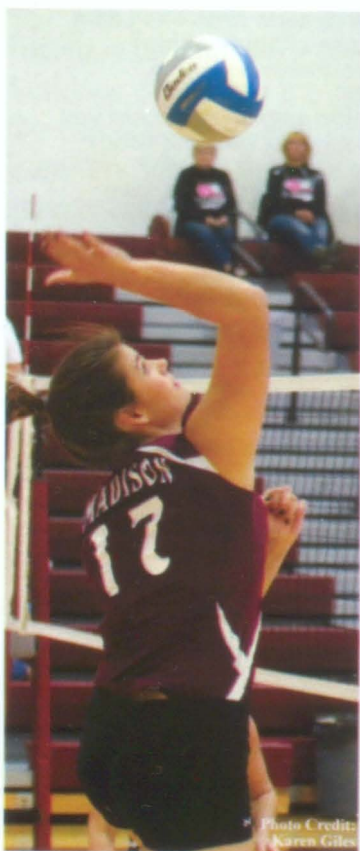

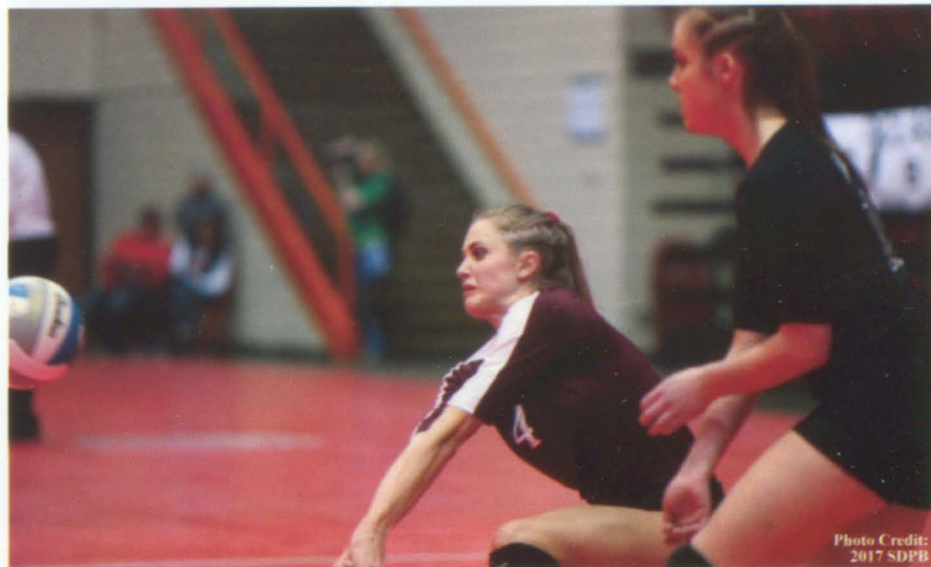

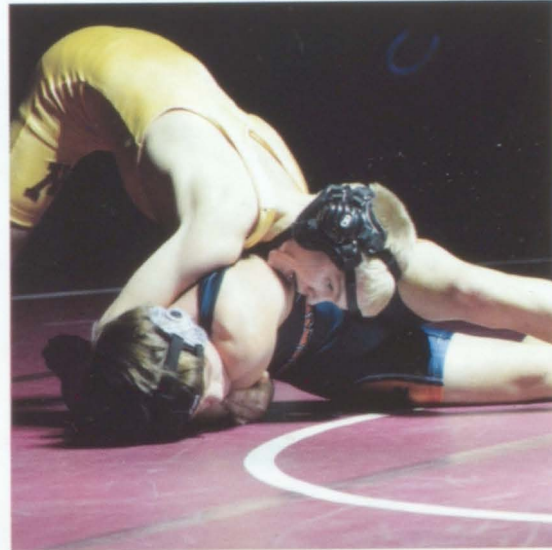
Focus is Key

One for the Books

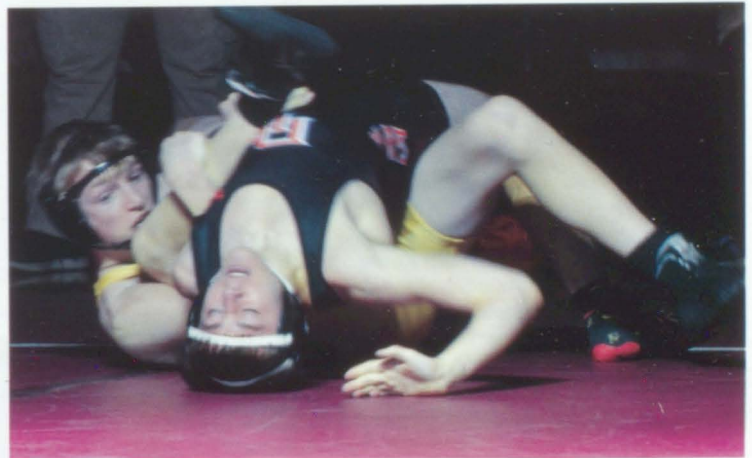

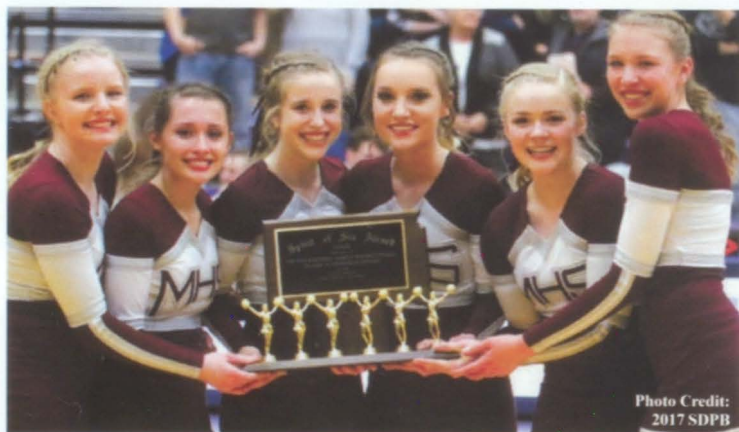

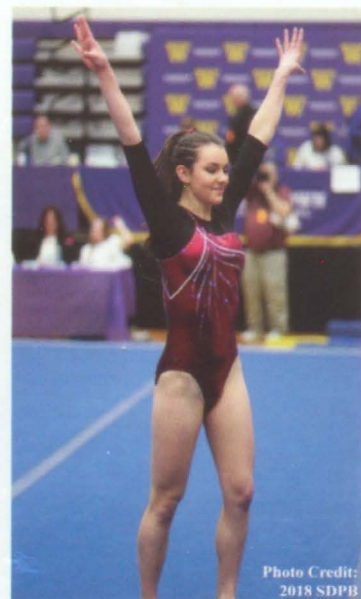

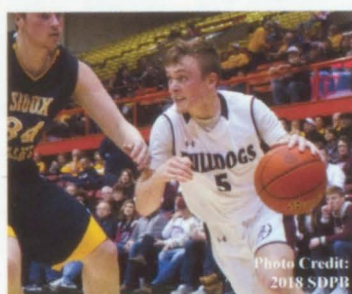

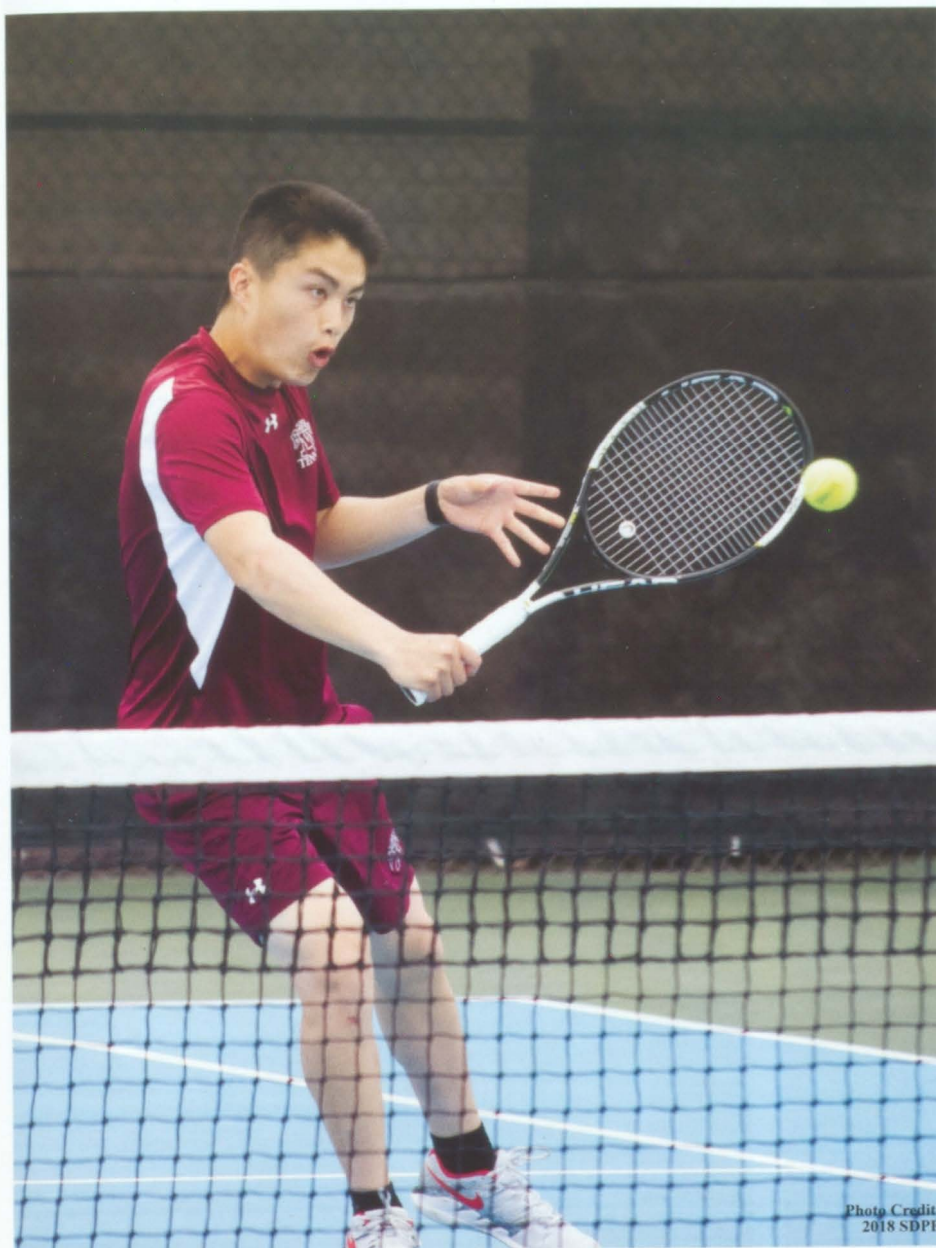

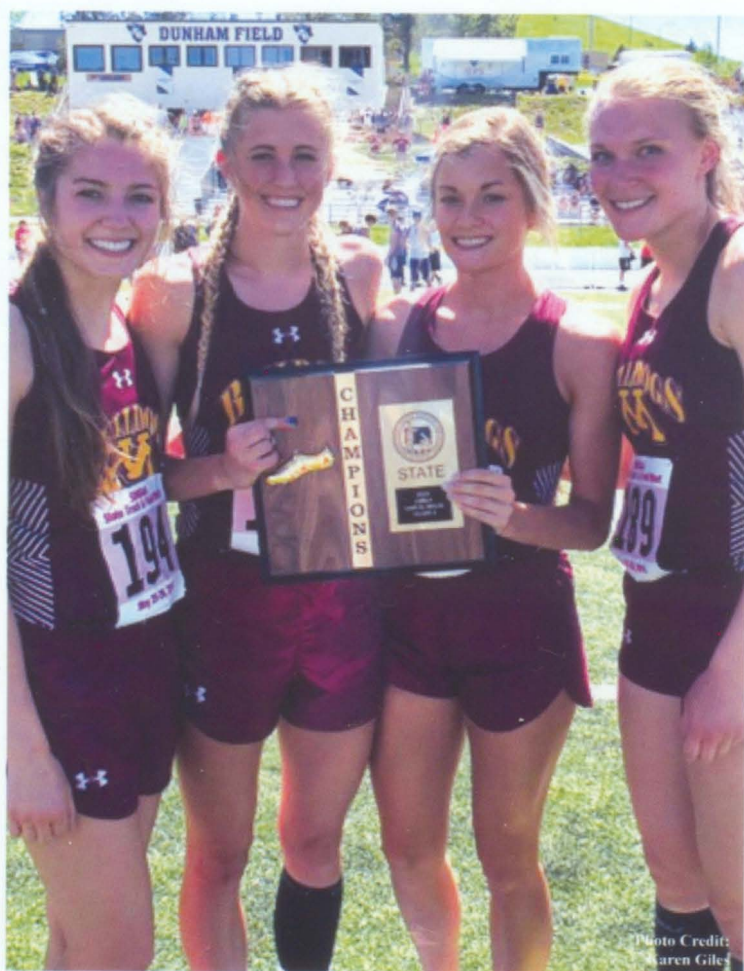

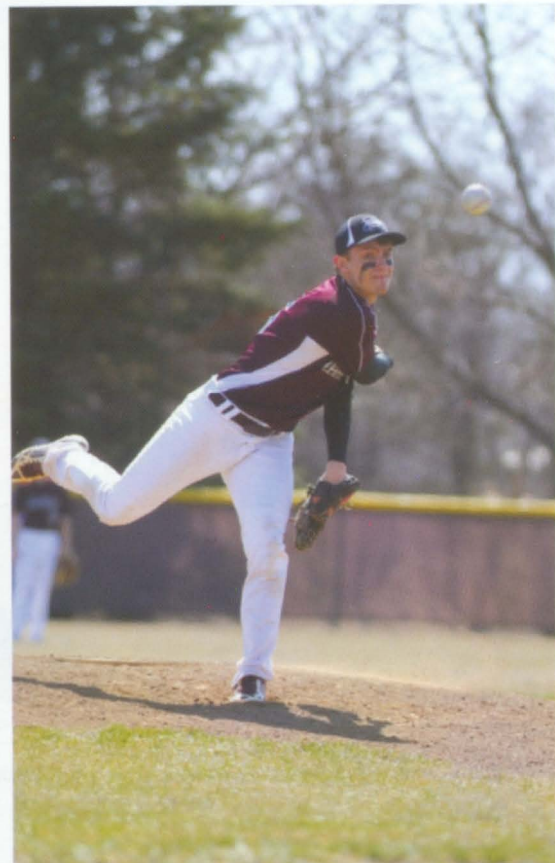

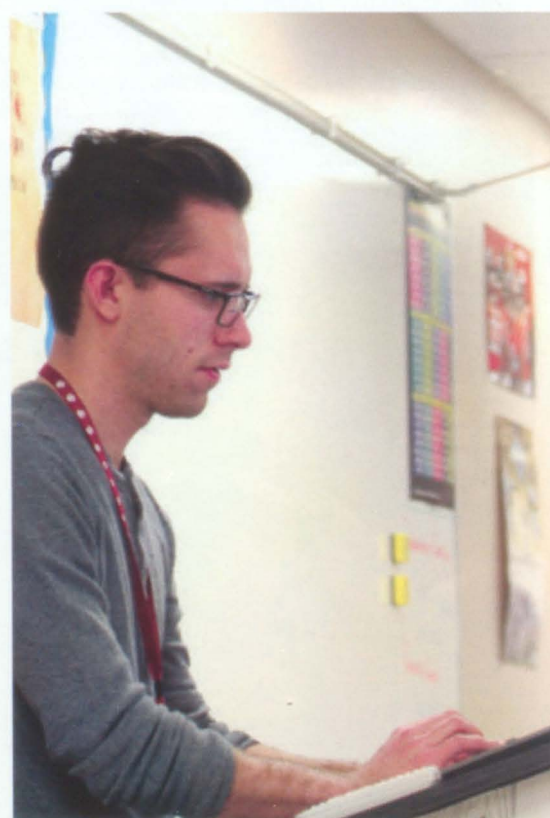

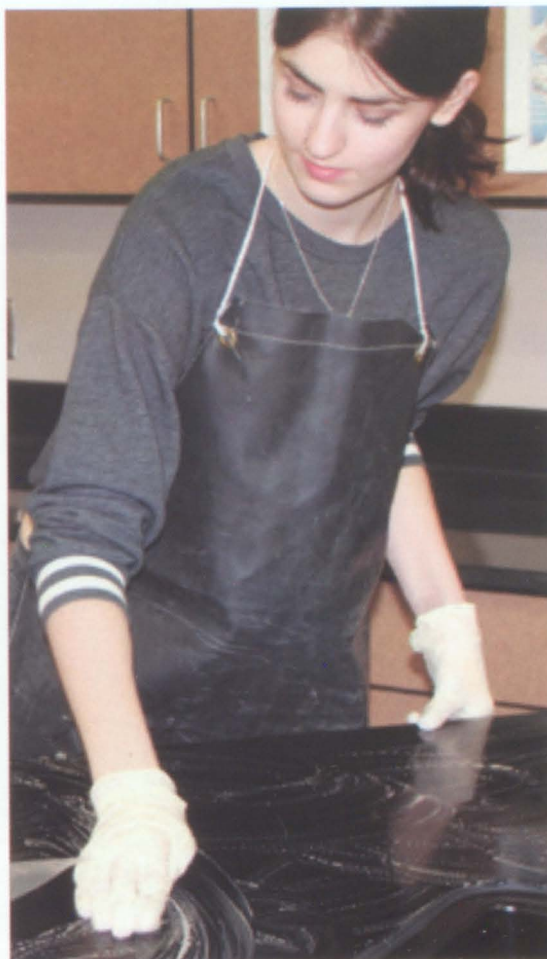

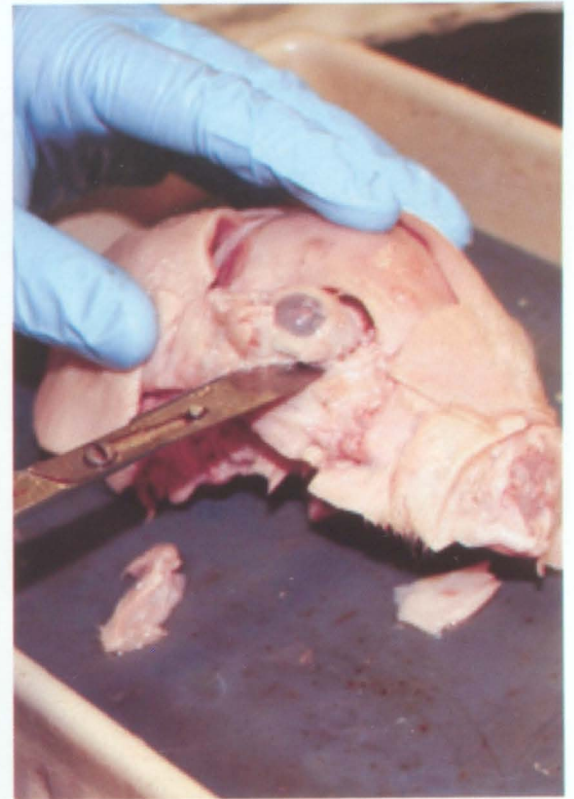

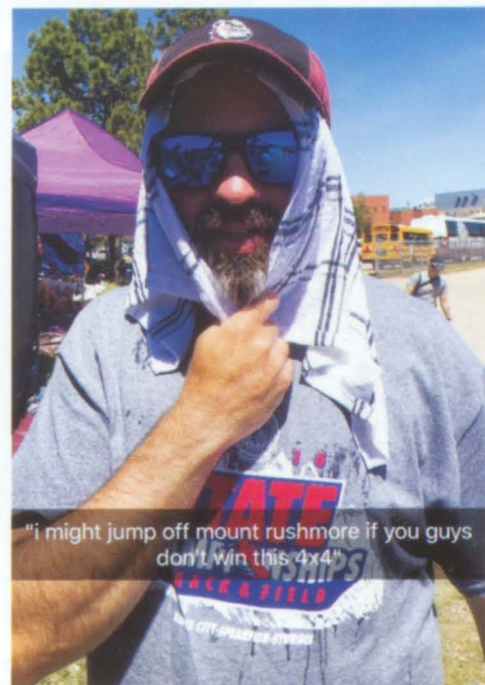
Colophon
